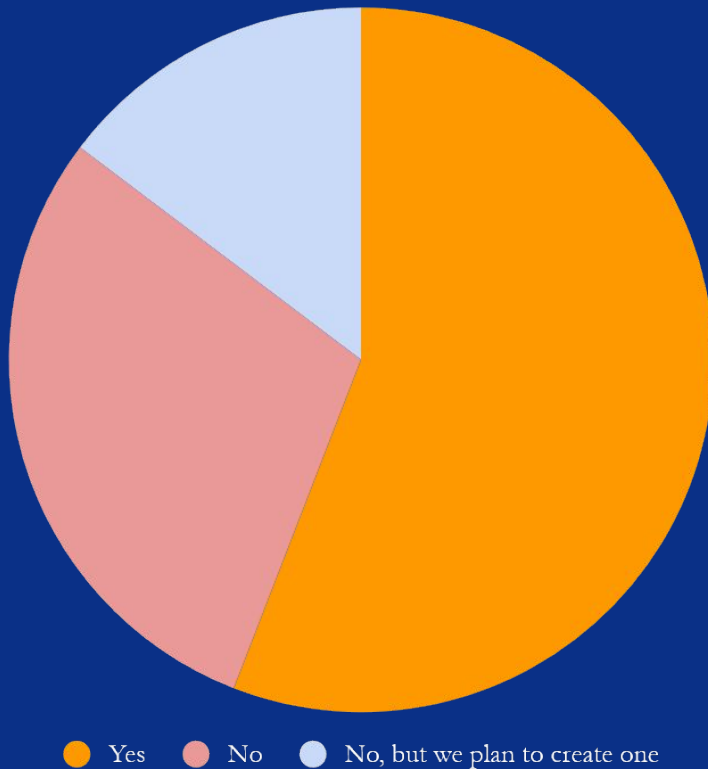

3. Do you have any regulations on the national level regarding the approach of external contacts?

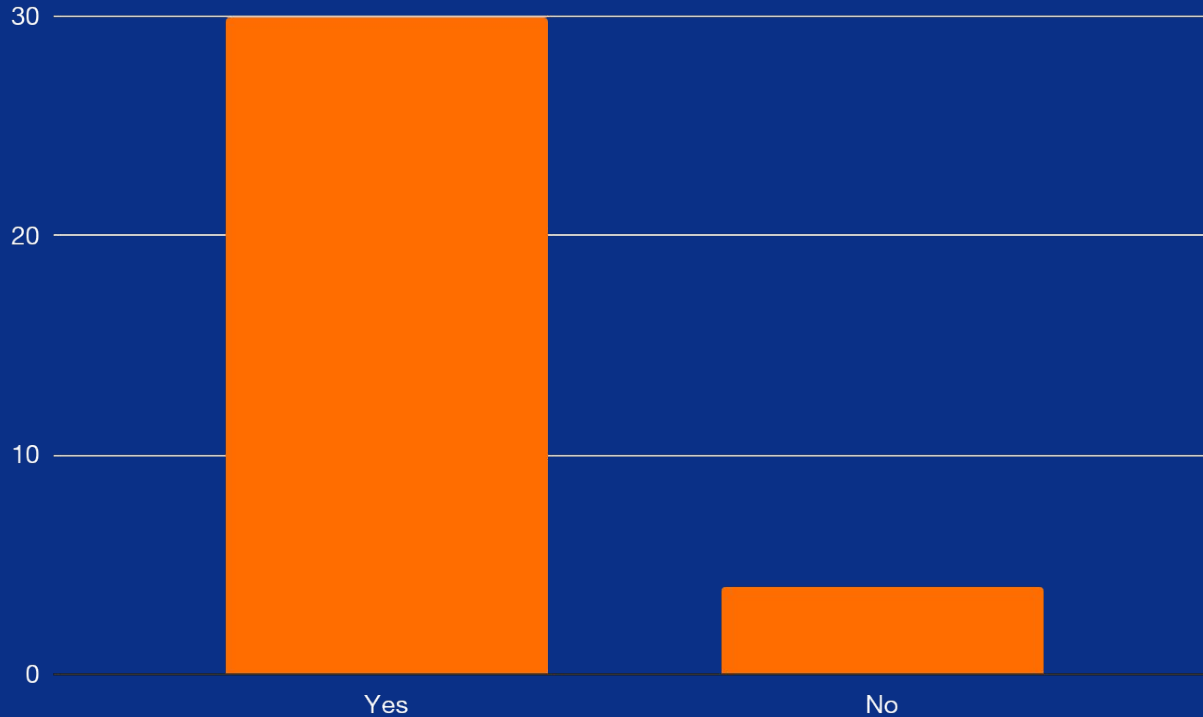

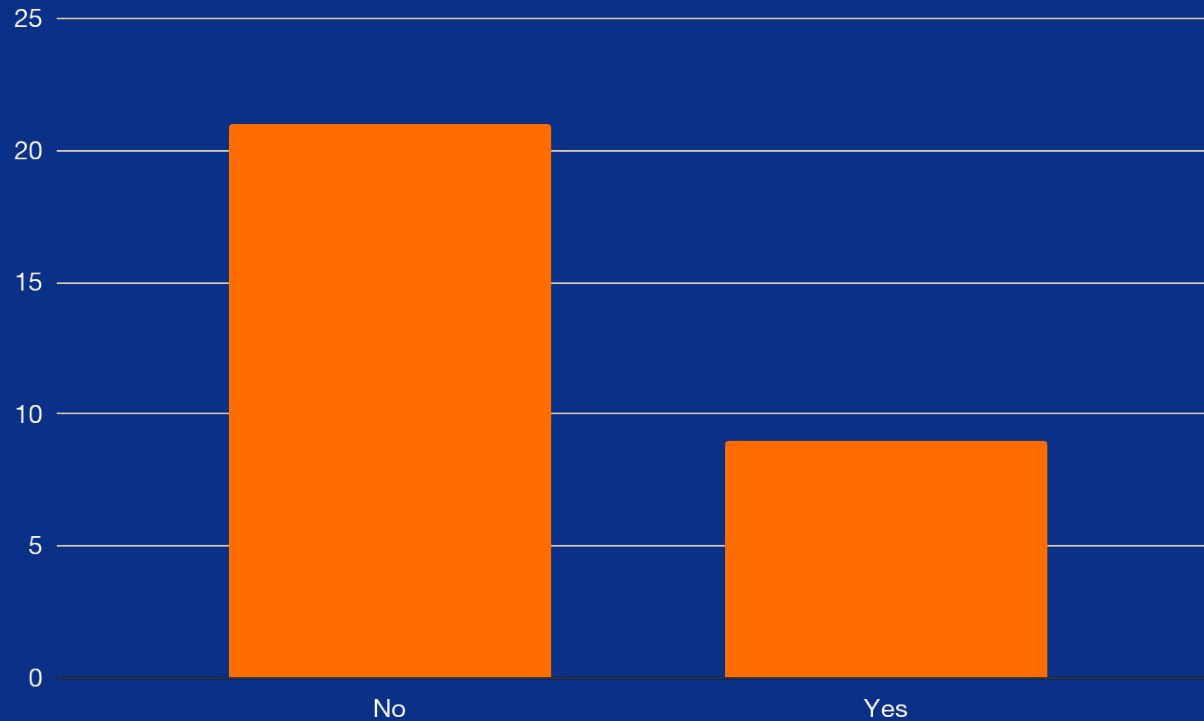
