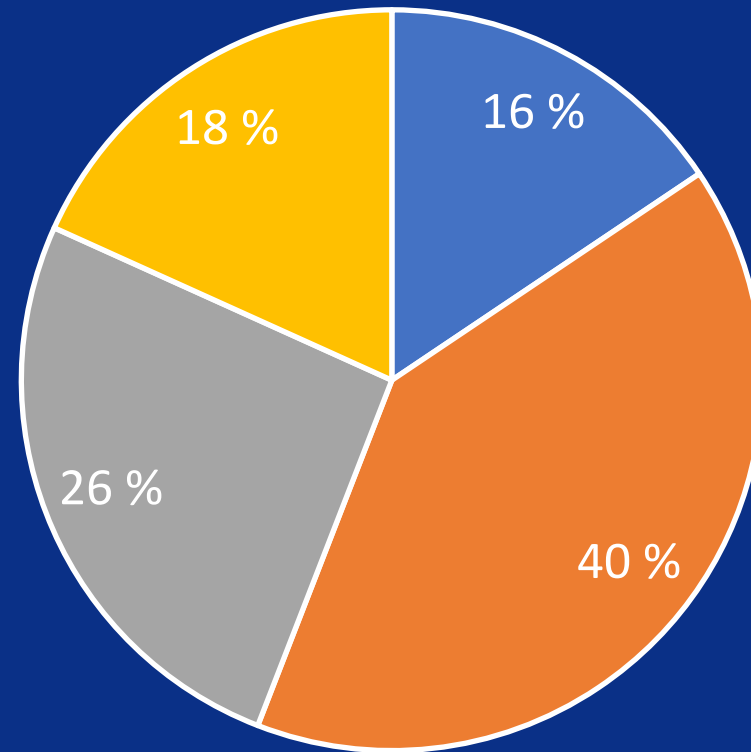

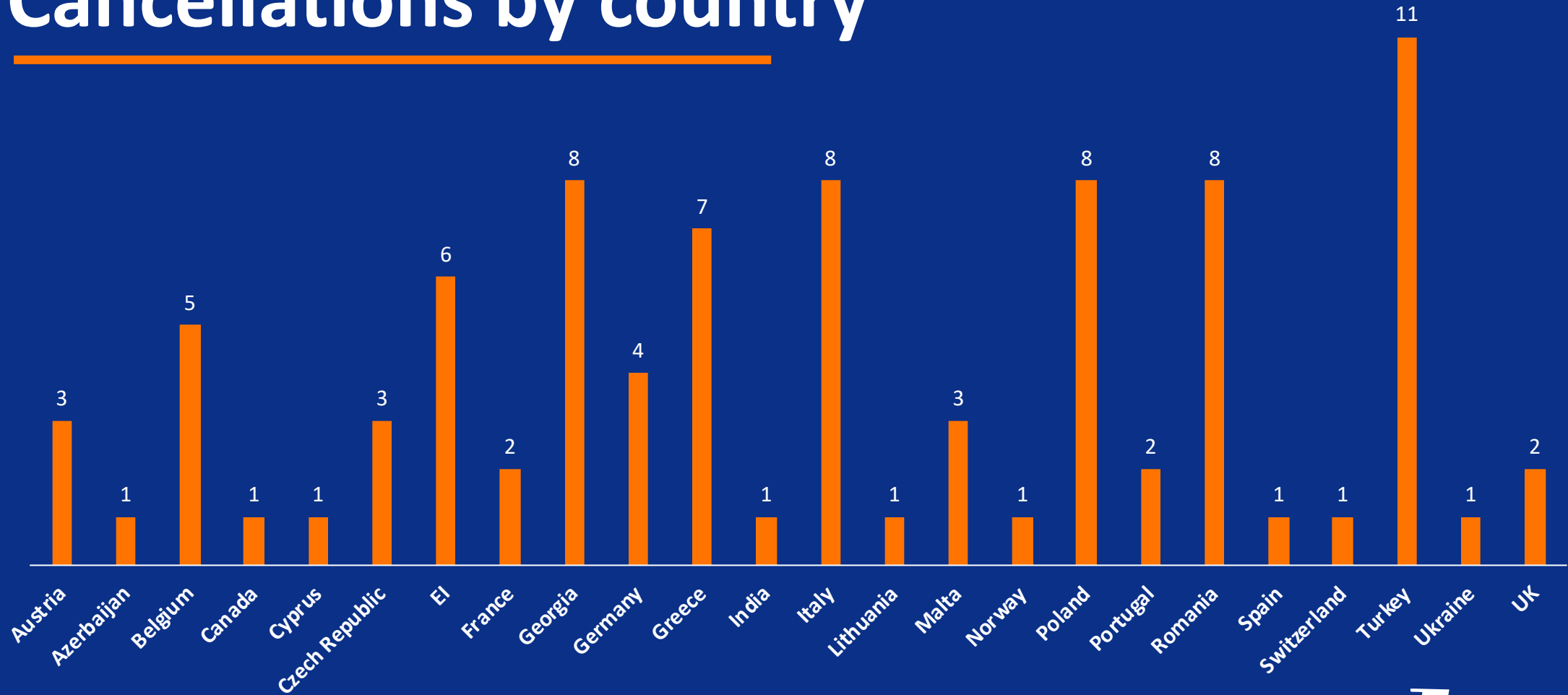
