30 countries are represented With a total of 80 submissions.



Have you read the BEE Handbook?








Why is this a problem?

The majority has only read parts of the handbook. The reasons given were:


- Time/ the handbook is too long
 - Problem: the handbook is not user-friendly
- They believed they had most of the knowledge and only read parts they didn't feel they knew
 - Problem: The handbook contains more than the headlines would suggest






Plan for future Expansion Tools

BEE Transition




Plan for future BEE Transition Tools
