Please make sure to read this report carefully and with special attention to obtain better knowledge of our ELSA Network.

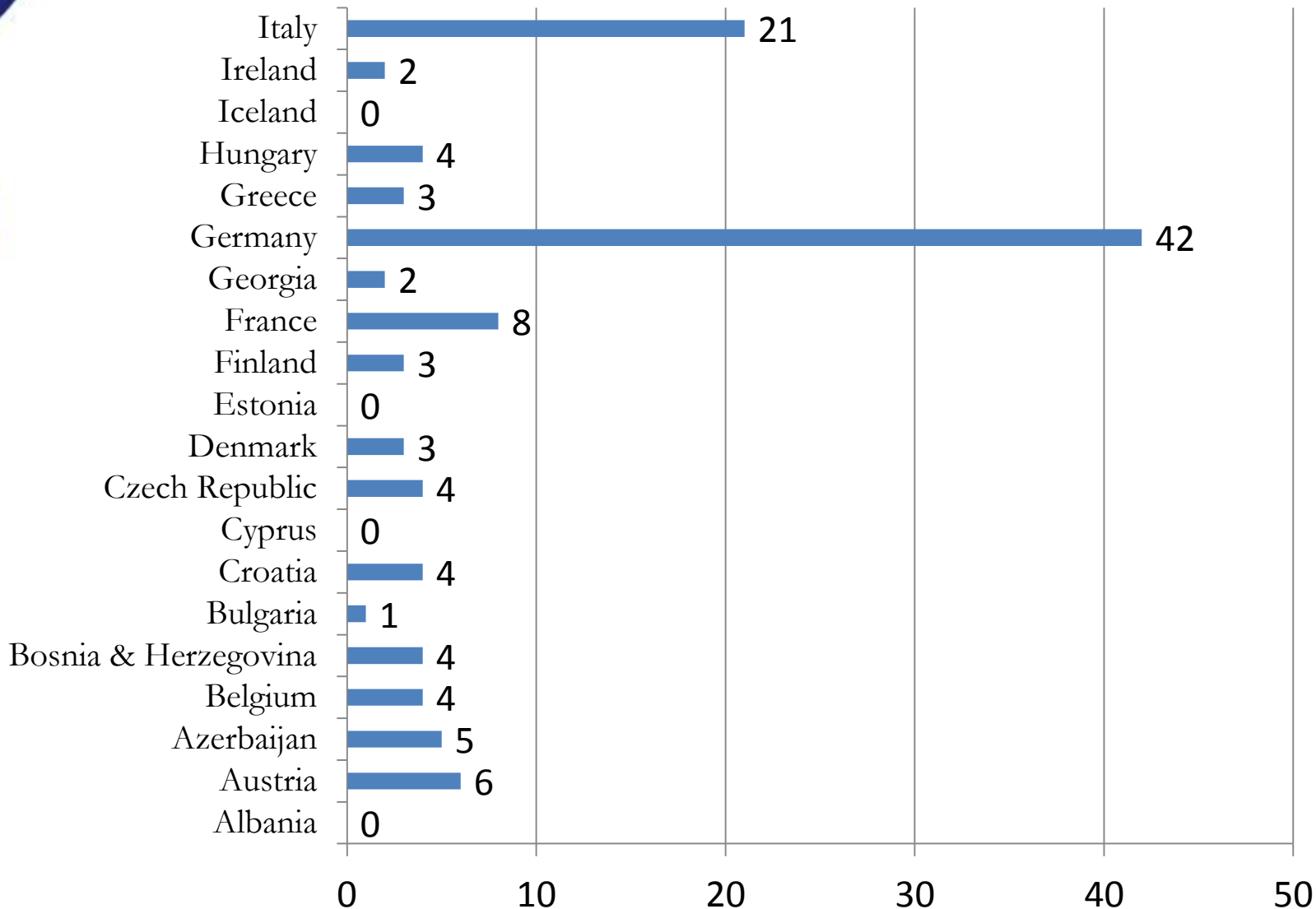

In total 226 Local Groups + 7 National Groups without Local Groups



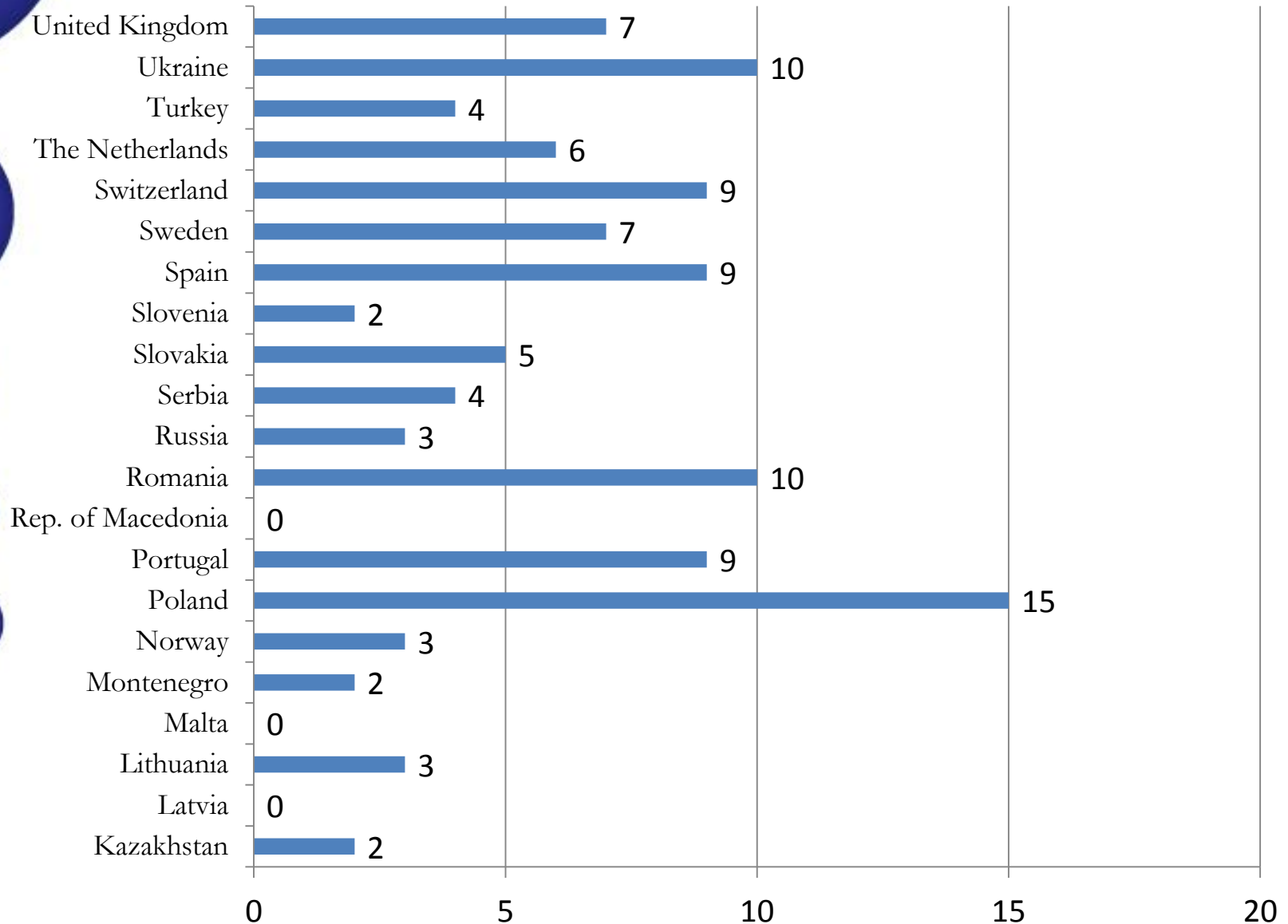
2. How many of Local Groups do you have?

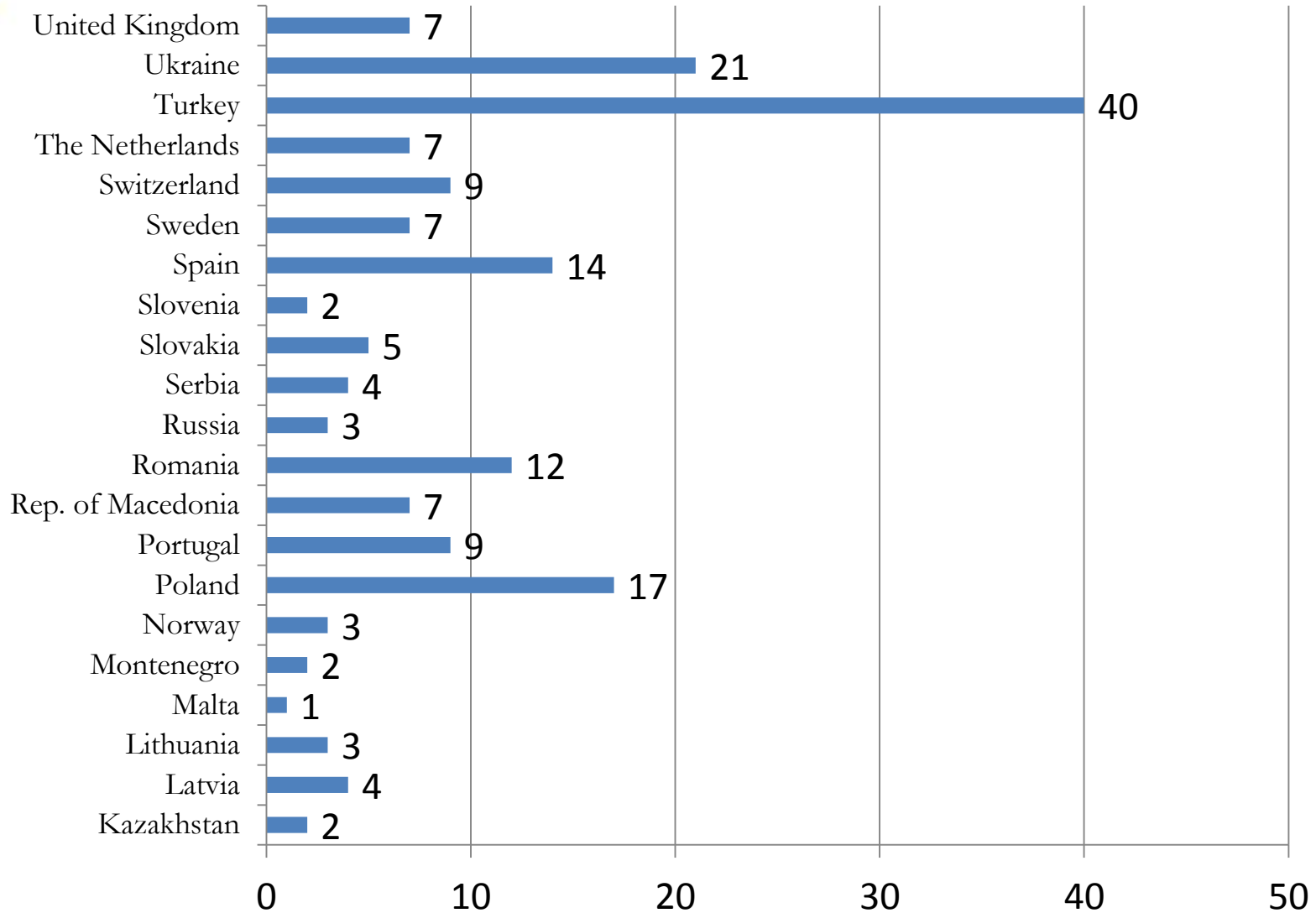


# Number of law faculties LG-s cover

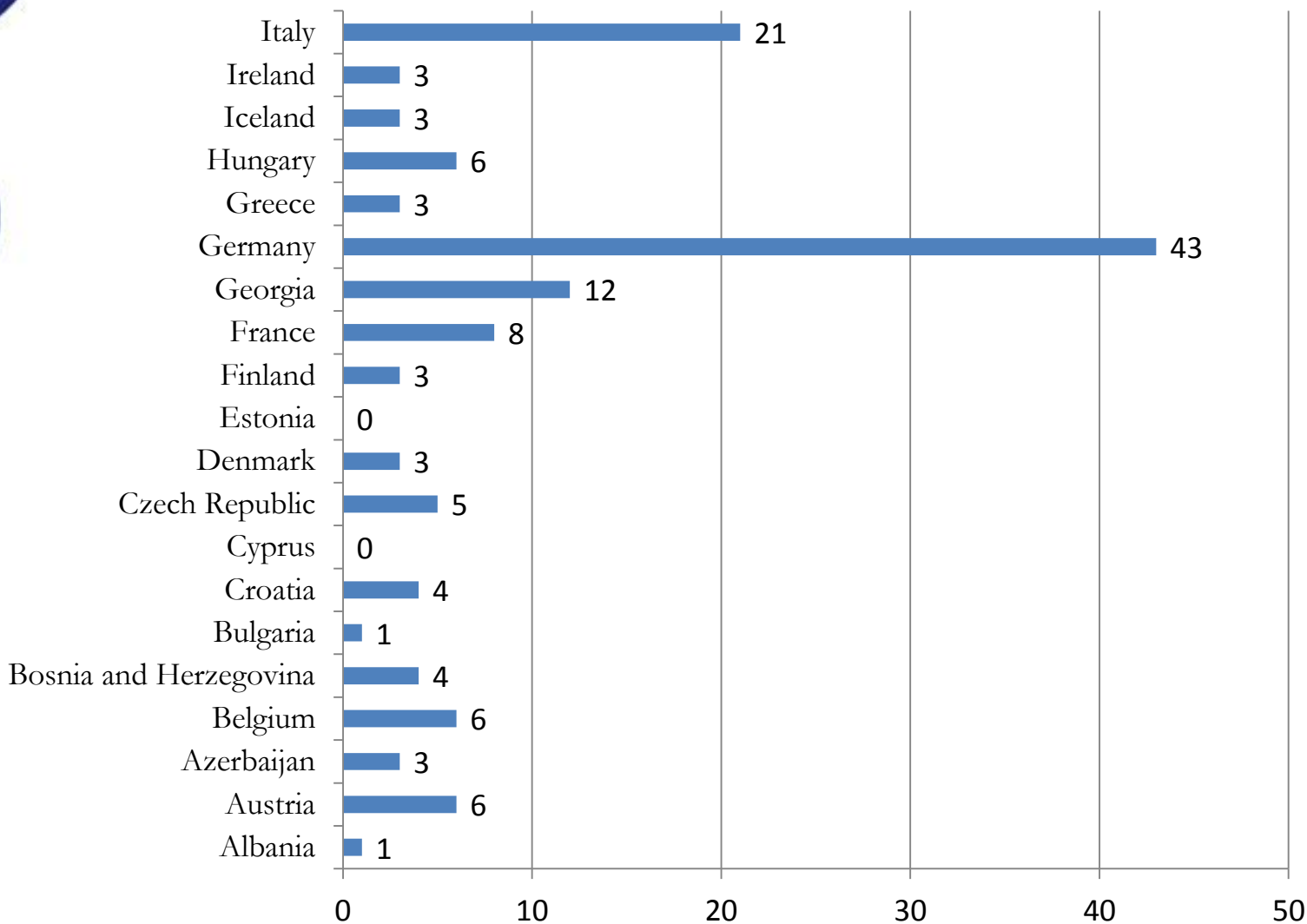
3. How many law faculties do your Local Groups cover?