5. Do you know what the International Trainers' Pool is?

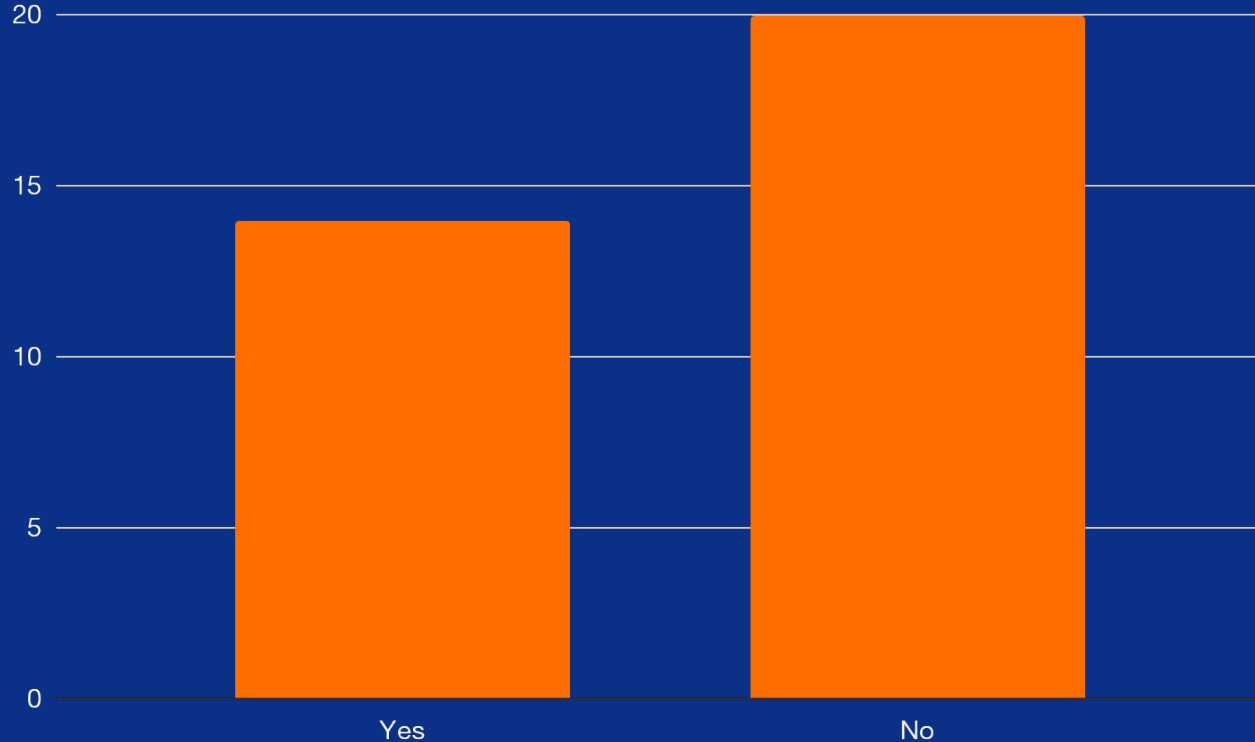
5-A. If your answer was yes, have you ever organised a Training with the International Trainers Pool?