# Cancellations: overview

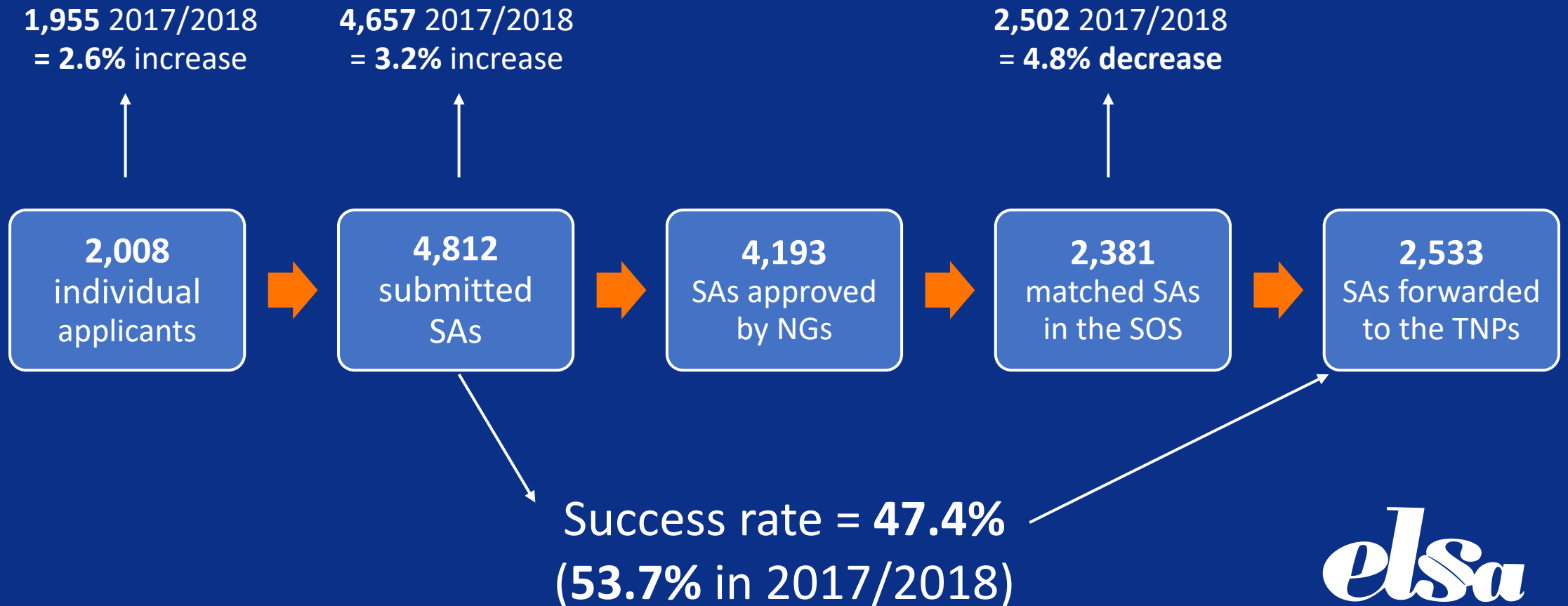
