Questions to the **ICM Agenda?**

How proposals workshops works:

Proposals are voted upon during the *plenaries*. Workshops recommend/not recommend

All workshops need a *simple majority* for a proposal to be recommended

For the simple majority, *abstentions are not counted* meaning only votes in favour/against matter

E.g.: 3 votes in favour, 2 votes against, 13 abstentions: The proposal is recommended

Even if a proposal is not positively recommended upon in the workshop, if there is a majority during the plenary session, the proposal will *pass*.

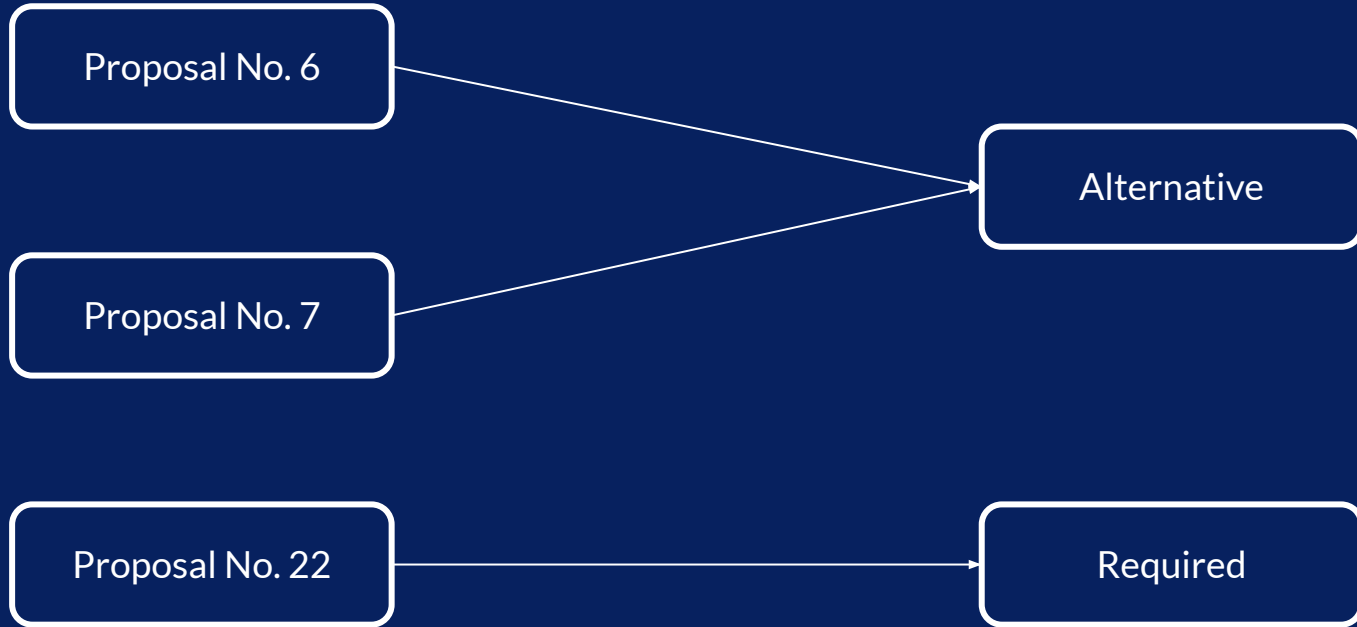