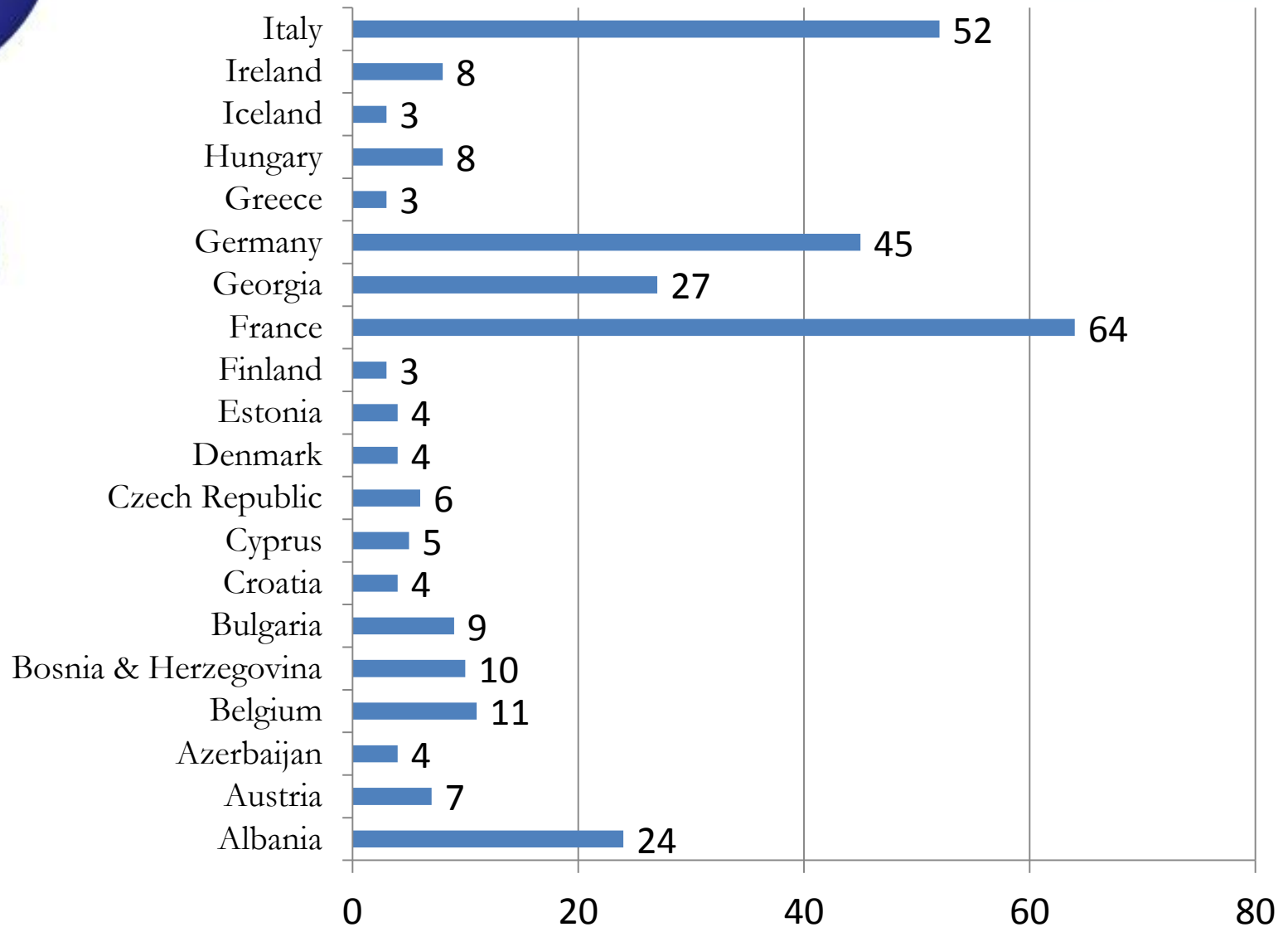

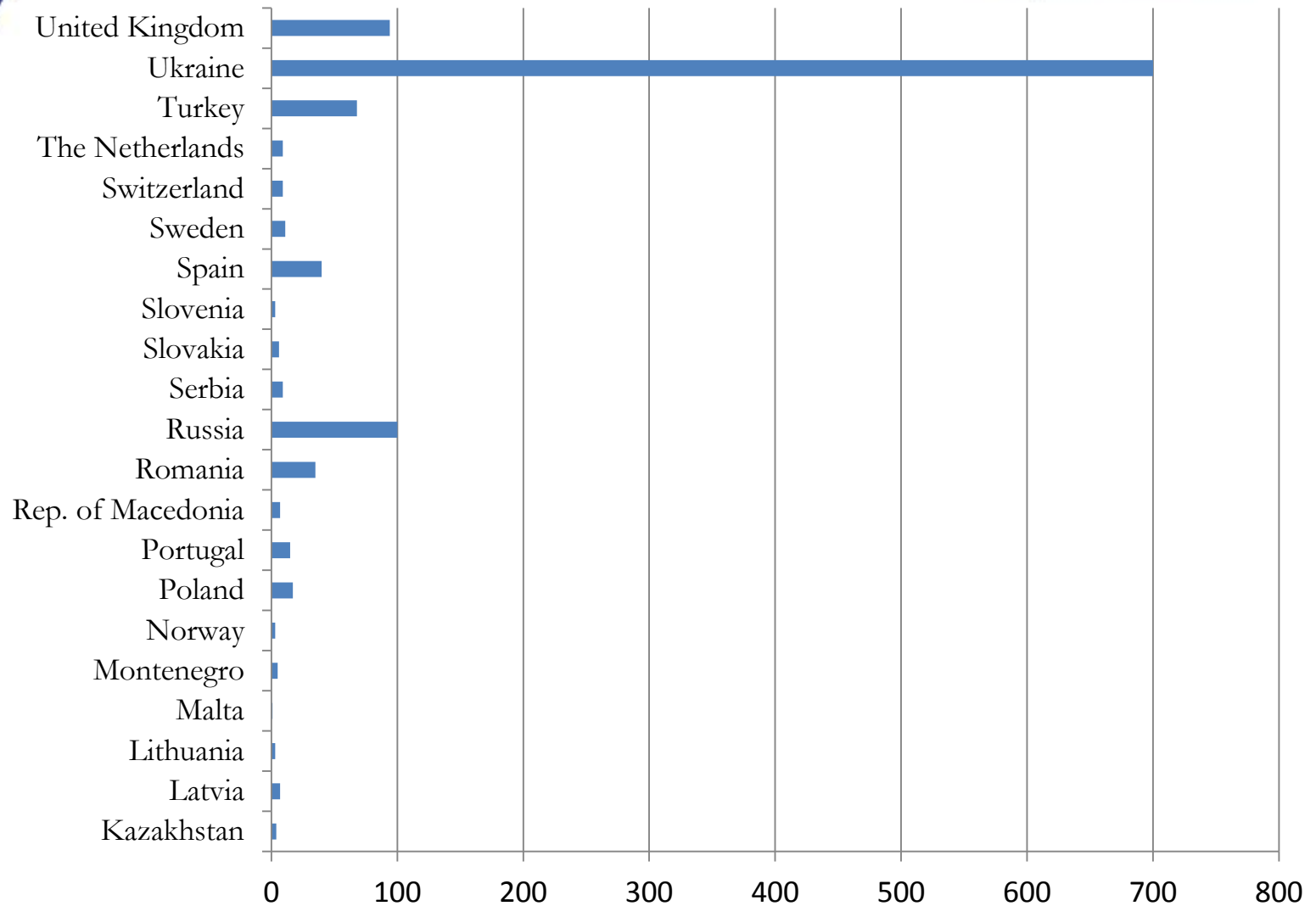
4. How many Law faculties are there in your country all together?

