

ELSA's Privacy Policy for International Board Officers

ELSA is a non-political independent, not-for-profit organisation organised on a local, national and international level. This privacy policy will explain how the International Board of ELSA uses the personal data we collect from you.

I. Official Positions within the International Board

Official positions within the International Board refers to positions on the International Board, inhibited by either elected or appointed officers.

II. Legal basis for the processing of the data

The legal basis for processing your data is Art 6 (1) point (b) 'processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract'.

III. What data do we collect?

The International Board collects the following data:

- Name (mandatory);
- Photo (mandatory);
- Signature (mandatory);
- Address (mandatory);
- Email (mandatory);
- Phone number (mandatory);
- Bank details (mandatory);
- Passport (mandatory);
- Visa documents (mandatory).

IV. How do we collect your data?

You directly provide International Board of ELSA with the data when applying to the International Board and subsequently when signing the Voluntary Agreement with the International Board of ELSA once elected or appointed.

V. How will we use your data?

The International Board of ELSA collects your data so that we can:

- Form a legally binding contract with the elected or appointed individuals.

If we were to process your personal data for any other purpose, you will be contacted prior and we will provide you with any necessary information. We will not disclose or share any personal data with third parties.

VI. How do we protect your data?

The International Board securely stores your data on the password protected office computer of



the Secretary General of the International Board. Additionally, the Voluntary Agreement is stored in physical form in the archives located at 239 Boulevard General Jacques, 1050 Ixelles.

The International Board will keep your provided data (except for passport copies and proof of address) for 7 years starting from the subsequent 1st of January after taking office to comply with Dutch administrative law. After this period, we will delete your data by erasing it from the password protected office computer of the Secretary General of the International Board and by destroying the physical copy from the archive. Passport copies and proof of address documents will be deleted one year after the respective term has ended.

VII. What are your data protection rights?

The International Board would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

- The right to withdraw consent – You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time and to require the International Board to stop processing and storing your data.
- The right to access - You have the right to request the International Board for copies of your personal data.
- The right to rectification - You have the right to request that the International Board correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request the International Board to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- The right to erasure - You have the right to request that the International Board erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that the International Board restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the International Board's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to data portability - You have the right to request that the International Board transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
