




Coverage of law faculties within National ELSA Networks





as evaluated by the National Boards






Communication between National and their respective Local Groups as evaluated by the National Boards





Communication between National Boards and the International Board as evaluated by the National Boards




Influence of Strategic Goals 2018 on yearly planning








Familiarity of local officers with ELSA International's projects



















Frequency of Board Meetings at the national level






Quality of cooperation within the National Boards





Expansion focus in 2016/2017












Officers' opinion regarding the Human Resources Strategy






Most problematic cycles throughout the Network










Amount of Synergy Managazines needed in Local Groups










Motivation behind organising AA events






Visibility of International ELSA Projects amongst individual members

How would you evaluate the relationship with your STEP Coach?




Did you have enough time for job hunting during the 1st Cycle?