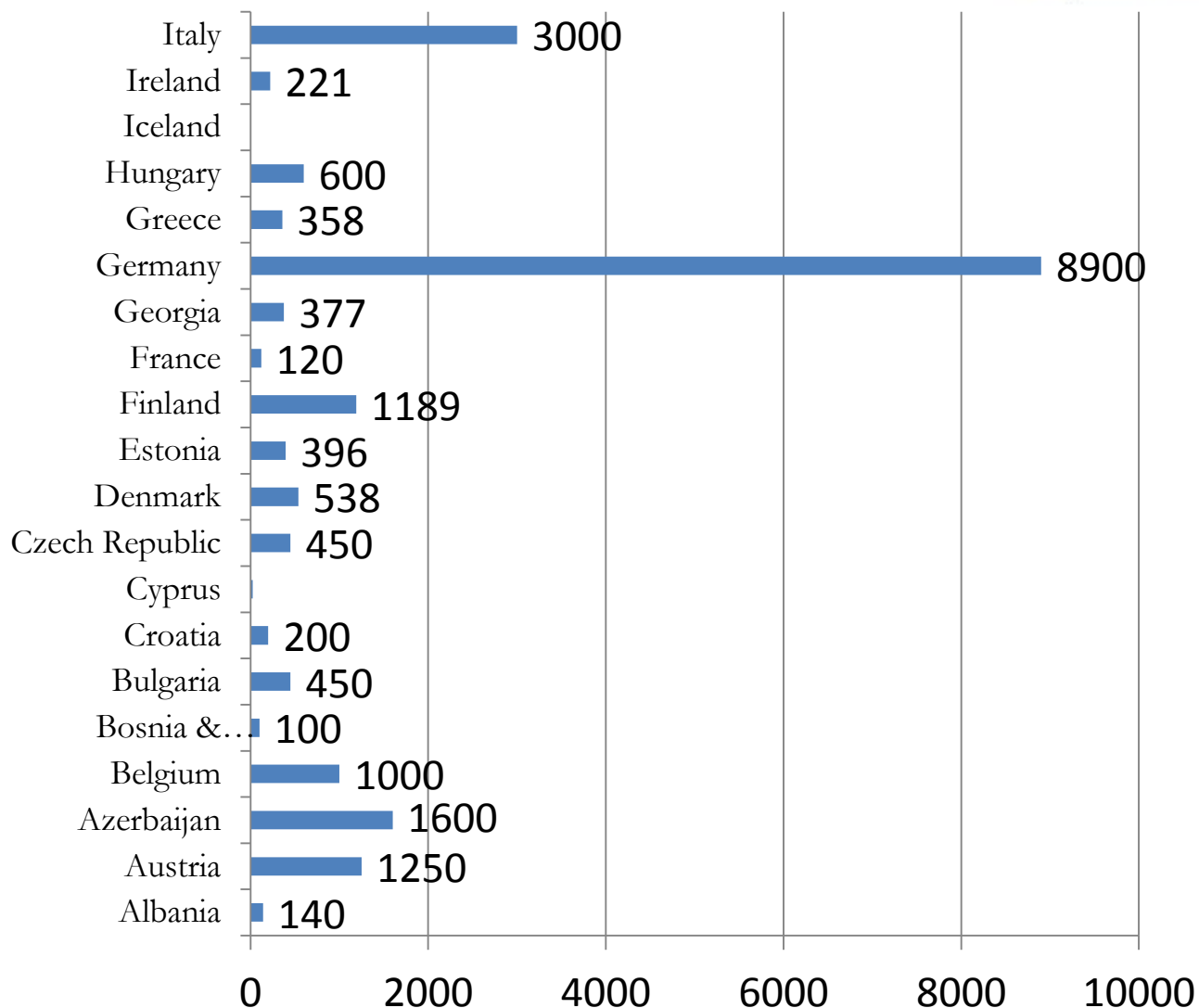

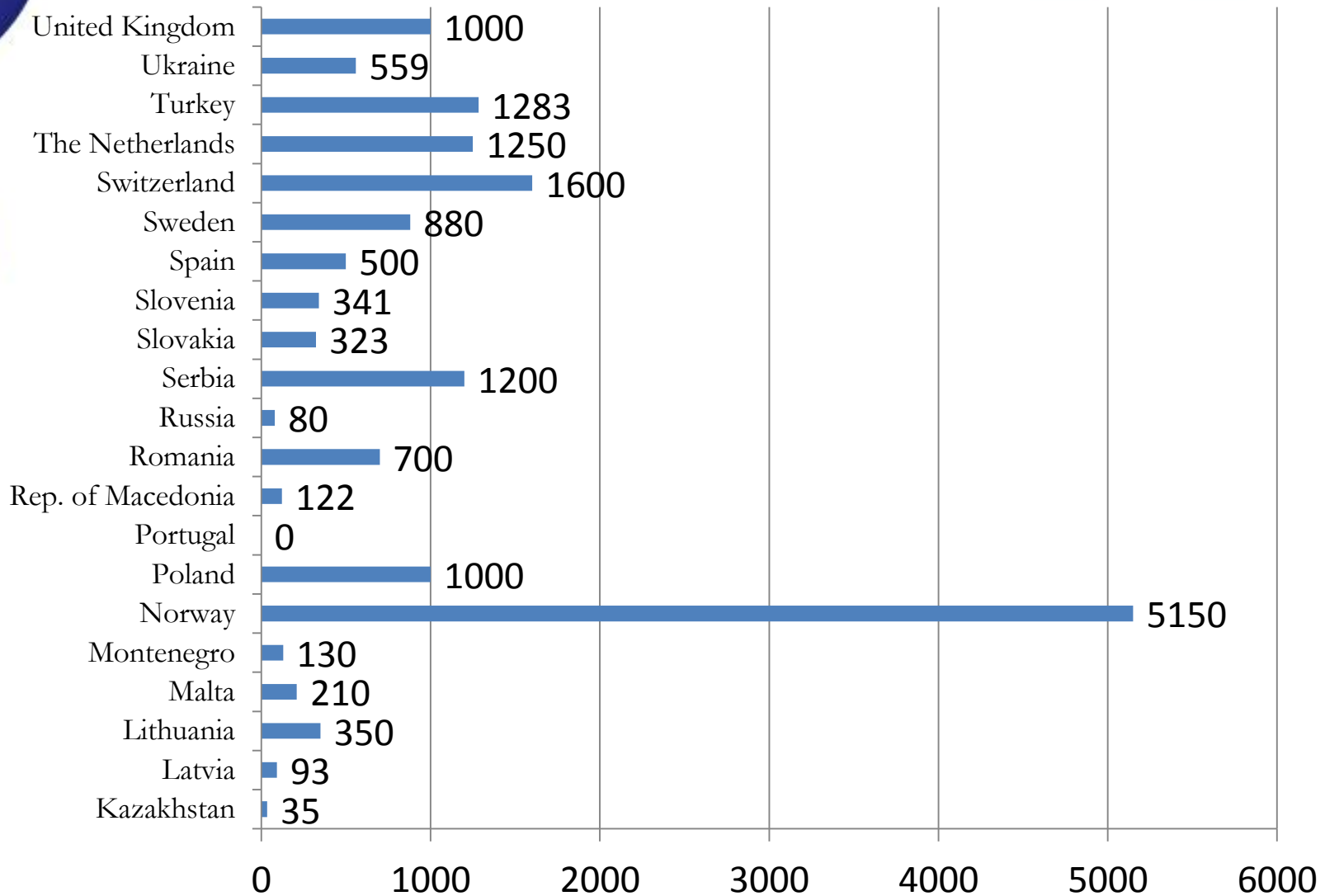


5. How many individual members in total do you have in your National Group (including Local Groups)?

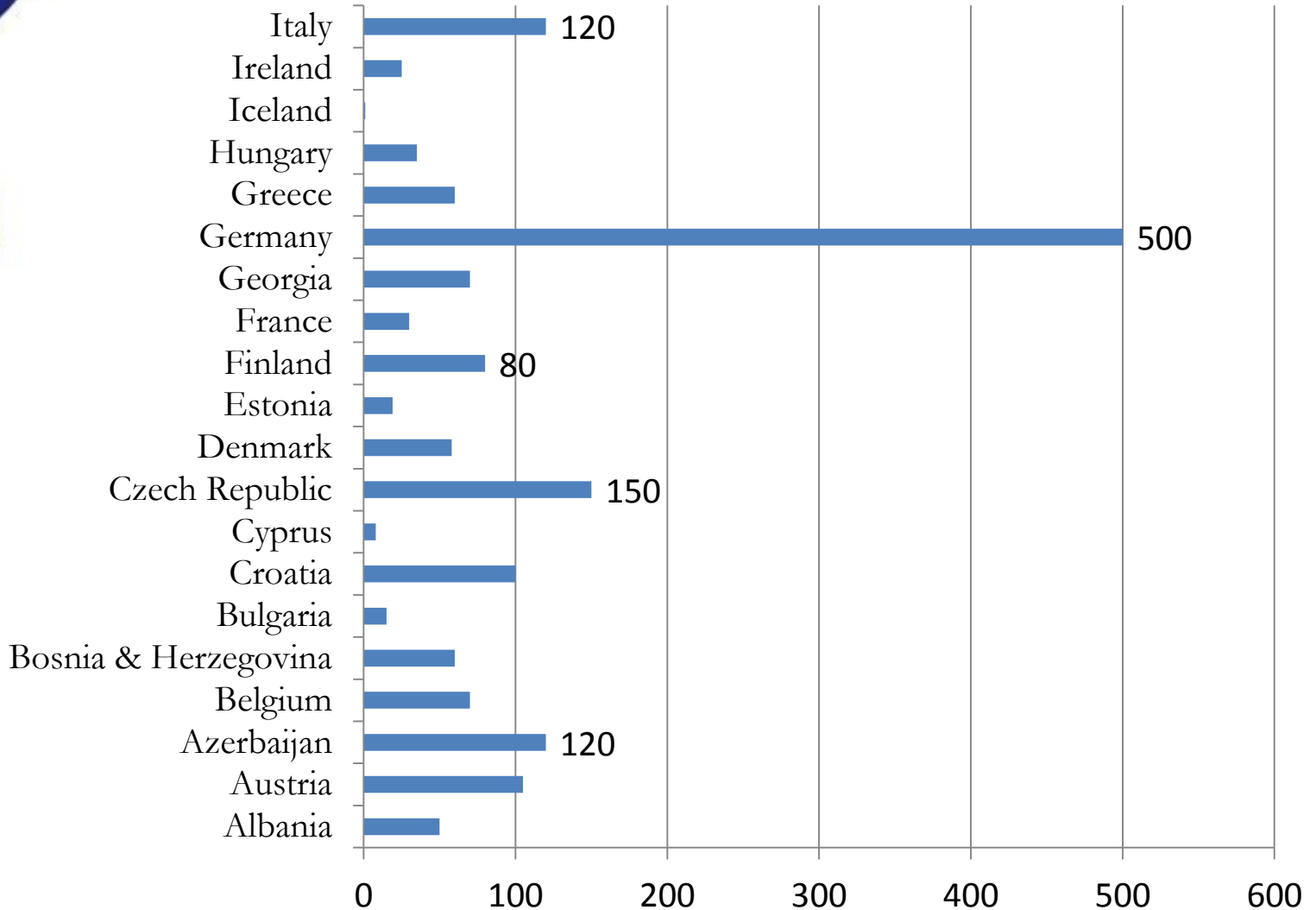


5. How many individual members in total do you have in your National Group?

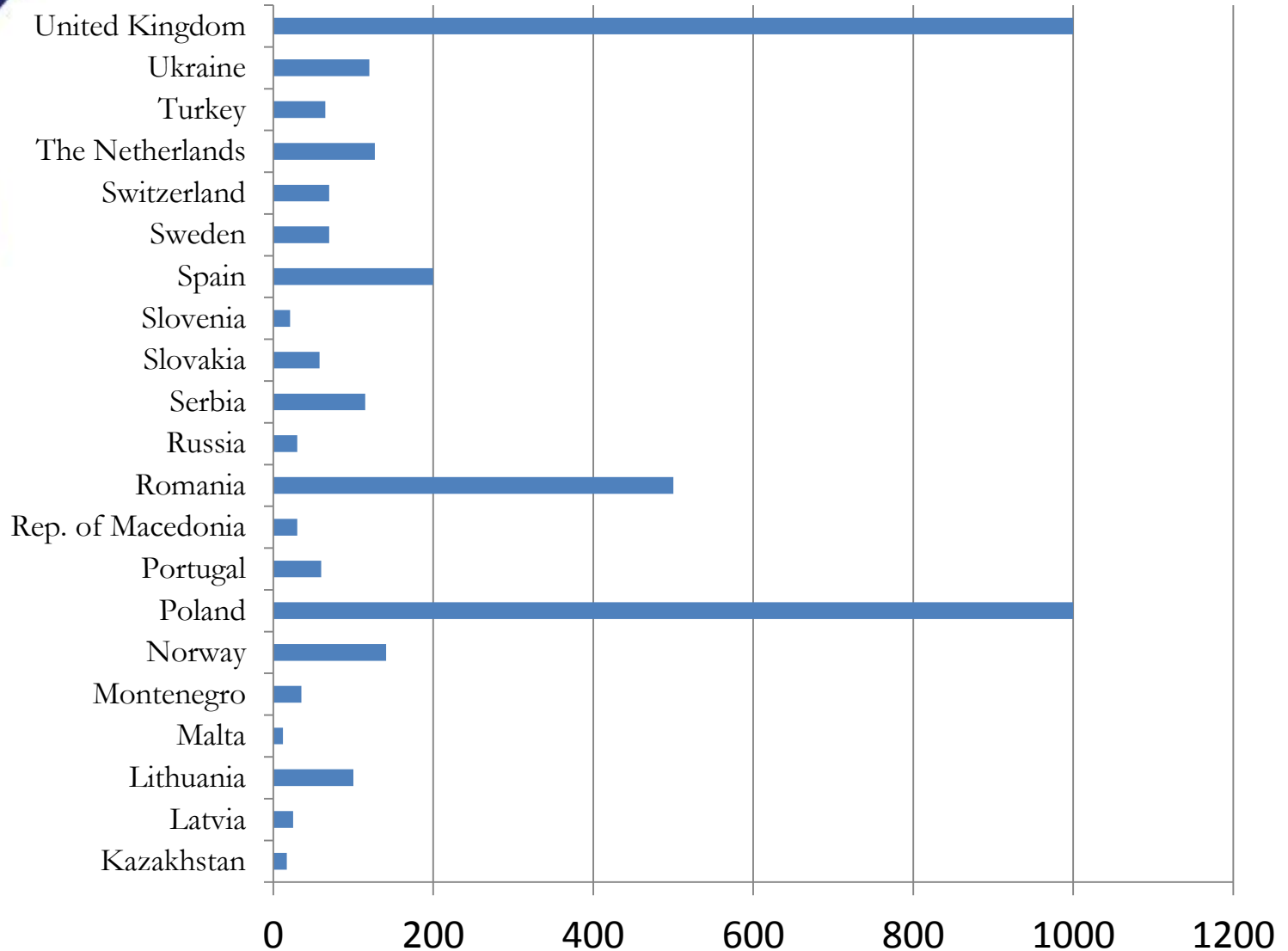


