






Coverage of law faculties in the National ELSA Networks



as evaluated by the National Boards






Communication between National and their respective Local Groups as evaluated by the National Boards






Communication between National Boards and the International Board as evaluated by the National Boards

Influence of Strategic Goals 2018 on yearly planning




Biggest obstacles in their implementation:














Familiarity of (local) officers with ELSA International's projects











Frequency of Board Meetings at the national level






Quality of cooperation within the National Boards










Visibility of International ELSA Projects amongst individual members