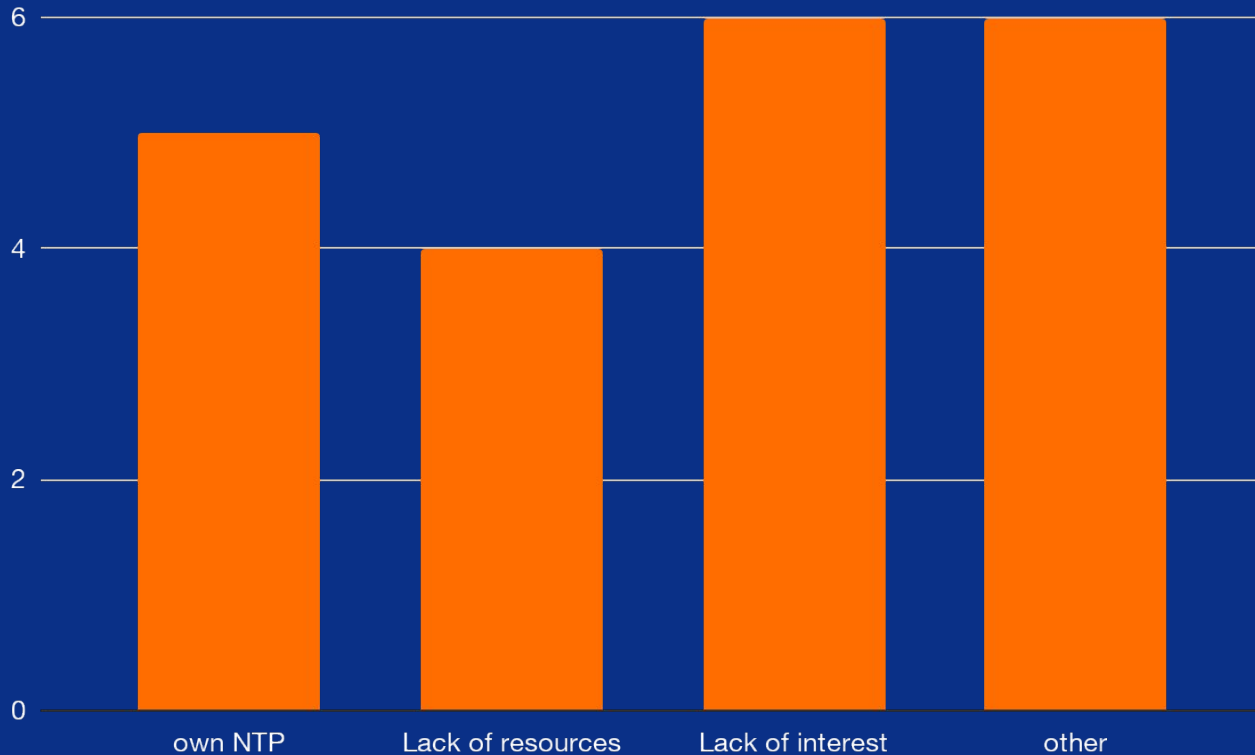
6. Do you plan on organising a Training with the ITP this term?

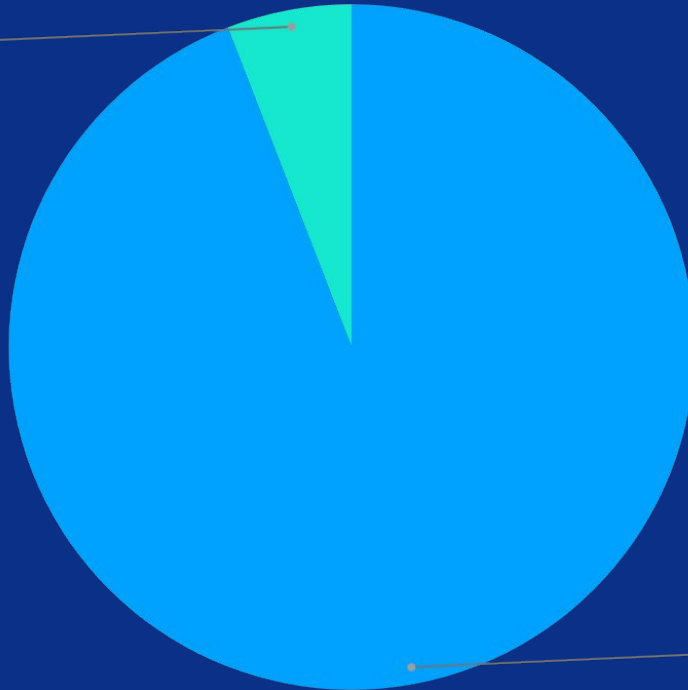

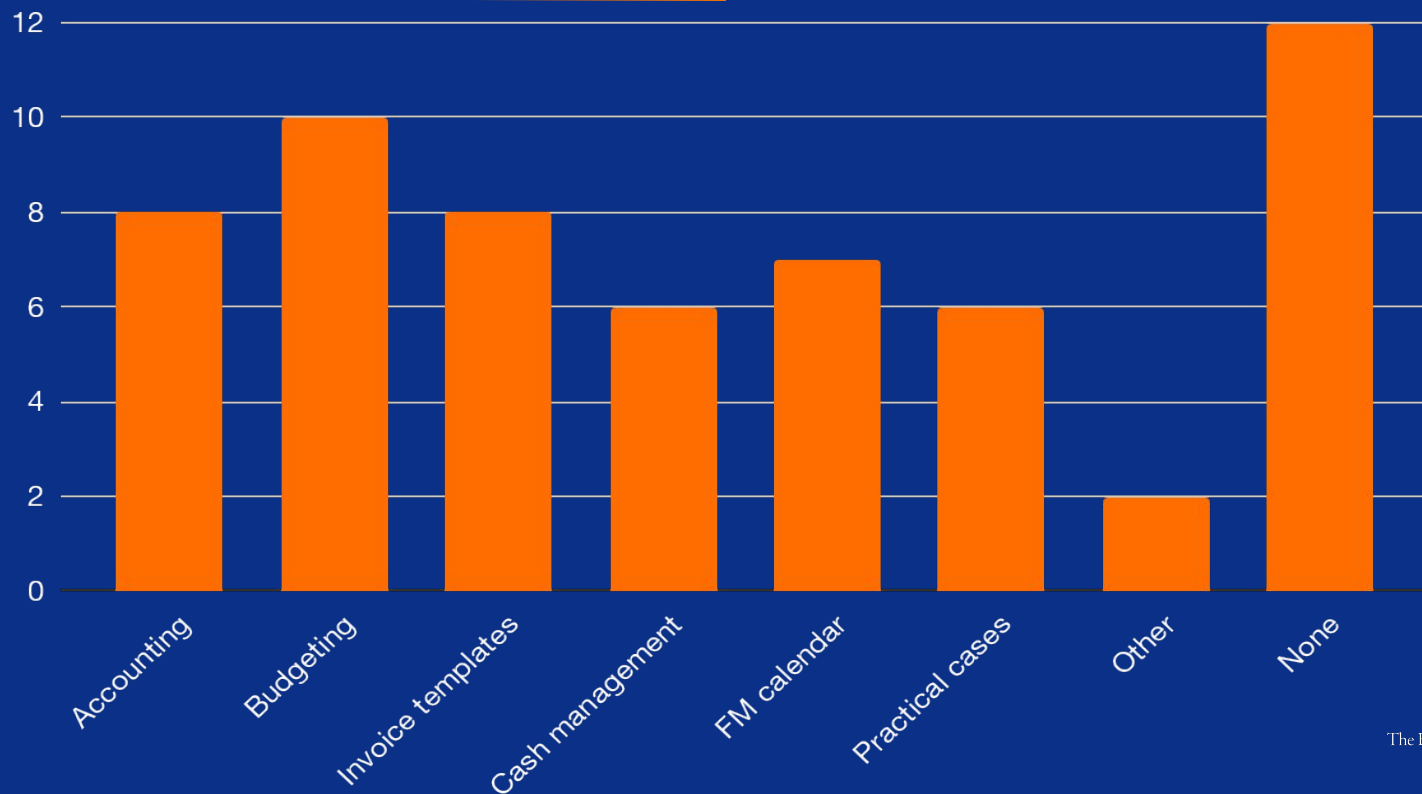
13. How much is the “Annual General Income” of your National Group gathered in the immediate previous financial year expressed in EURO?