6. How many active members do your National Group and Local Groups have together?

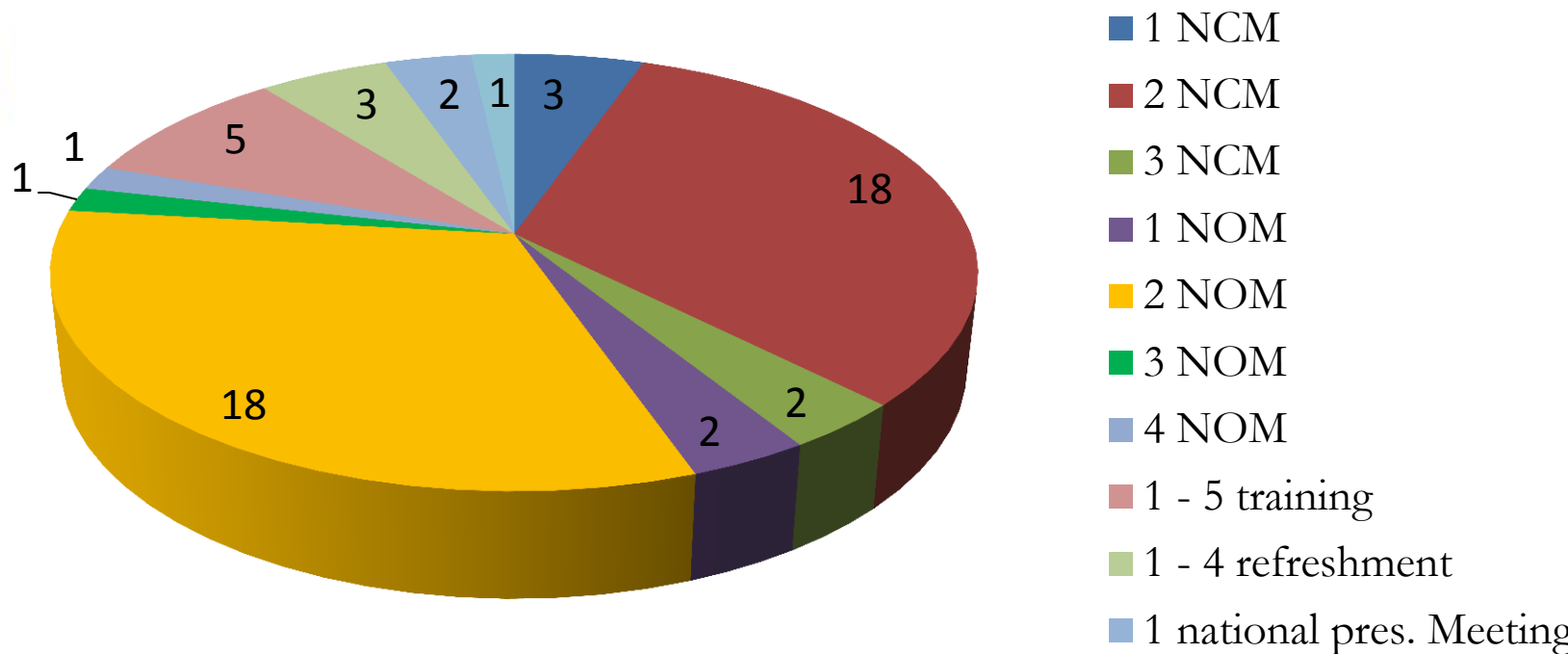

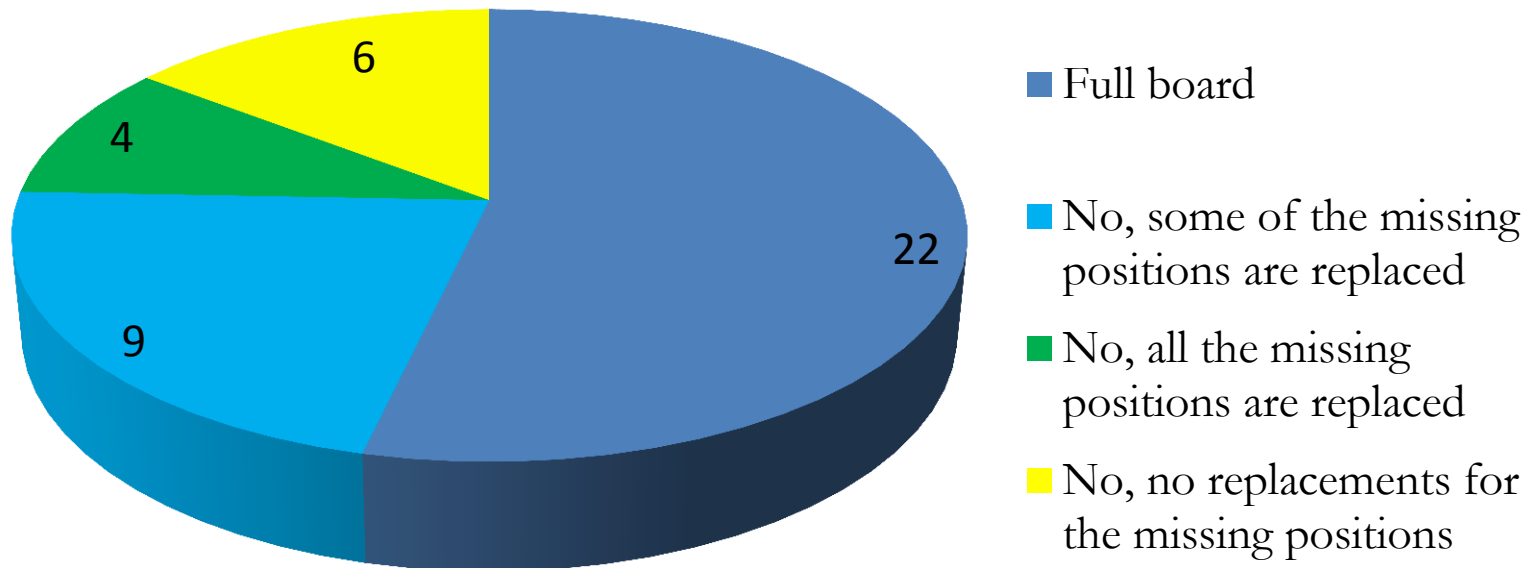

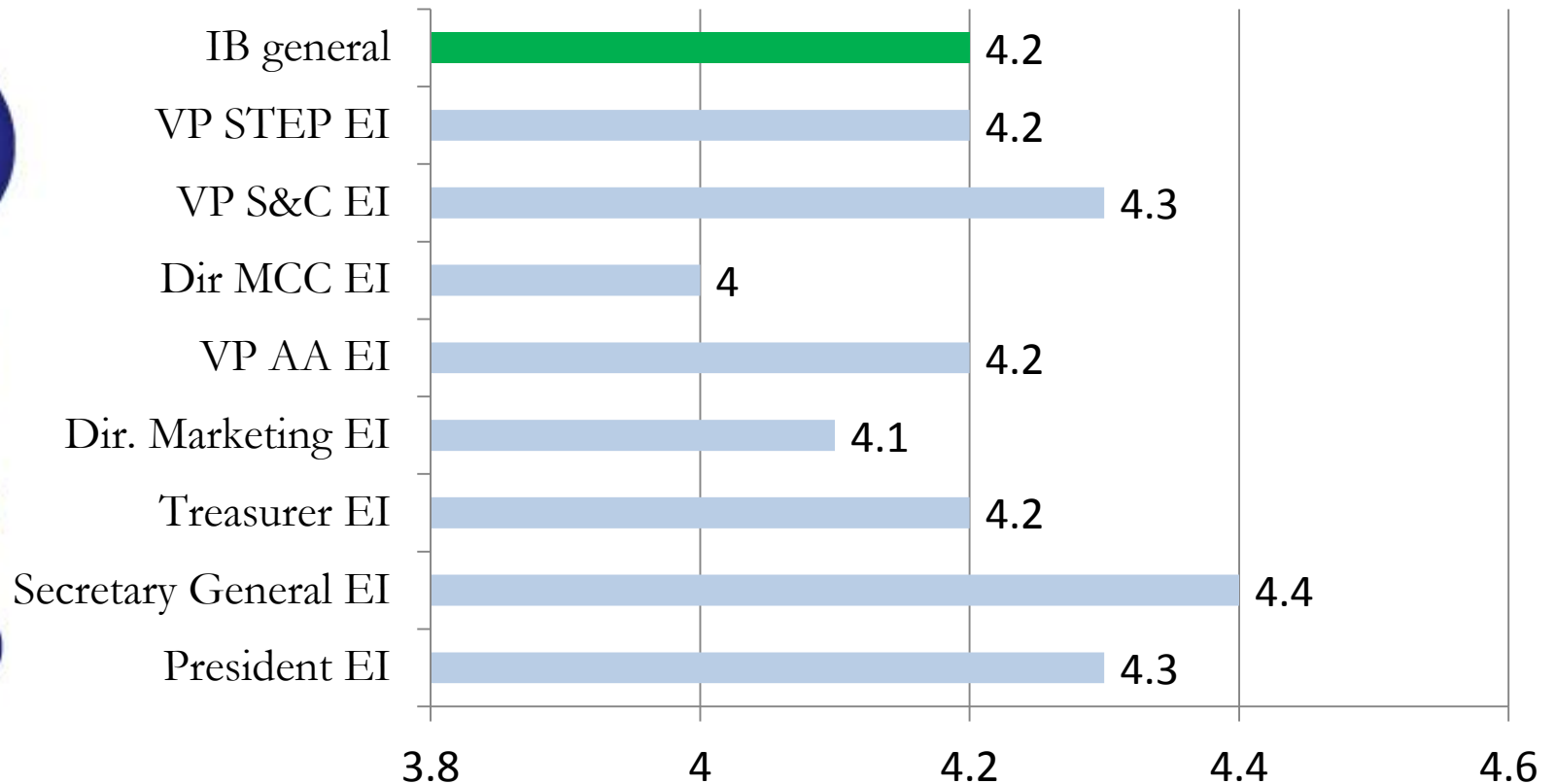

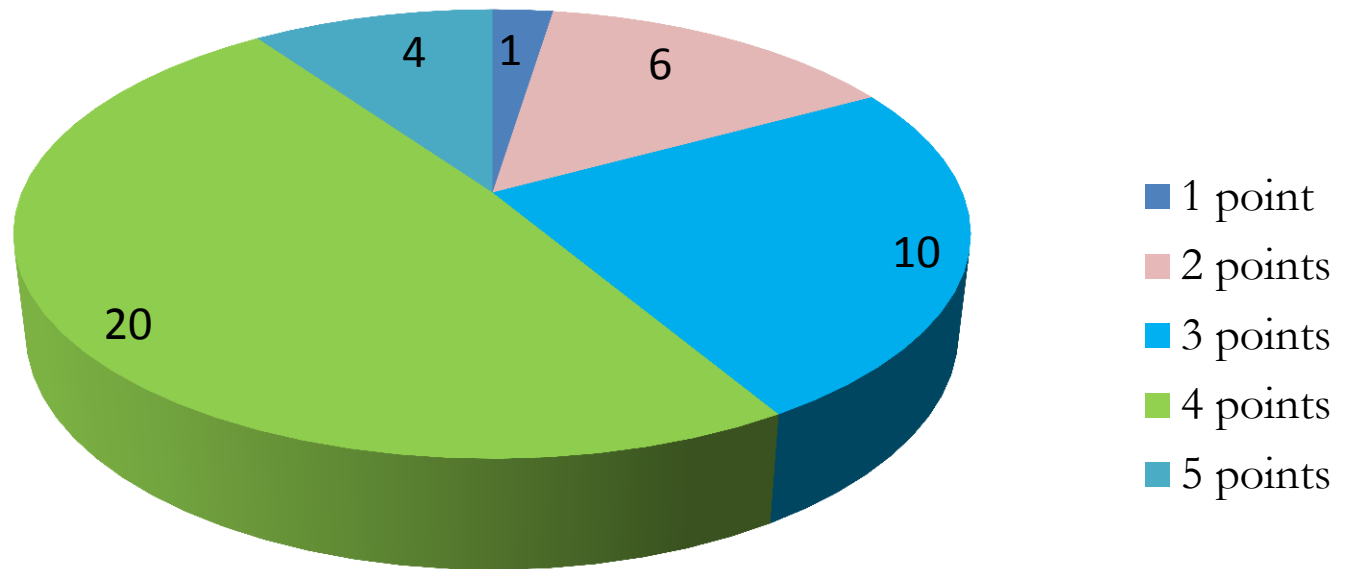

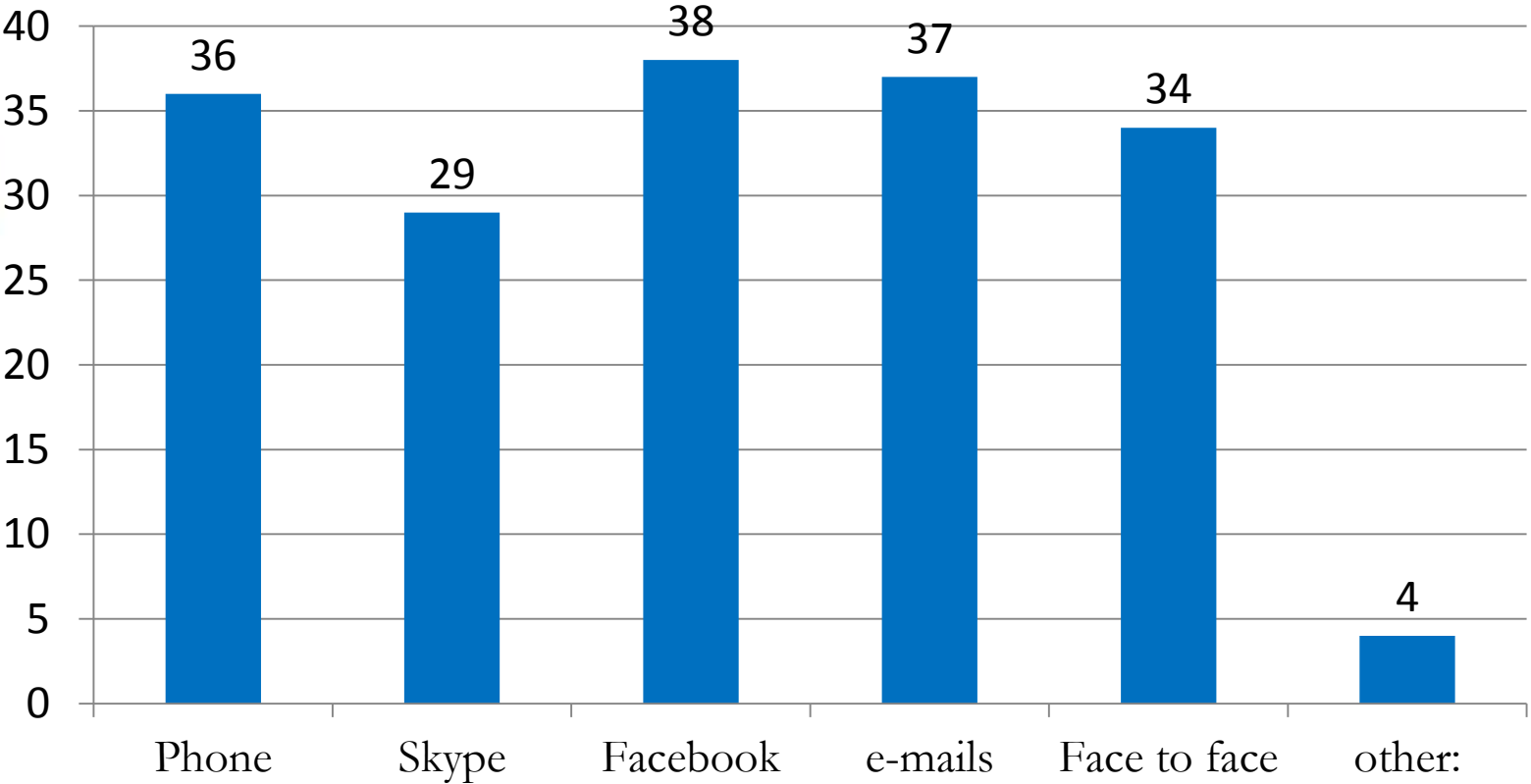

