



Welcome to Professional Development!

What is Professional Development (PD) to you?

PD is defined as: "(...) a Key Area of ELSA that aims to support law students and young lawyers in developing and improving the necessary skills to access the professional world by means of continuous education for individuals in regards to their future career and the skills needed therefore."

- ICMDB Part 8 Professional Development, Chapter 1 Definitions, Article 1.1.



ELSA's Philosophy Statement:

Vision:

A just world in which there is respect for human dignity and cultural diversity.

Purpose:

To contribute to legal education, to foster mutual understanding and to promote social responsibility of law students and young lawyers.

Means:

- To provide opportunities for law students and young lawyers to learn about other cultures and legal systems in a spirit of critical dialogue and scientific co-operation;
- To assist law students and young lawyers to be internationally minded and professionally skilled;
- To encourage law students and young lawyers to act for the good of society.

How did we get to where we are today?



A Short History Lesson:

- 1981: The European Law Students' Association was founded
- 1985: Student Trainee Exchange Programme (STEP) was established
- ~2000: First STEP Online System
- 2018: The SOS Portal for ELSA Traineeships
- 2021: Board Reform STEP became Professional Development
- 2023: Development of the Legal Tandem Project, codification of Lawyers@Work
- 2024: Legal Tandem, Career/Job Fairs, Lawyers@Work, Legal Clinics all codified in the International Council Meeting Decision Book
- 2025: We are <u>here</u>



ELSA Traineeships - Our Flagship Project

- Been ongoing since ELSA's inception (practically)
- Previously physical moved onto digital platforms
- Over 10 000 Applications since 2018
- Over 1500 Traineeships since 2018
- One of ELSAs biggest projects





Career Launch - ELSA International's Other

- **Project** Begun in 2020 during the COVID-19 Pandemic
 - Digital Workshop Series and Job Fair
 - Combined with ELSA Skills Academy
 - Capitalizes on the development of digital technology
 - Focuspoint for 2025/2026 on International's side



Be careful of how you present our projects - and of the marketeers time schedules






KEY SELLING POINTS


Google Drive & Google Workspace