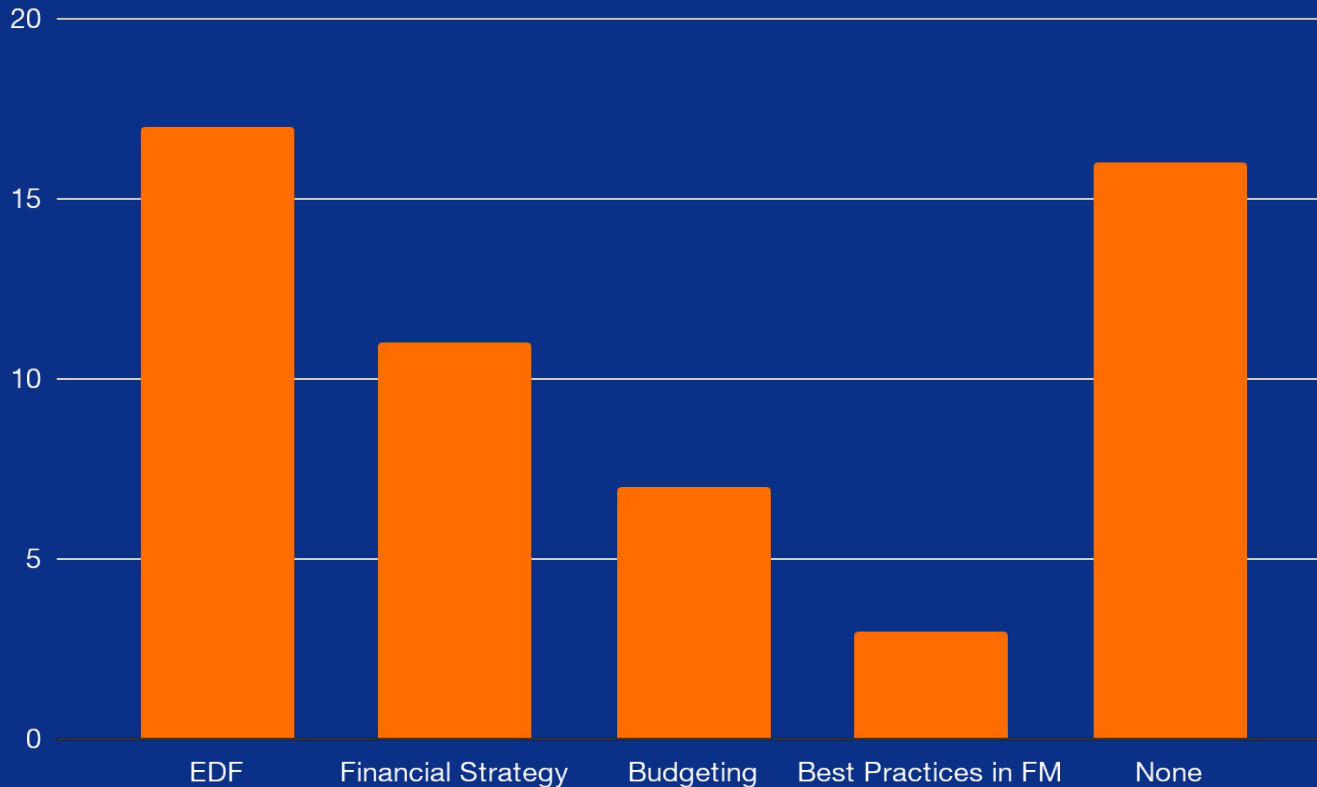
10. Which of the following tools have you used from the ELSAOfficers portal?