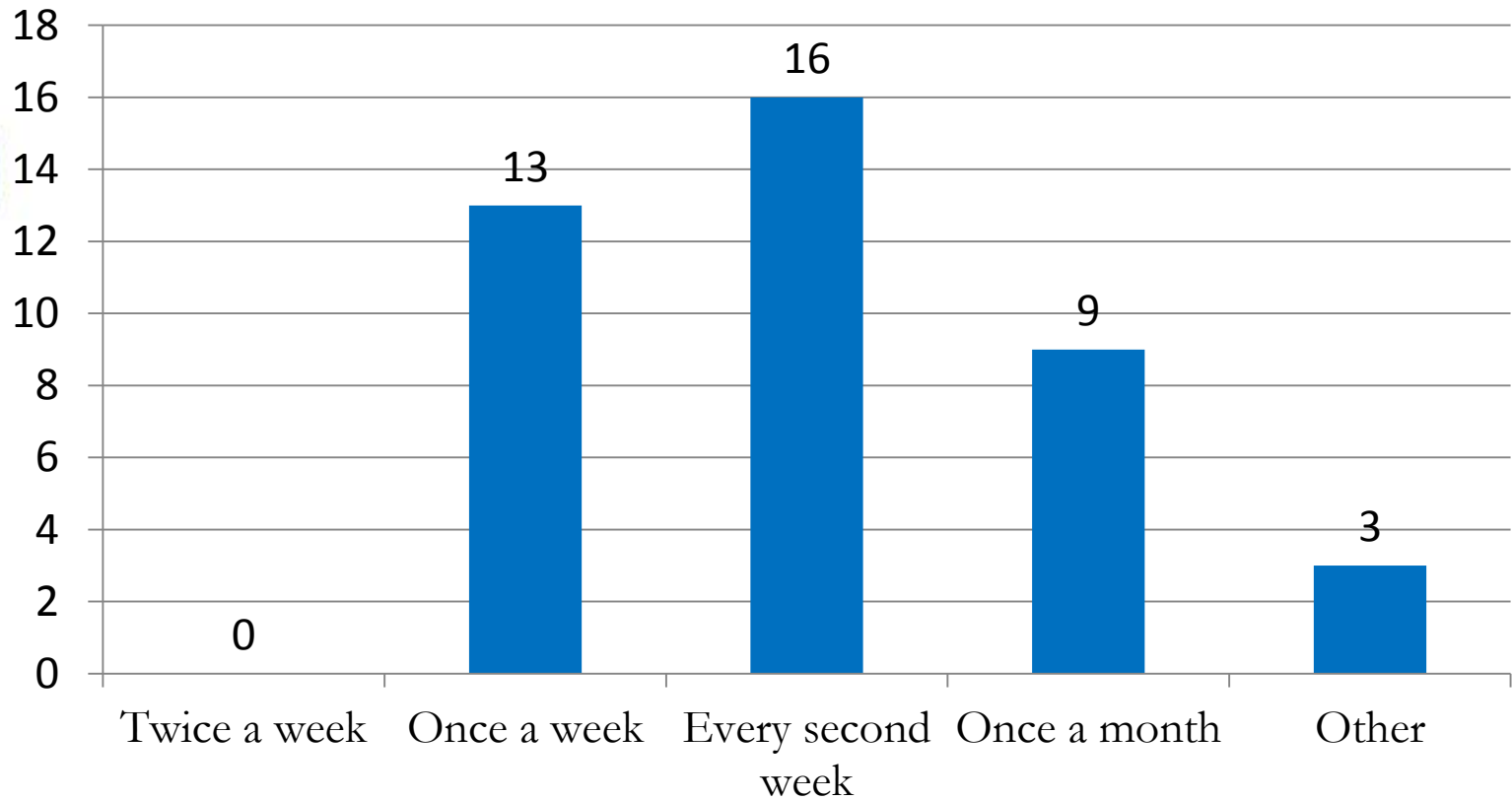

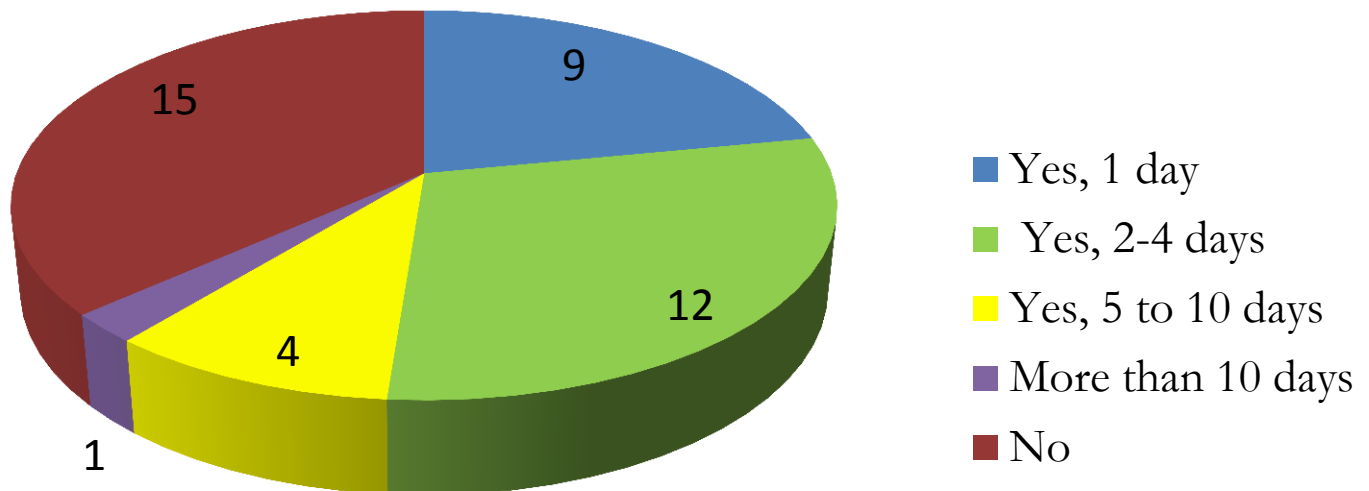

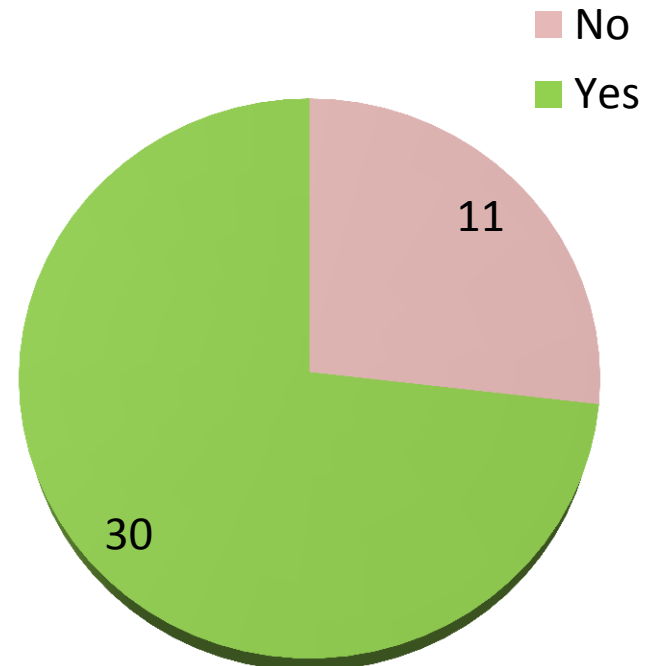

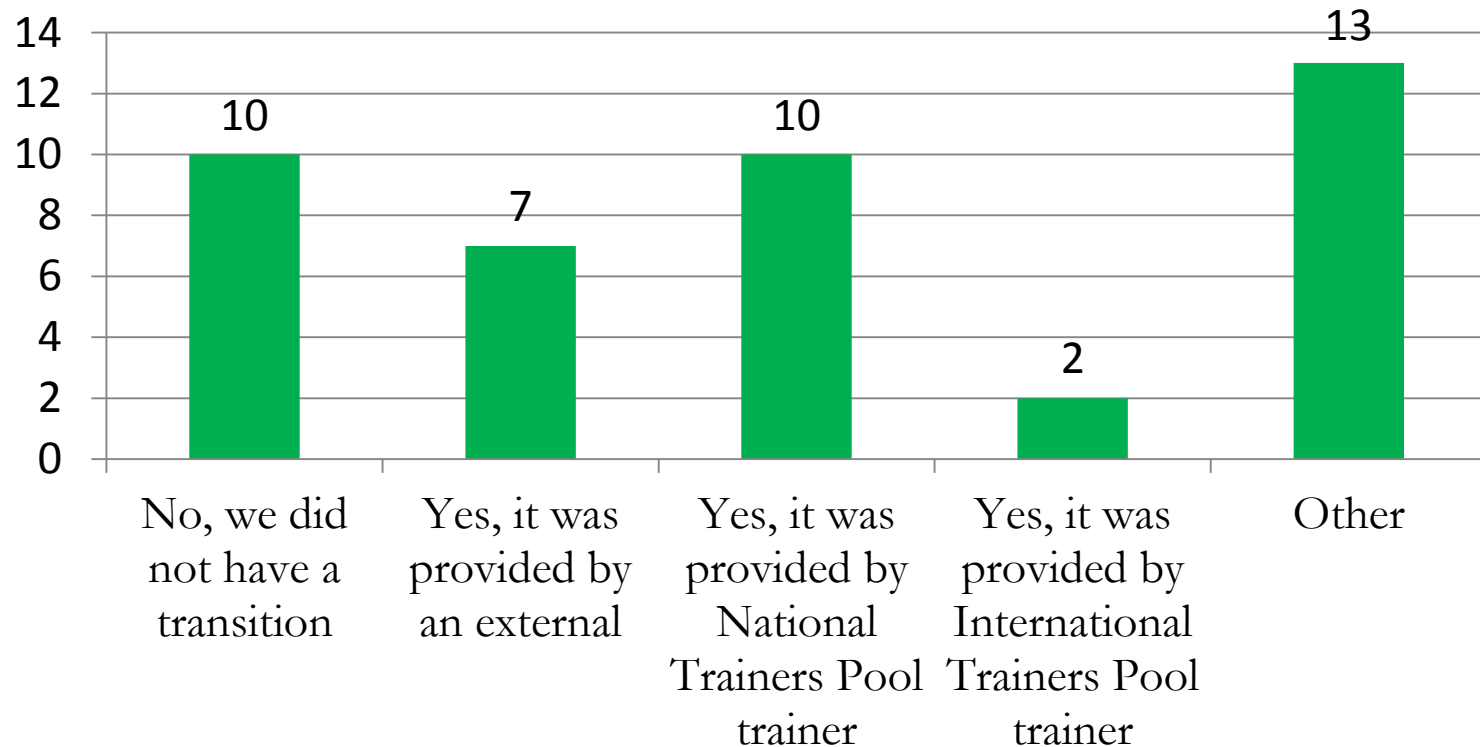

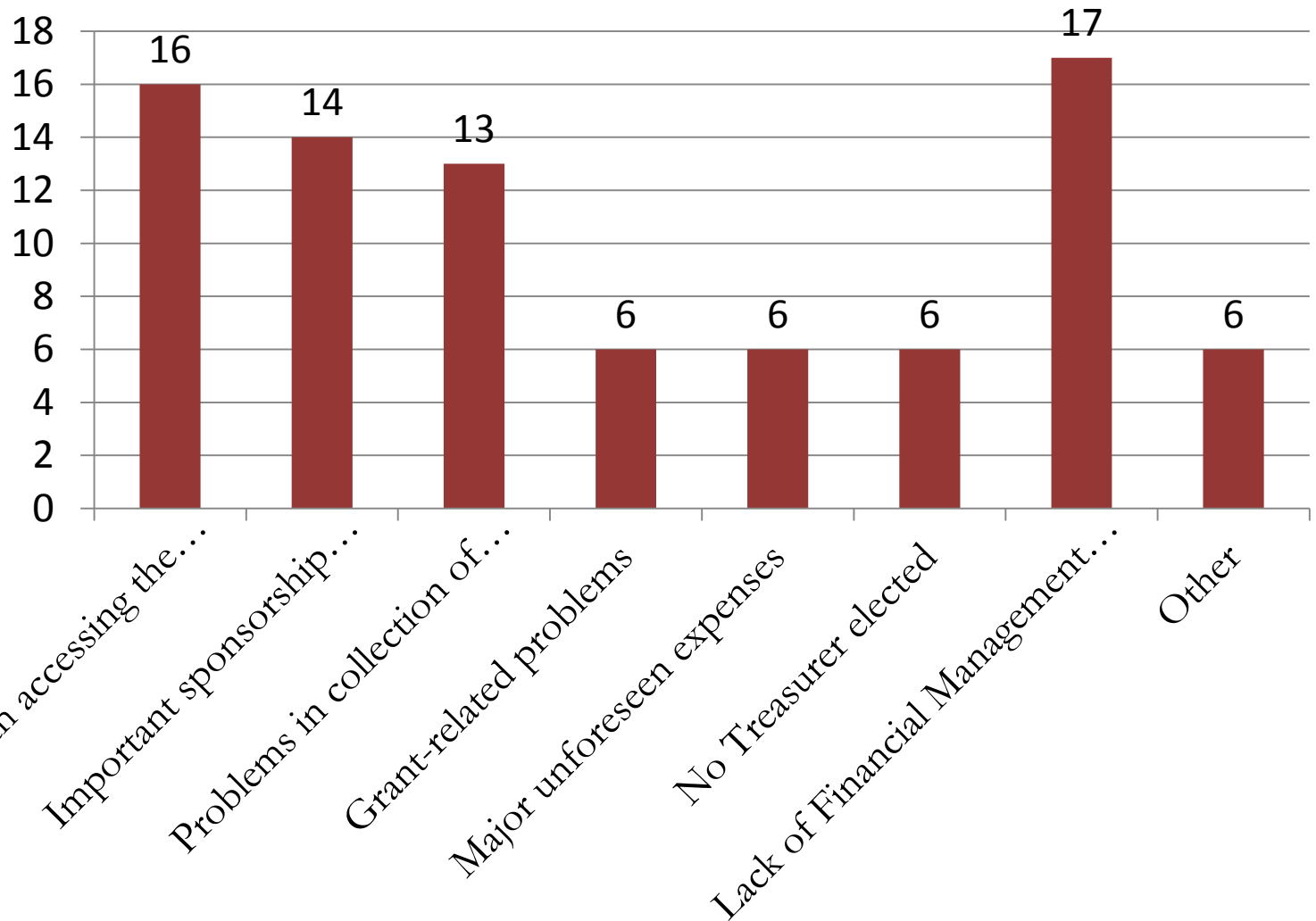

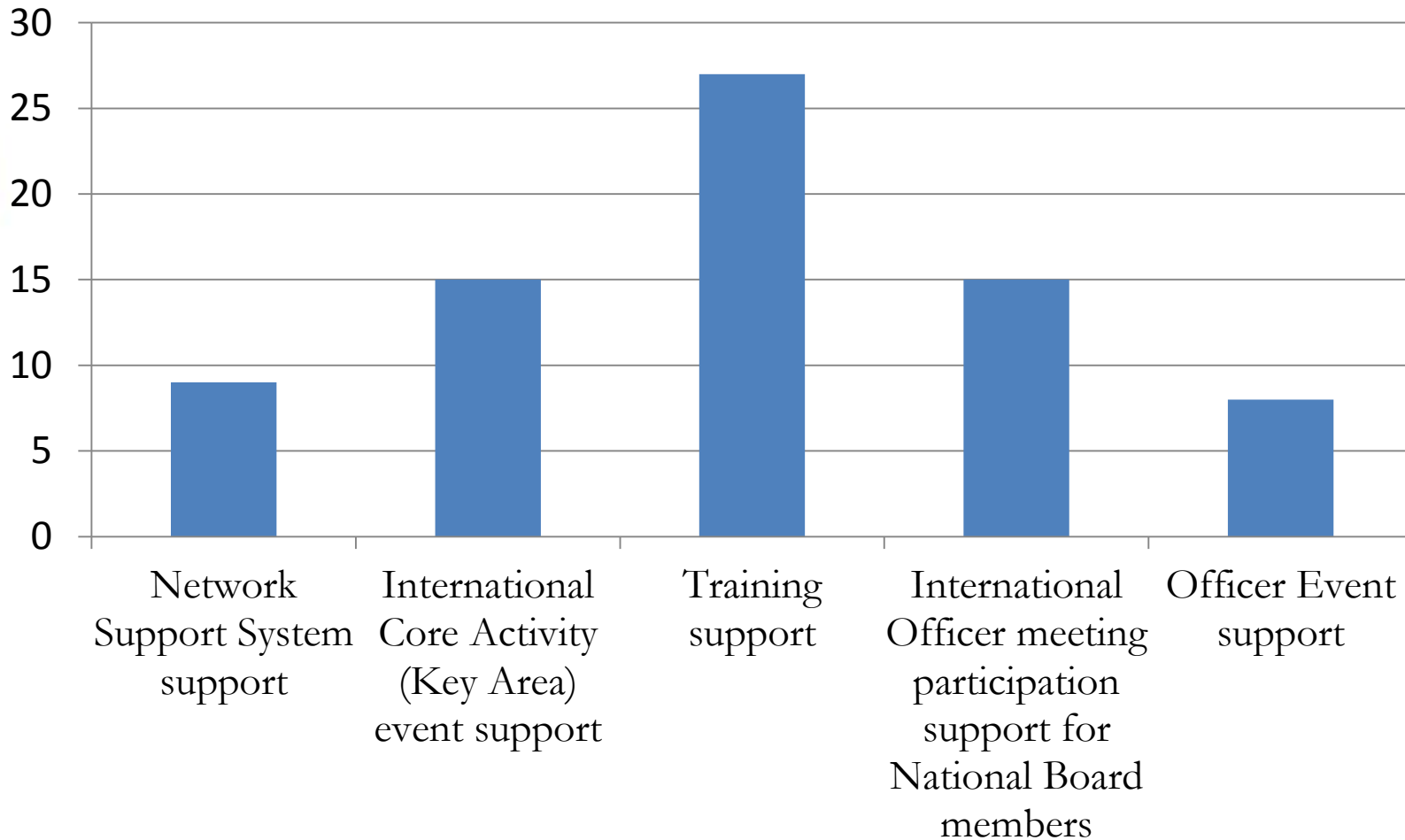


FM 1) What Financial Management difficulties your National Group has faced in the past year?

