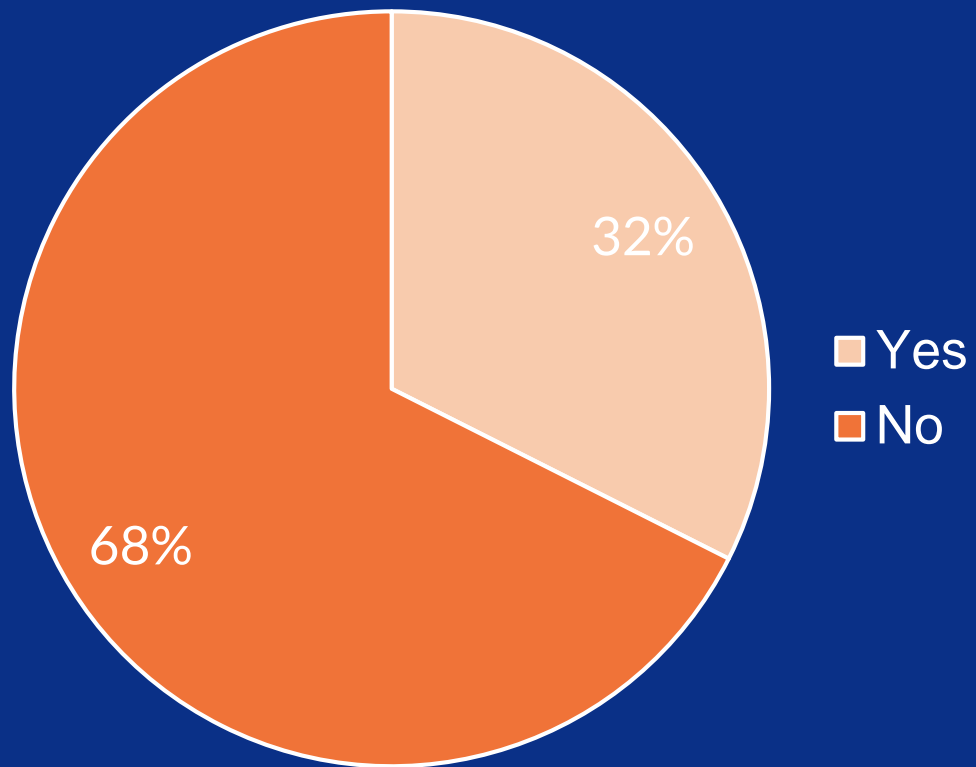
Create an ELSA Advisory Body that consults the International Council and the IB on long-term projects and planning, by giving advice, improving knowledge management and transition.
