We invite contributions on topics such as:

- The evolving role of the Court's case law;
- How national courts apply the Convention and what that means for individuals seeking justice;
- The ECHR's influence beyond Europe;
- The Convention's future in a time of shifting politics, threats to the rule of law, and emerging digital rights issues.