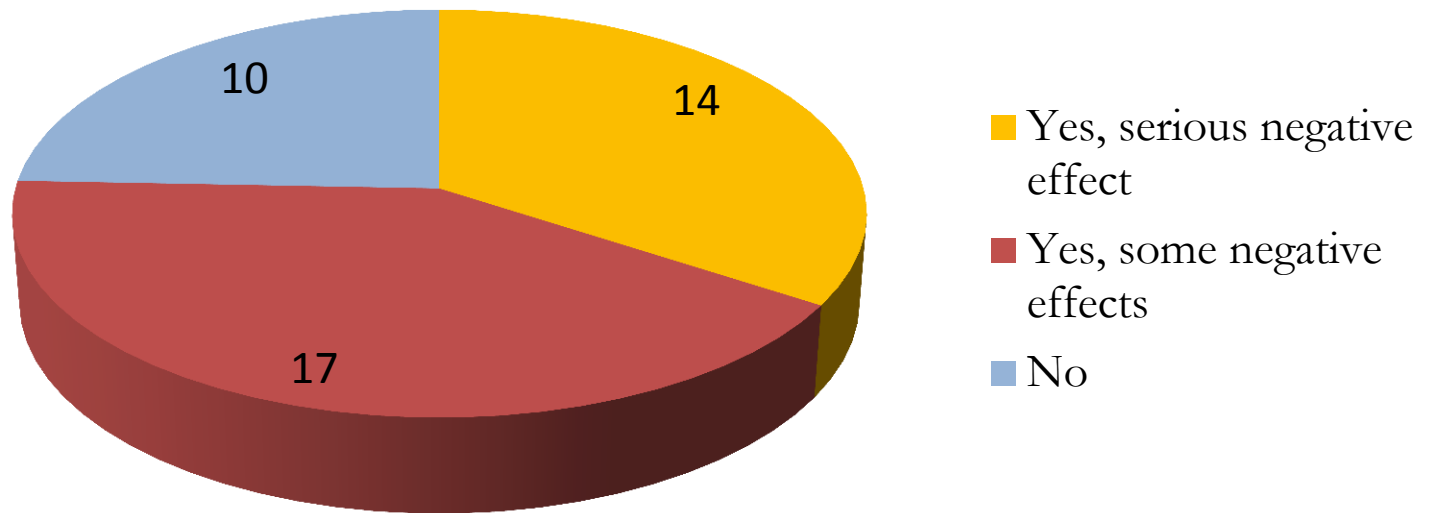

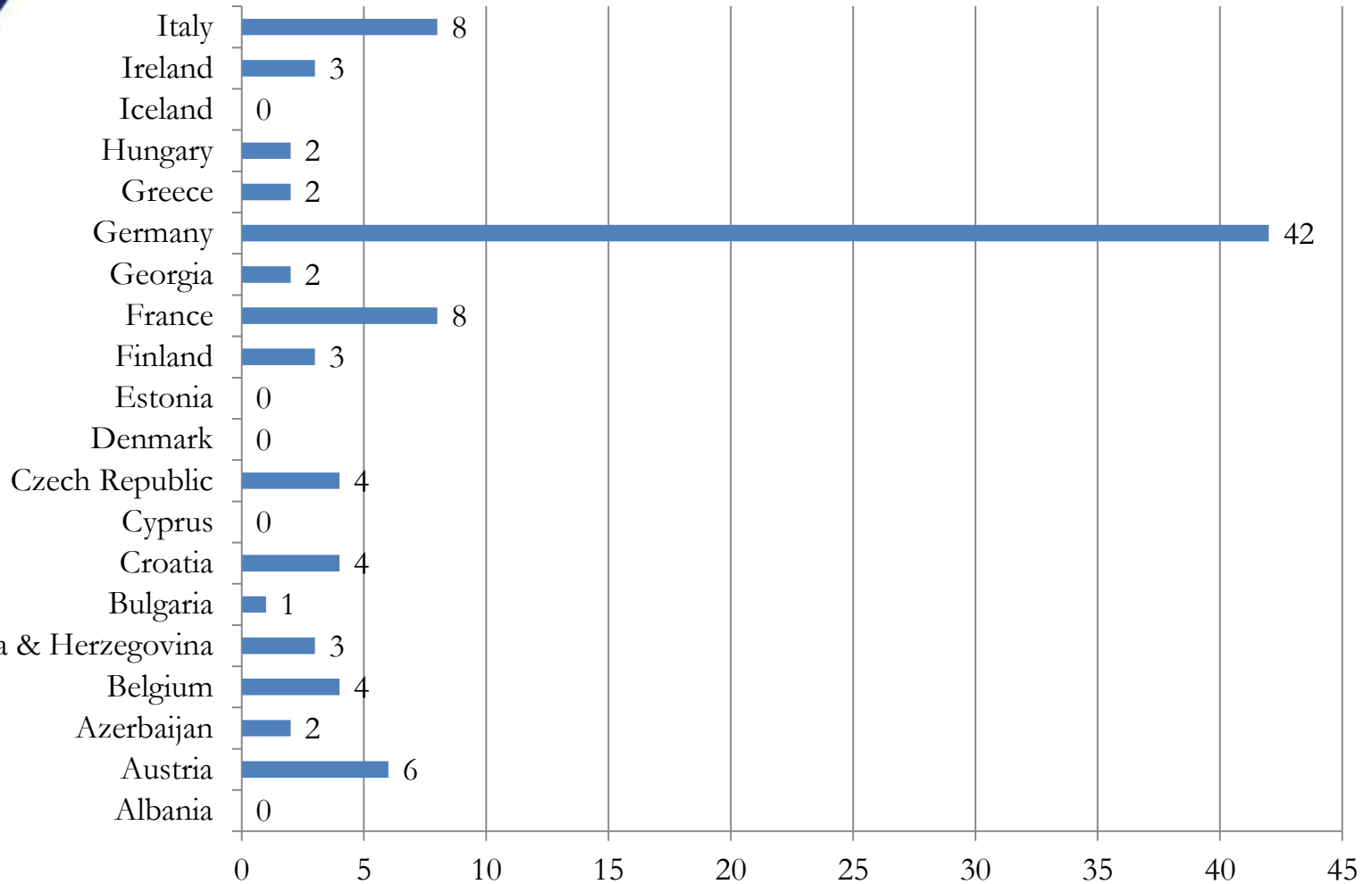

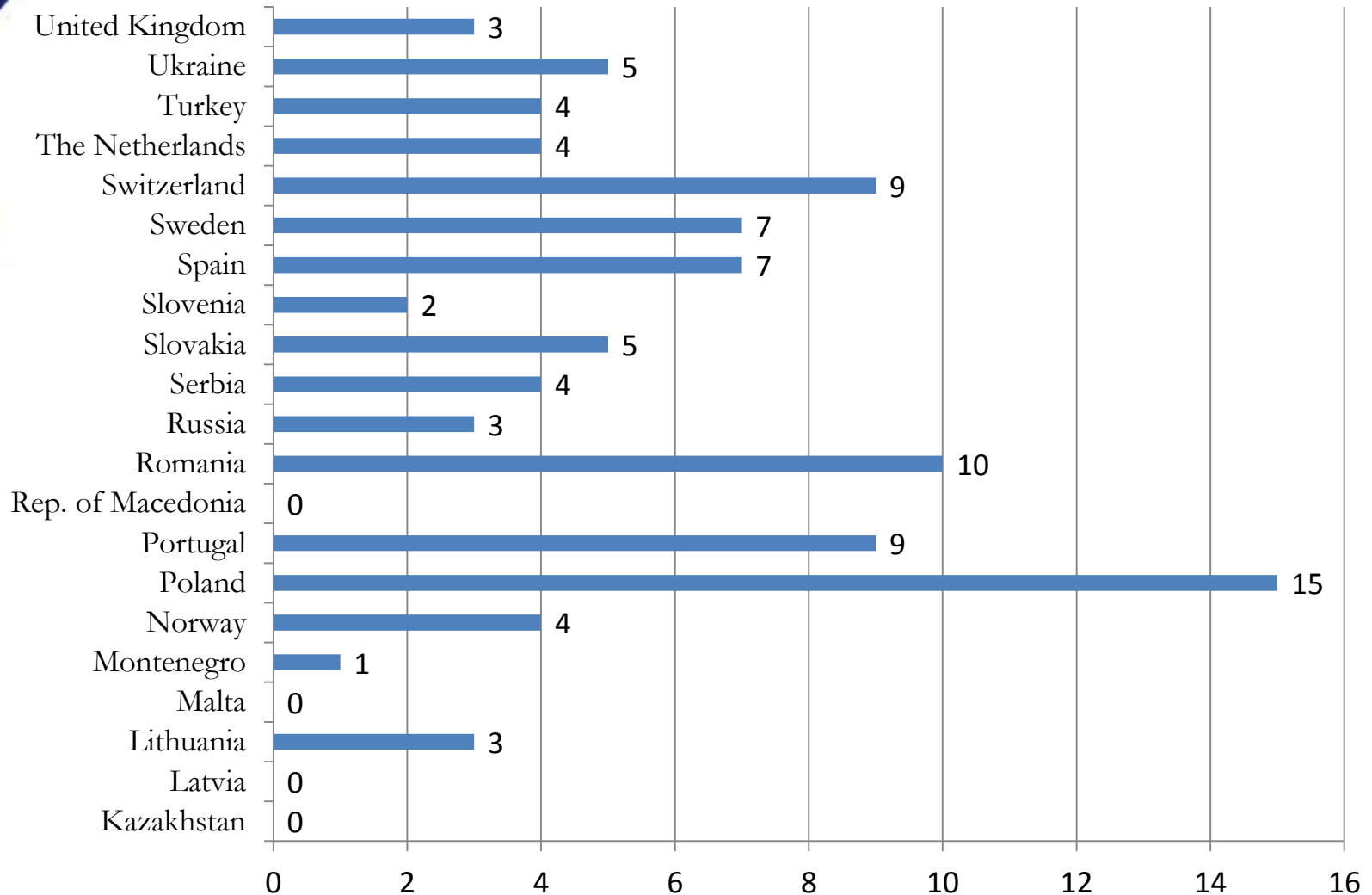


MKT 1) How many of your Local Groups have an official Facebook Page? (Facebook users and Facebook groups excluded)