11. Which of the following tools should be created for the Officers portal?



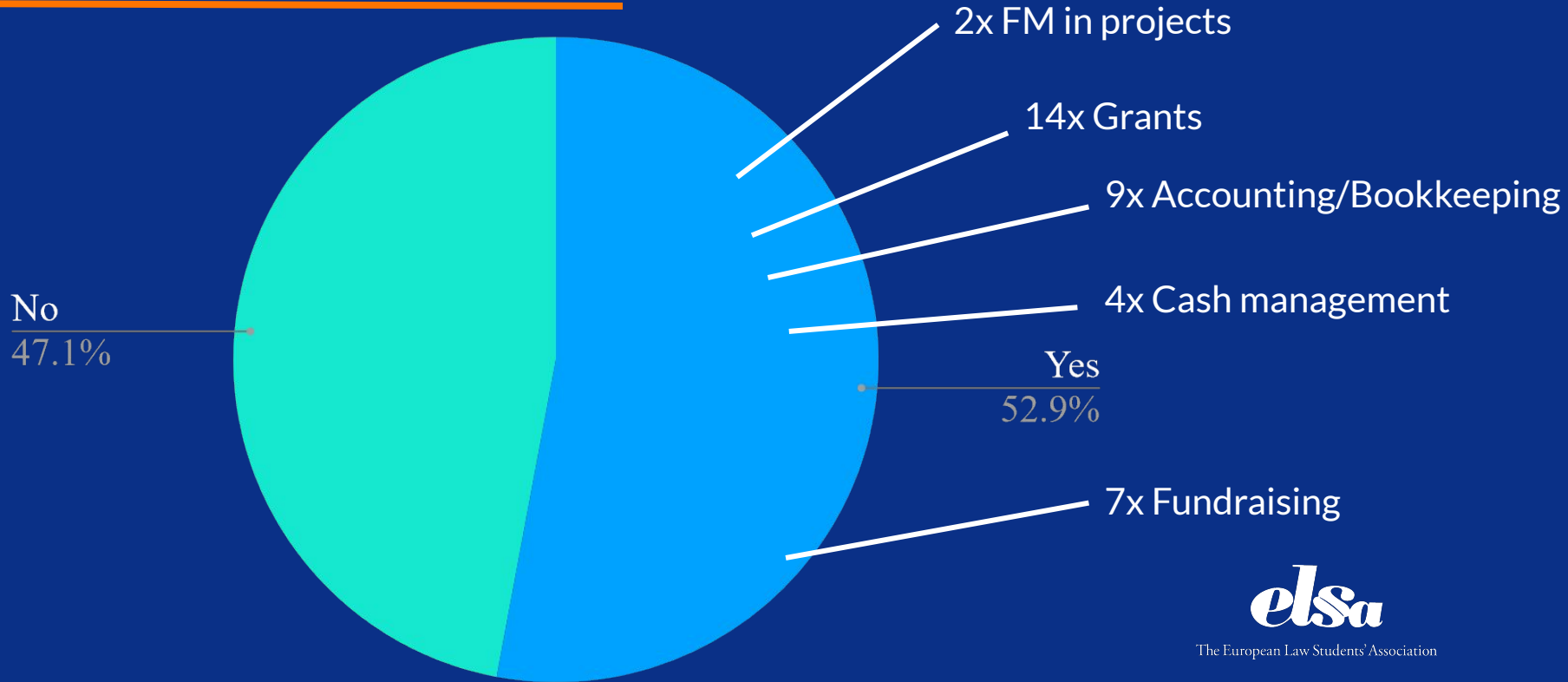

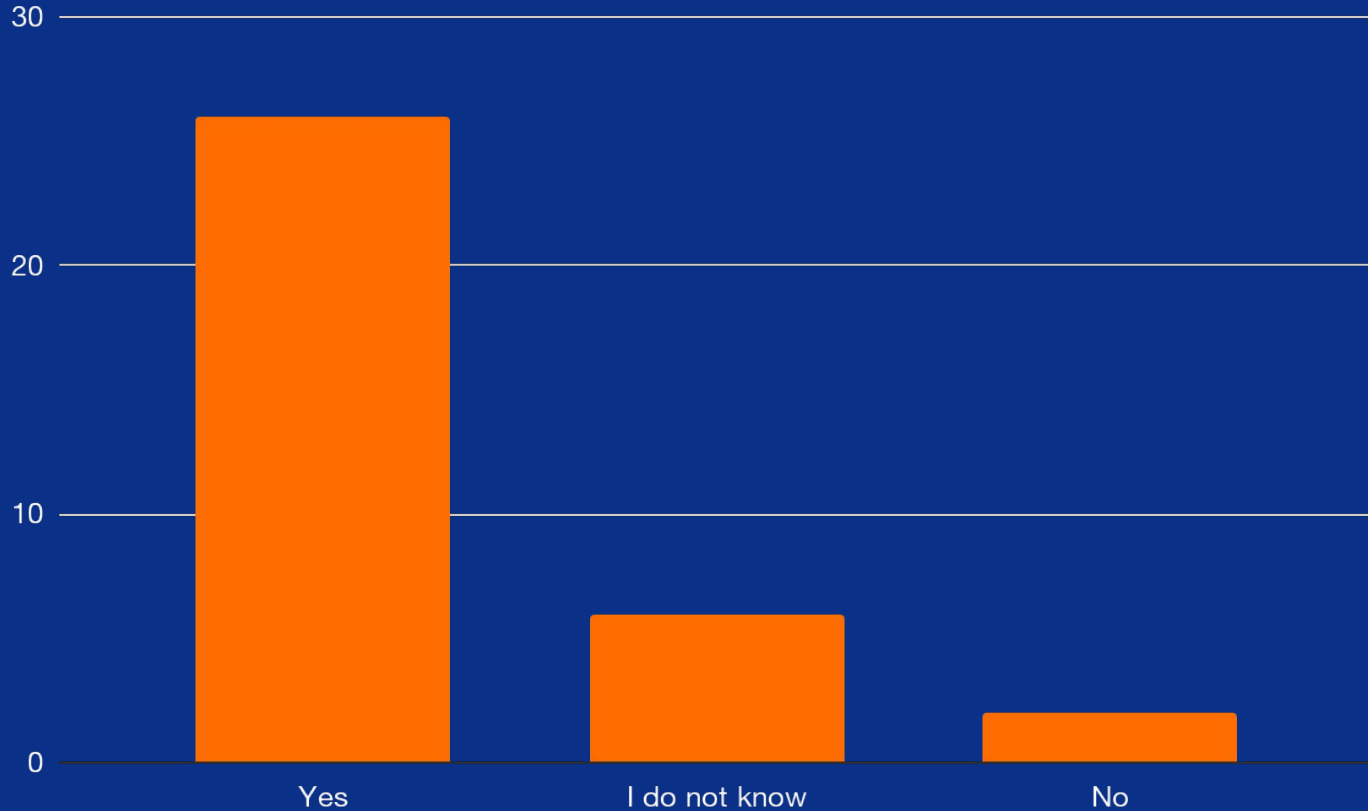

