## Structure of good motivation letter

- Know to whom you <u>address</u> the letter! (ELSA International)
- In the <u>first paragraph</u> of the letter:
  - briefly introduce yourself,
  - show interest in the project and the specific ELSA Delegation you are applying to,
  - demonstrate that you know well the committee/institution where you're applying to;
- Use the <u>second paragraph</u> to:
  - explain your interest to the specific ELSA Delegation and in the topic of the respective Delegation,
  - point out your specific academic background relevant to the topic of the session;
- In the <u>third paragraph</u>:
  - explain how you would like to benefit from the participation,
  - elaborate on the qualifications that you possess that will make you an exceptional ELSA Delegate,
  - show your awareness on the seriousness of holding the title of ELSA Delegate;
- In the <u>final paragraph</u>:
  - focus on your strongest qualities and be creative in your delivery: add your personal touch while stating your motivation,
  - Always end with a positive note by reaffirming your motivation, enthusiasm, and suitability to the position of ELSA delegate.