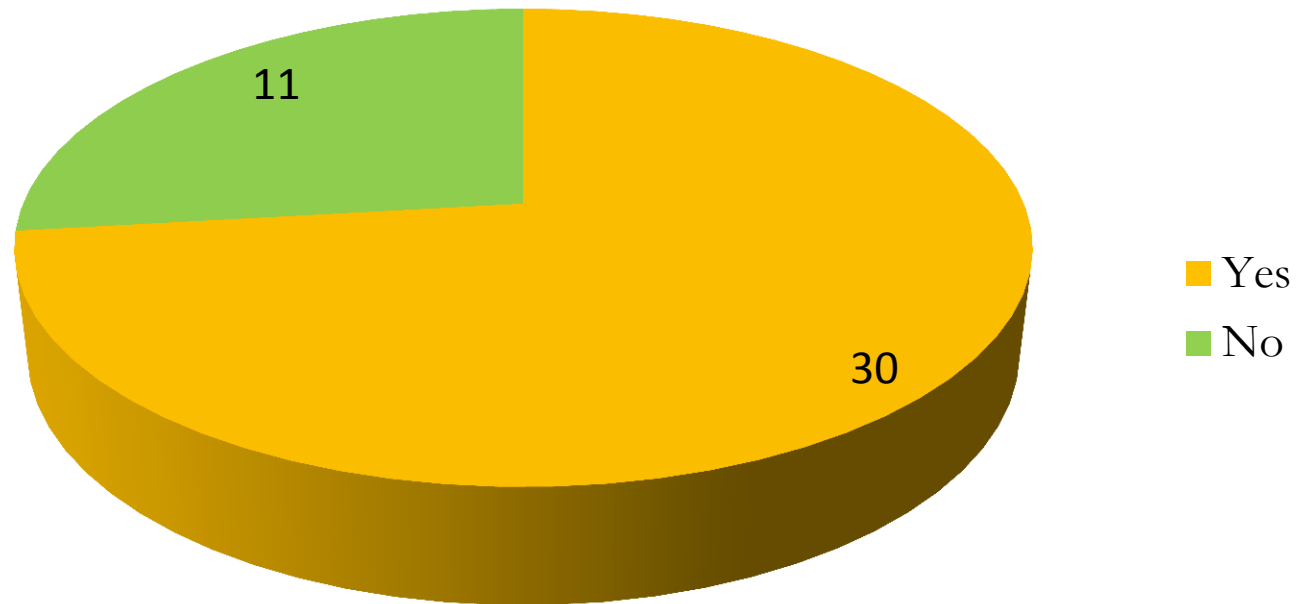

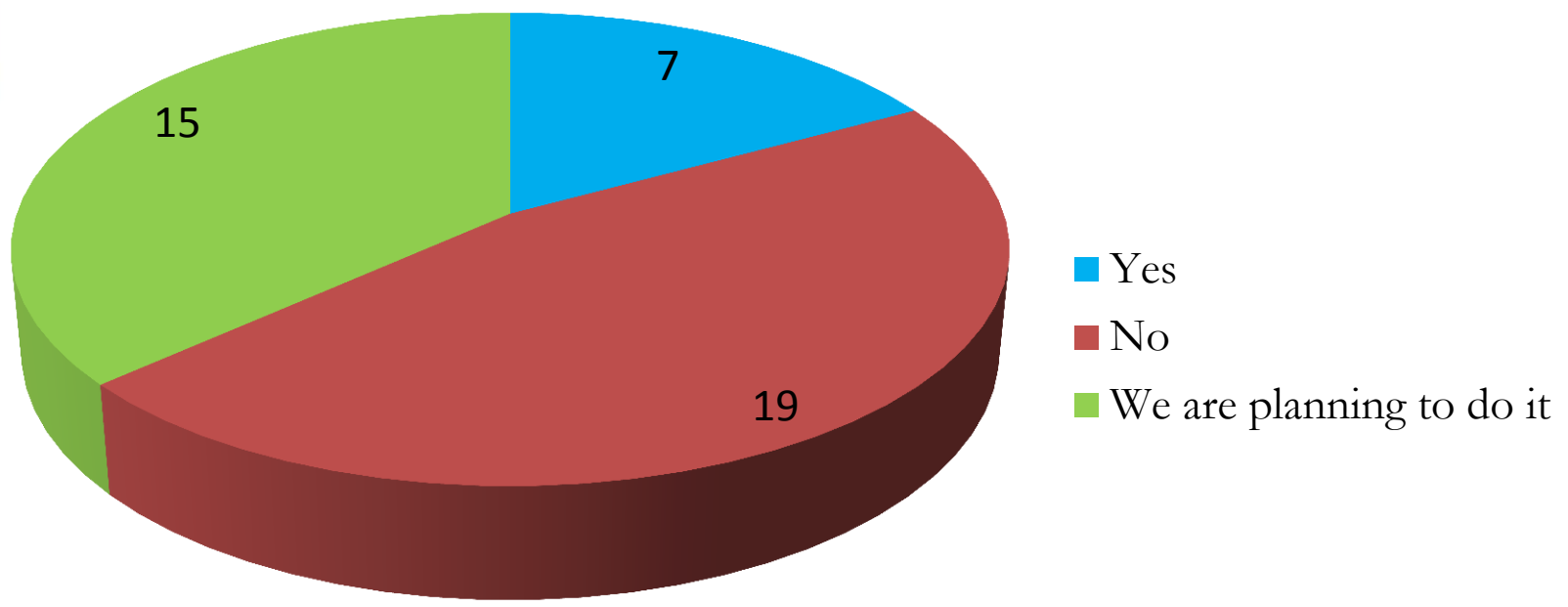


# Have your LG-s distributed Synergy magazine?

# Has your National Group carried out a national Market Research?

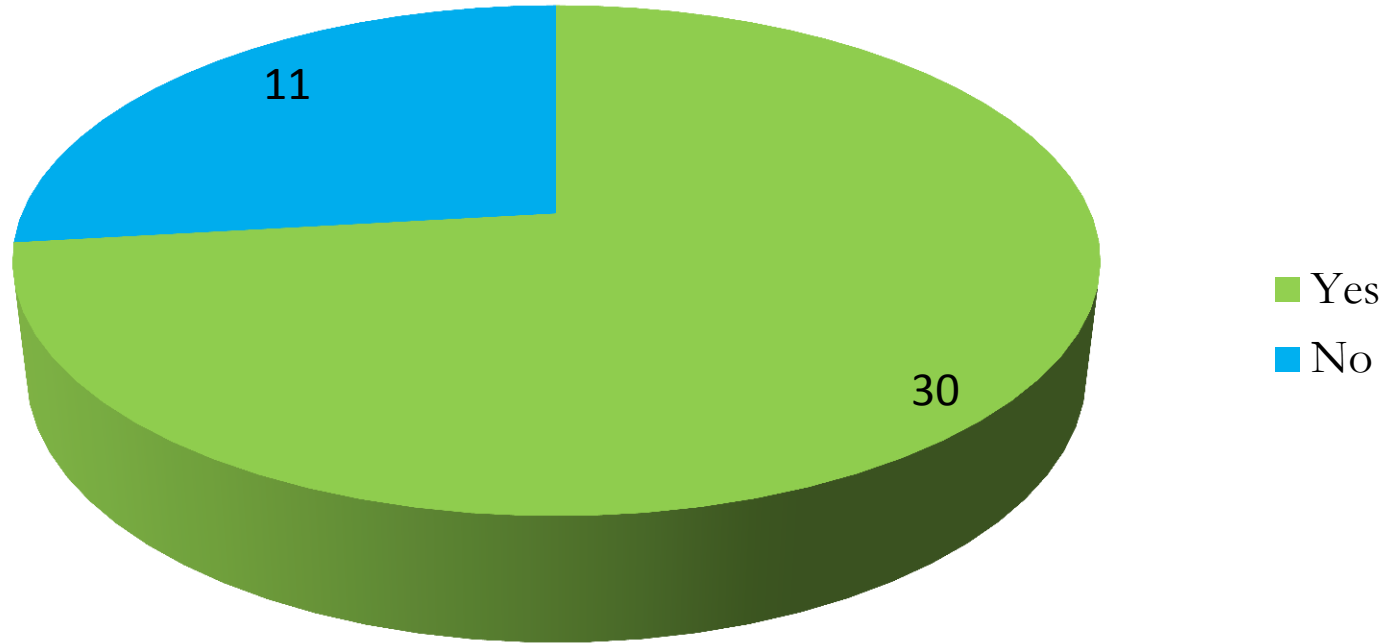

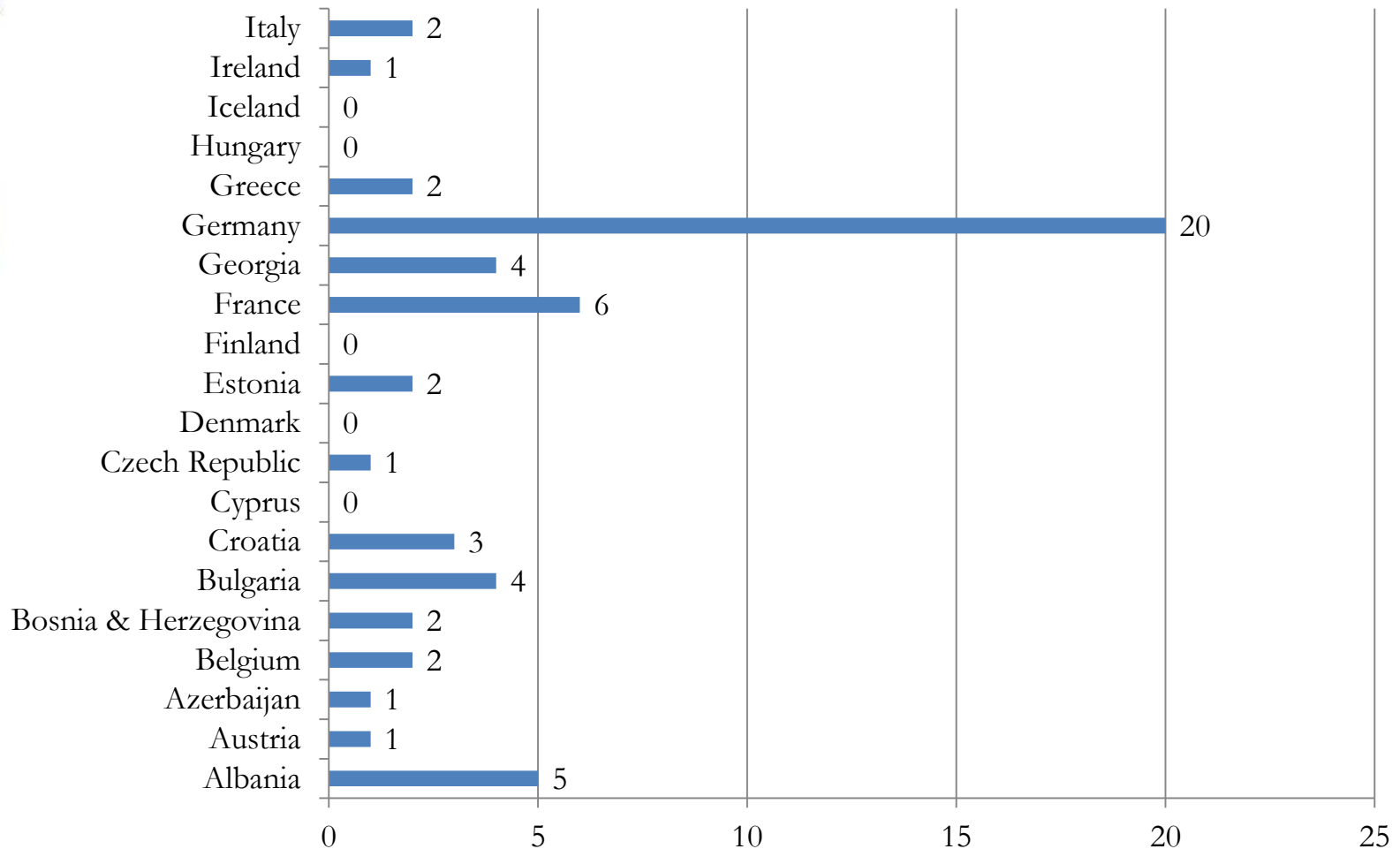

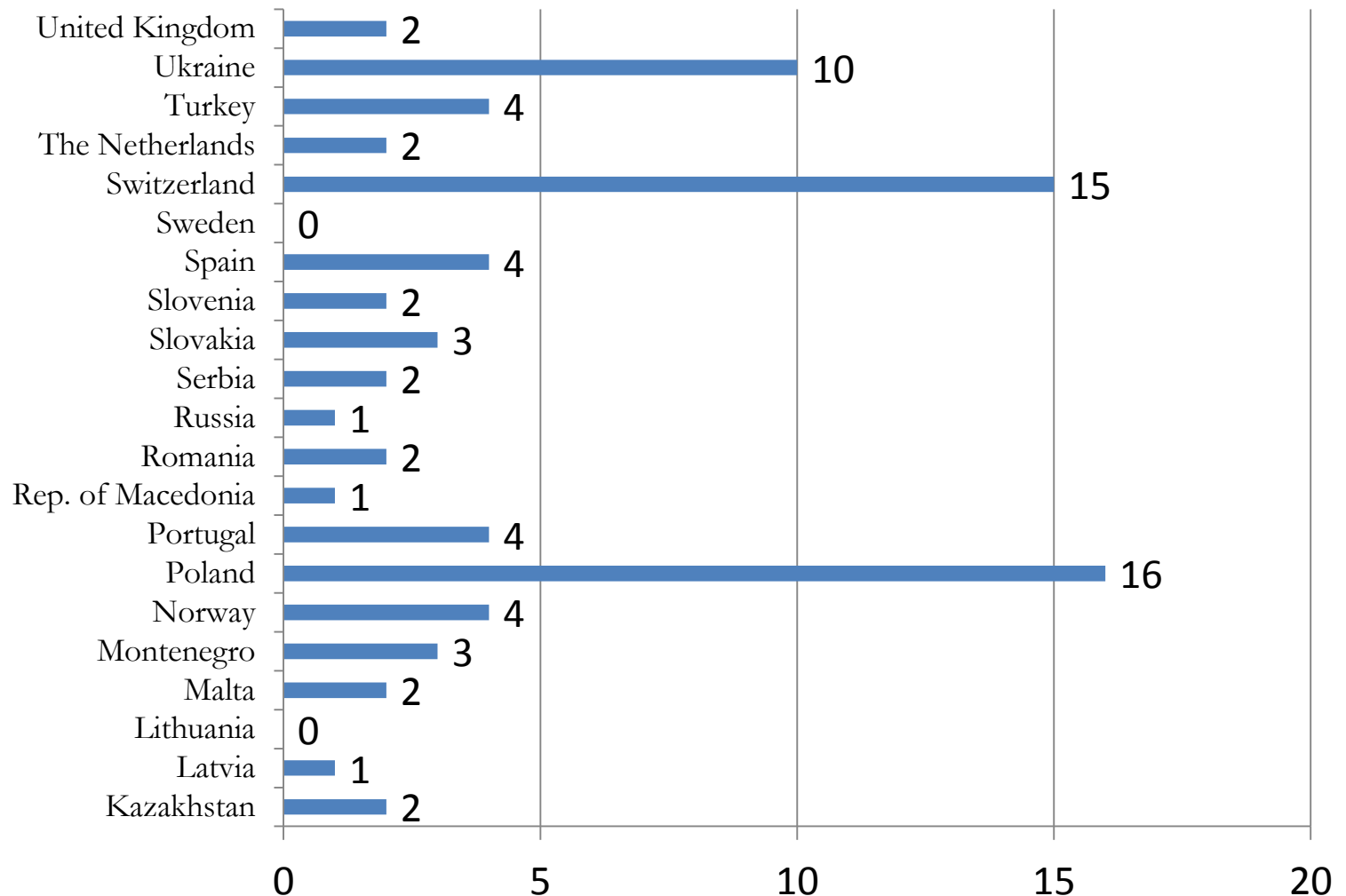
AA 2) How many AA events related to Human Rights is your Group planning or organizing for the term 2012/2013?