16. Which platform do you currently use the most to produce content out of the Marketing Kits?

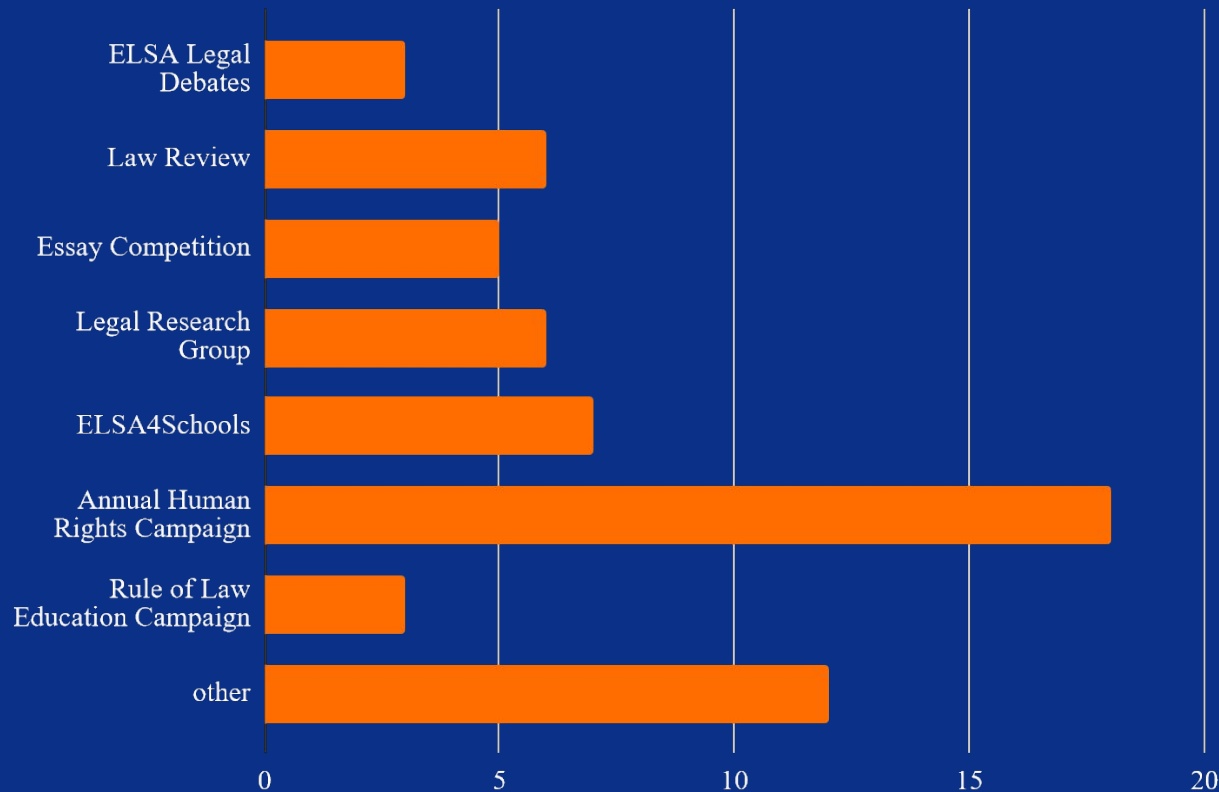

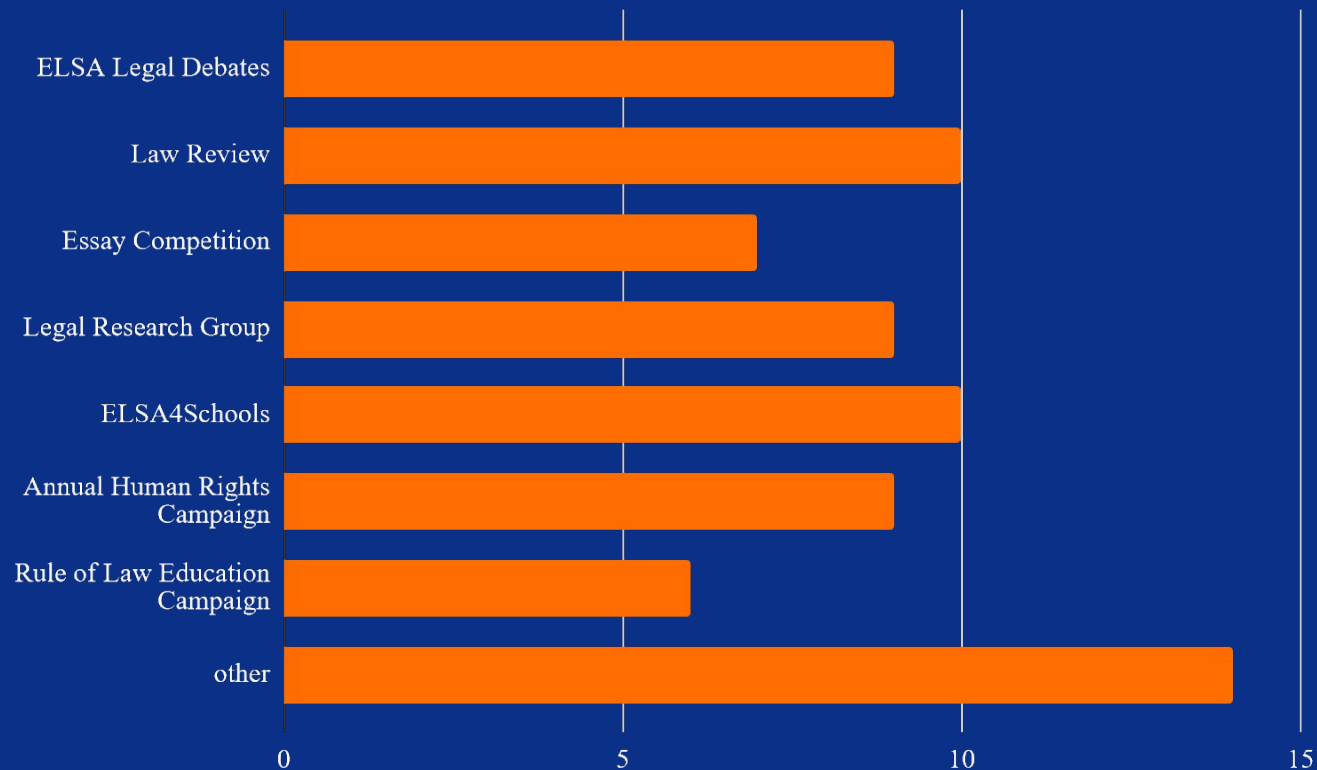