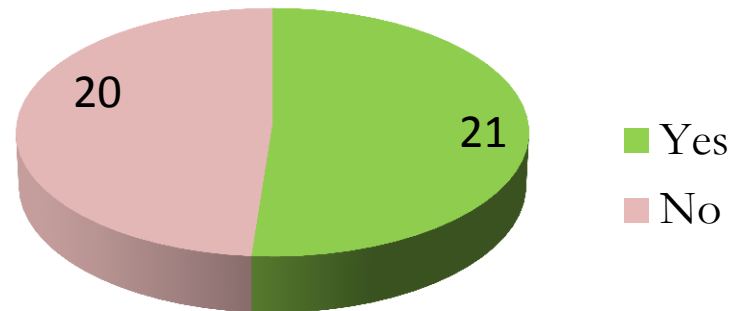

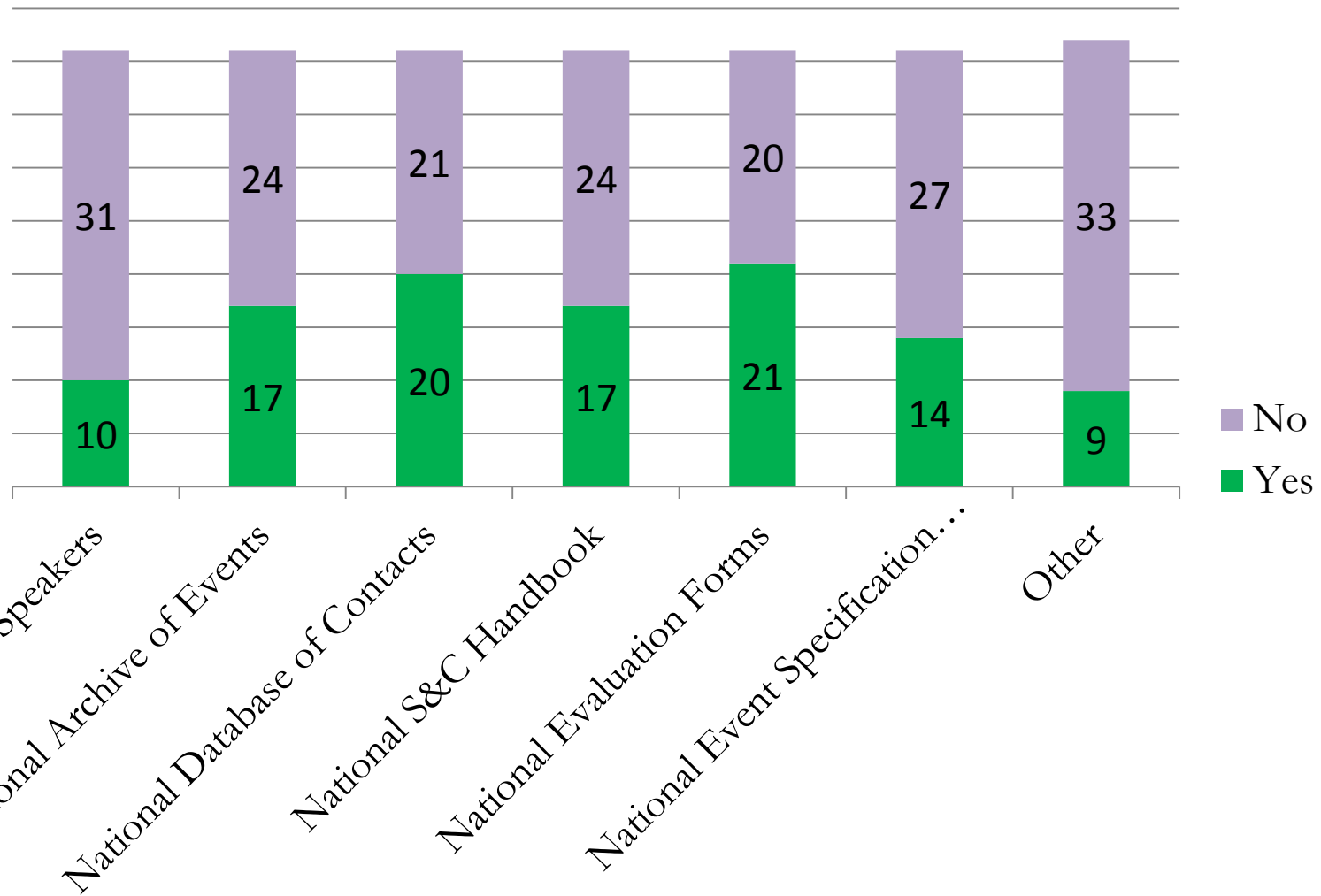

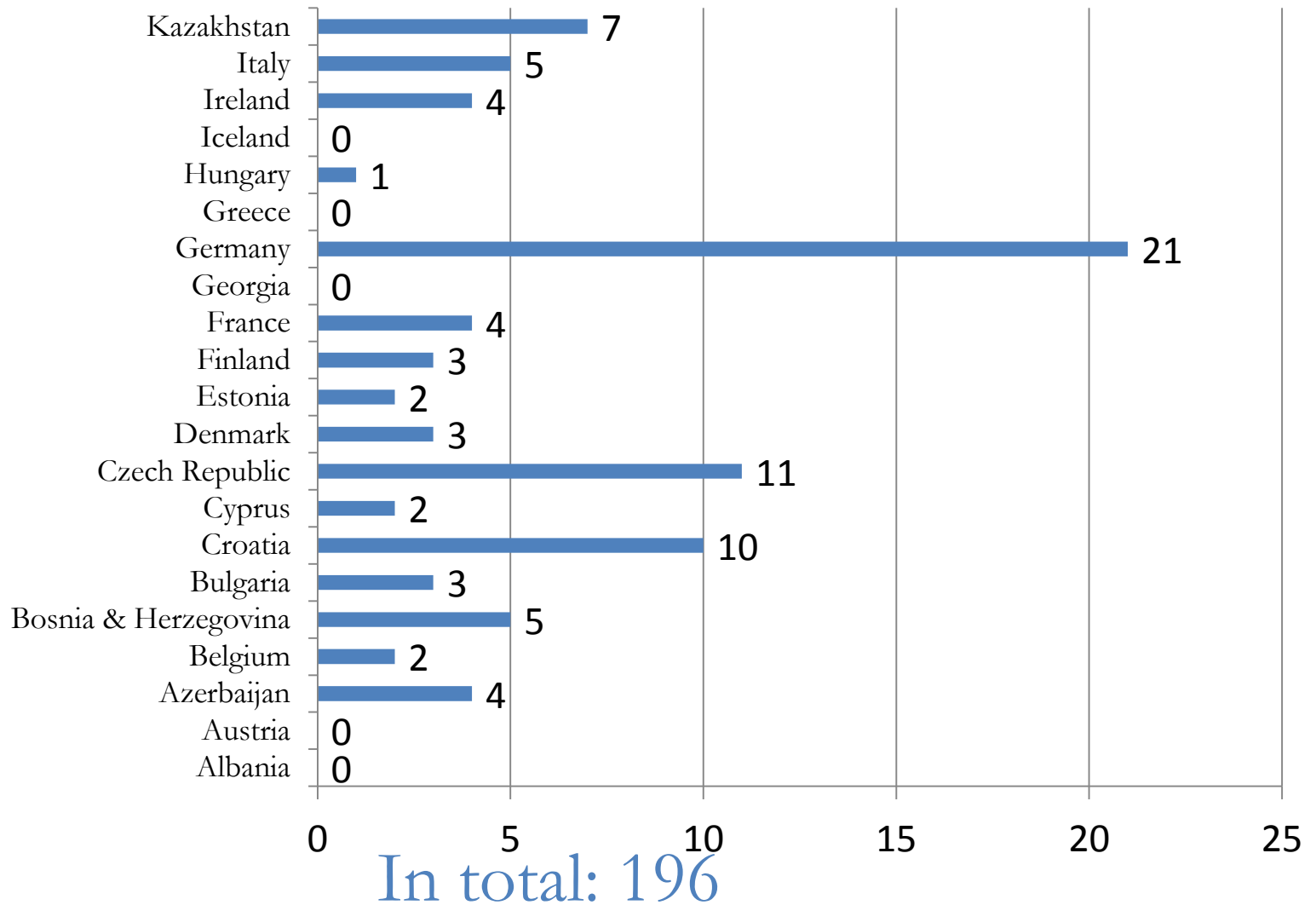

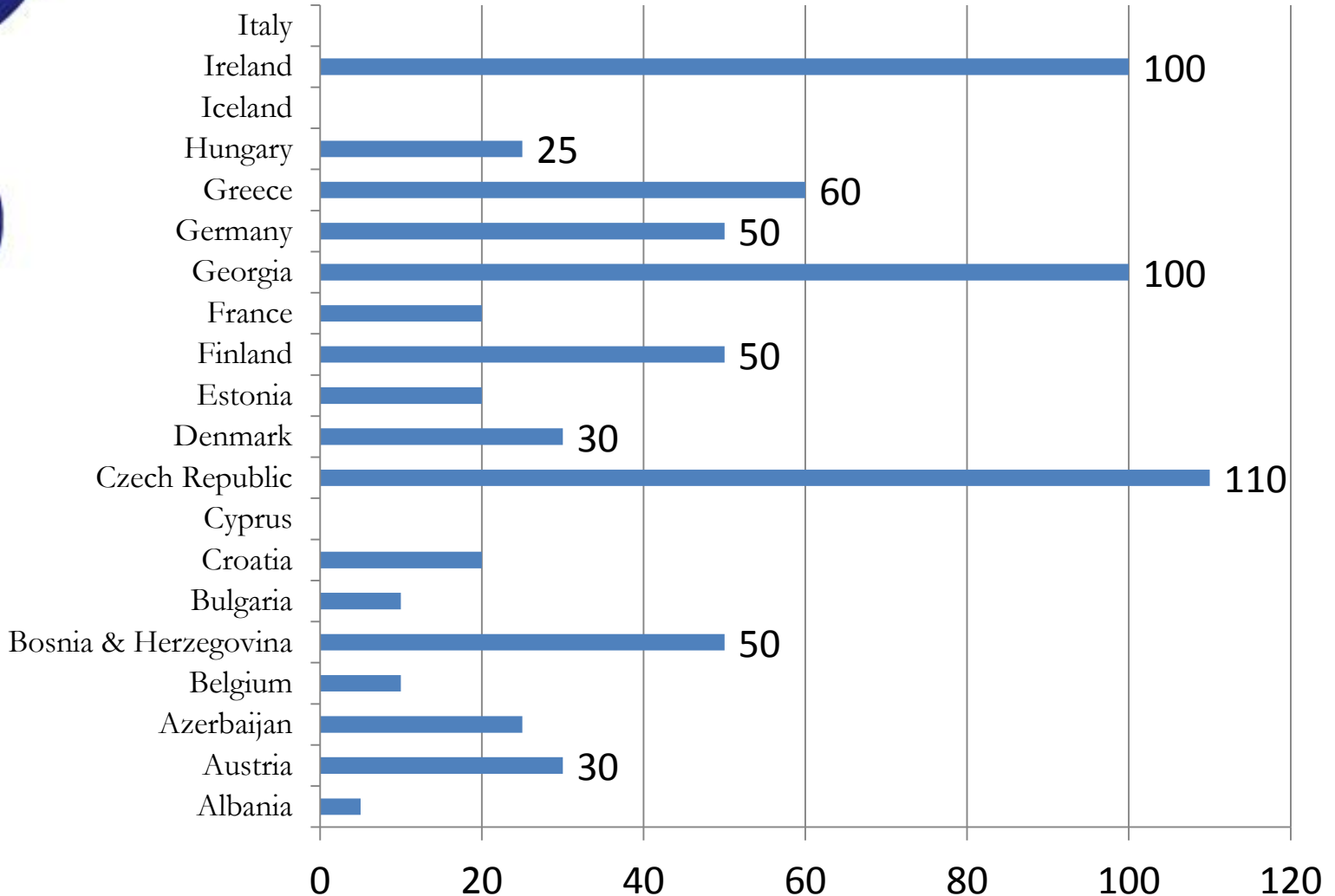

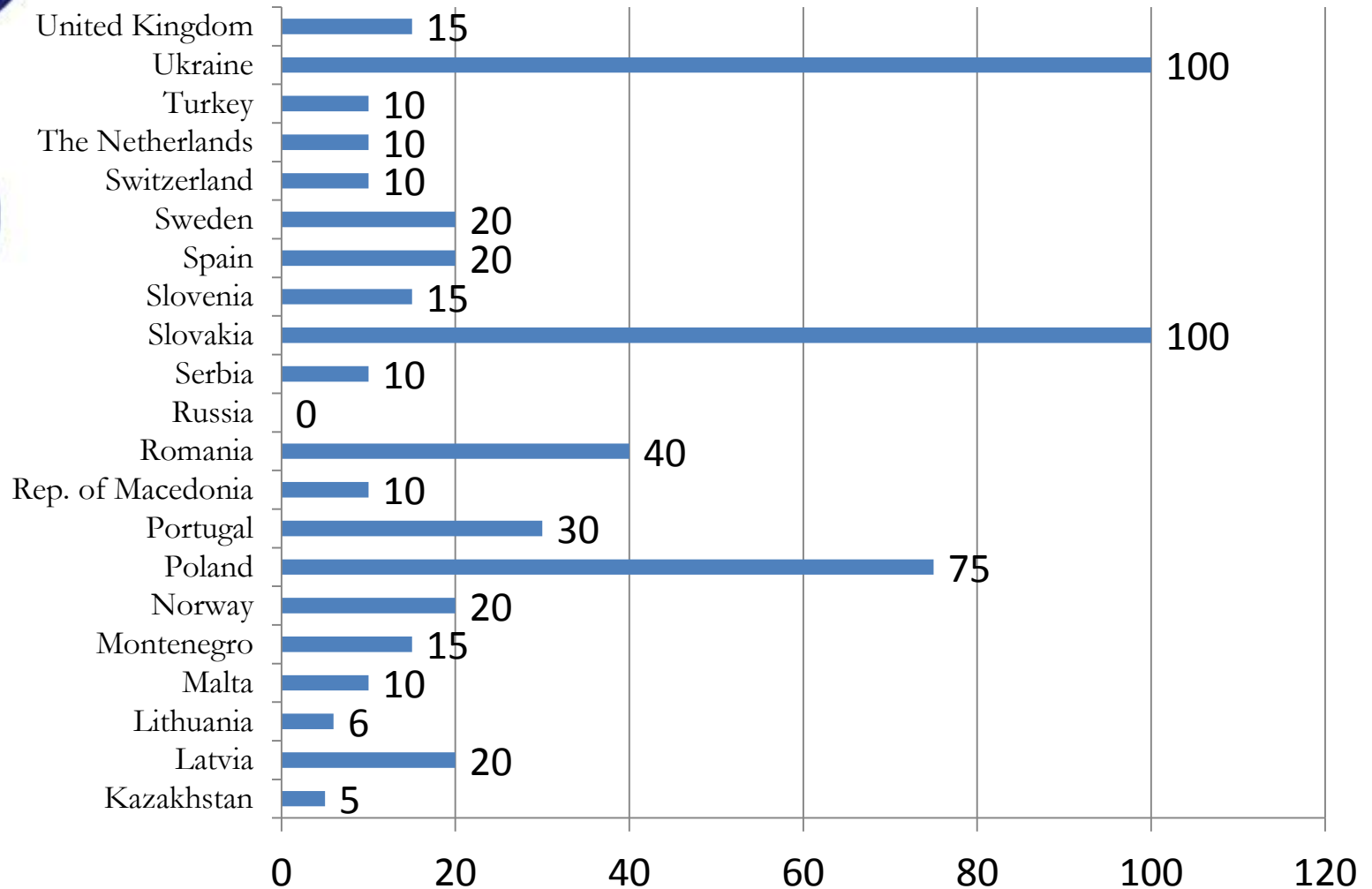
STEP 2) How many Student Application Forms do you want to collect during this term in office?

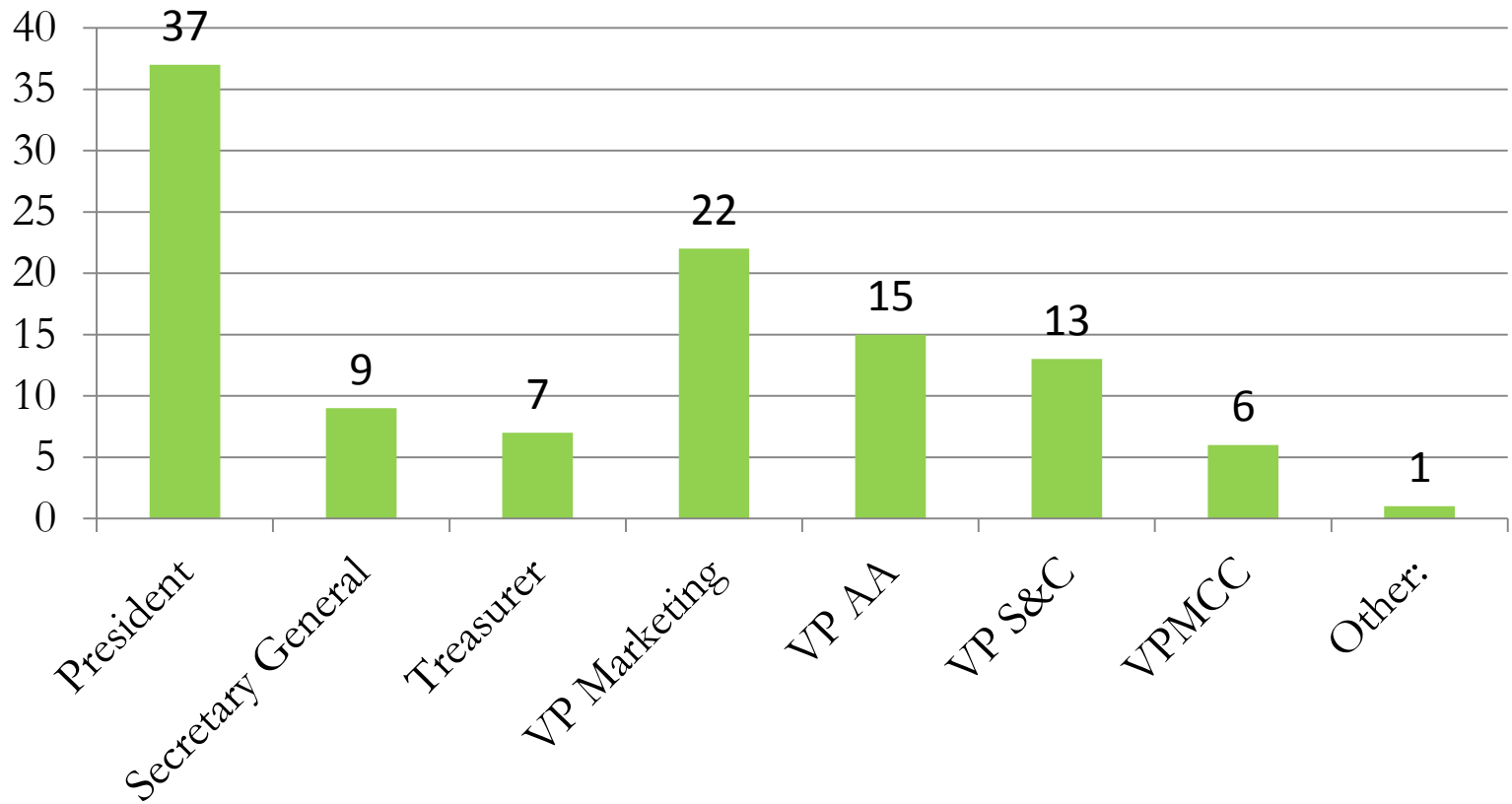