17. Which projects did you organise in the first half of the term?



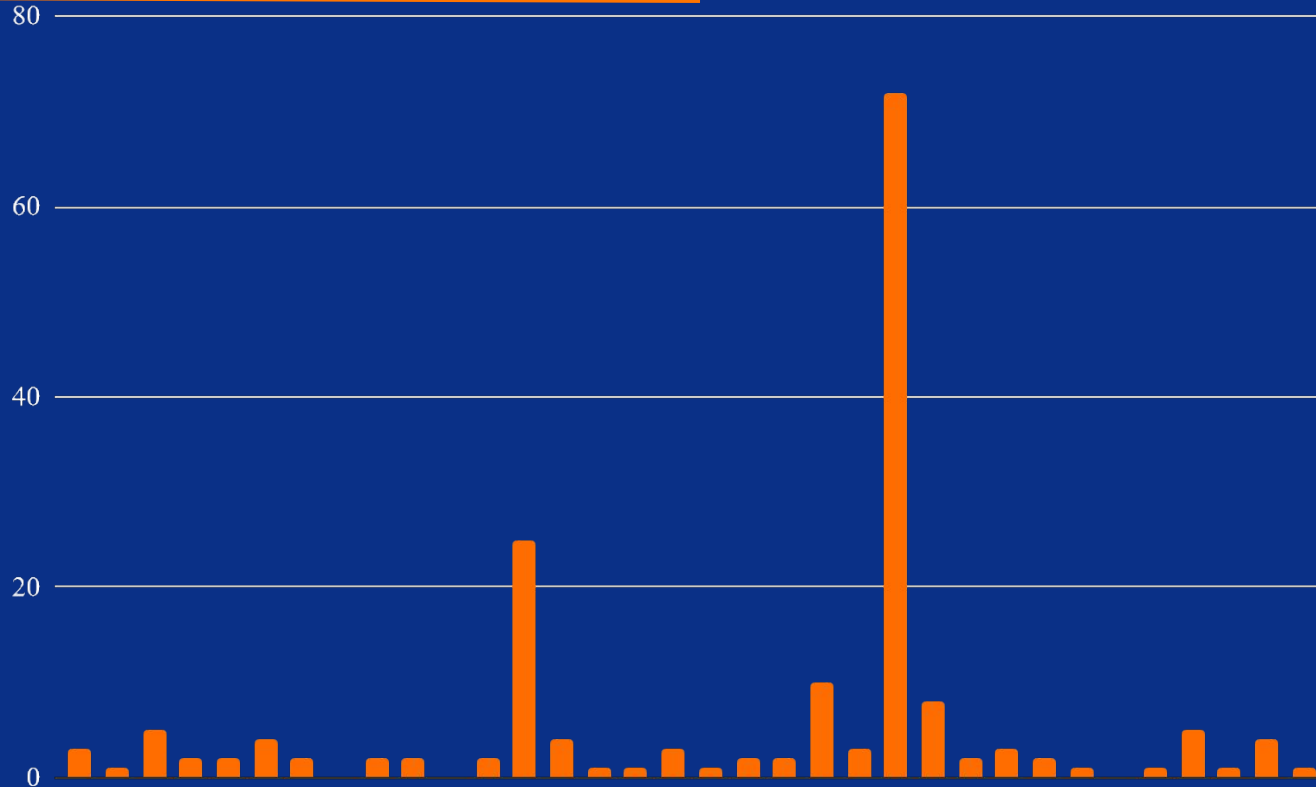
18. Which projects are you planning to organise in the second half of the term?

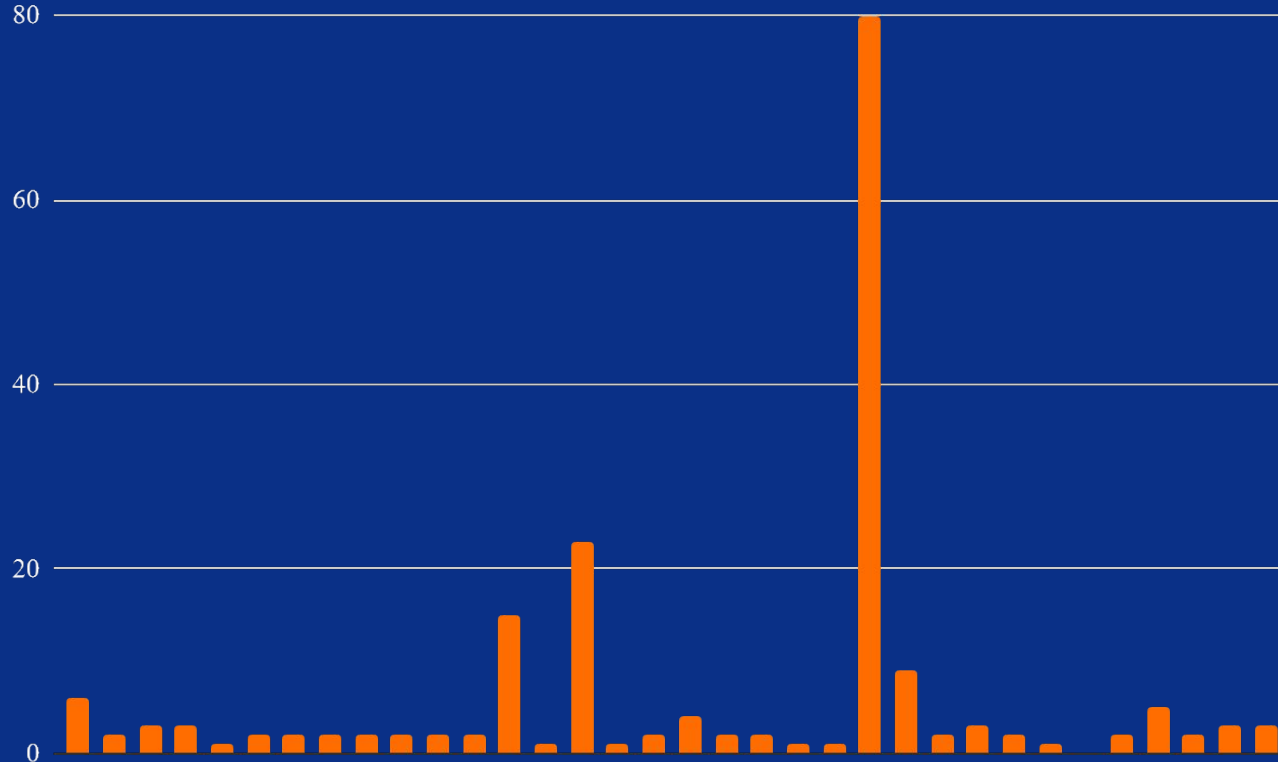

19. How many AA events have you already organised during 2022/2023?

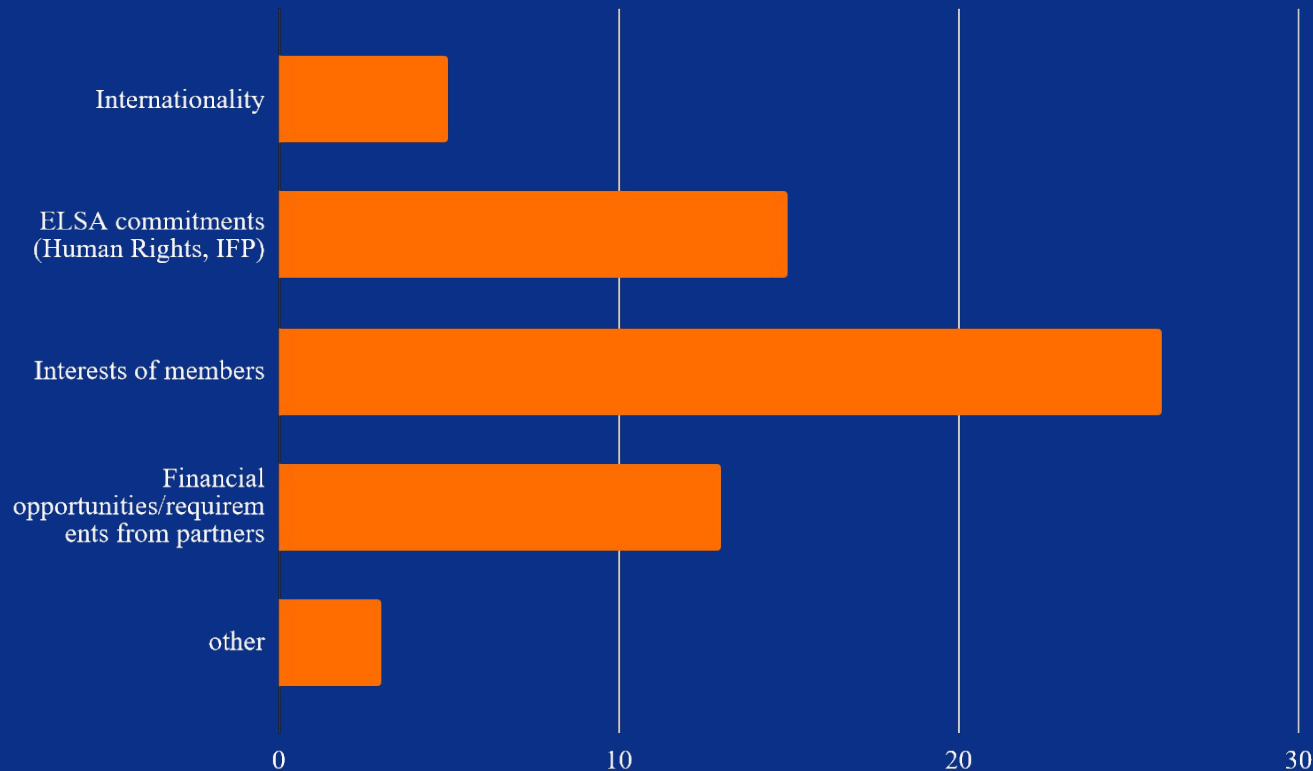

20. How many AA events are you planning to organise during the rest of your term?

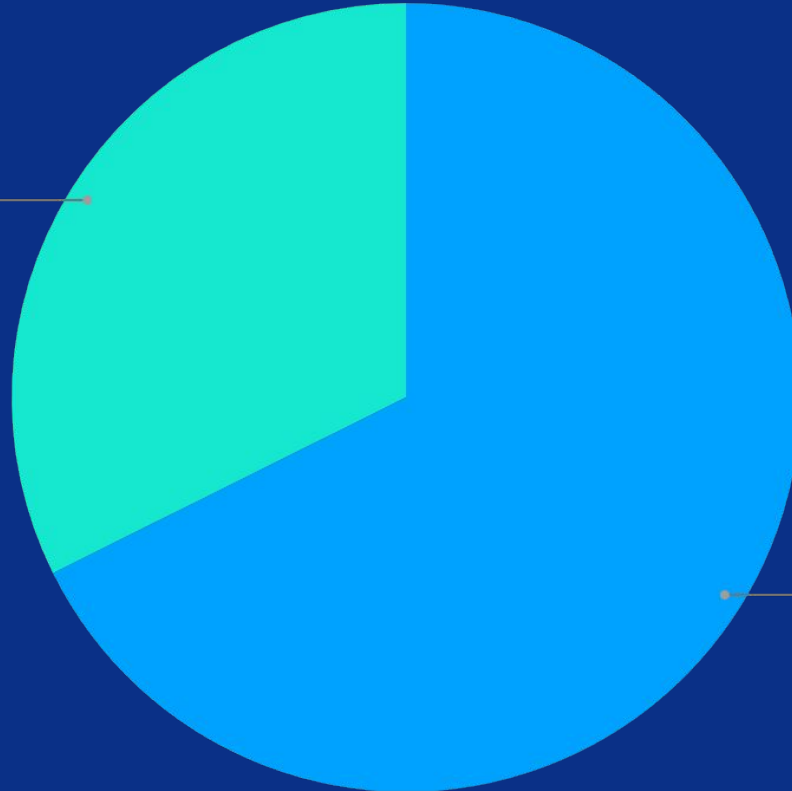


21. What is your main focus when organising AA events?

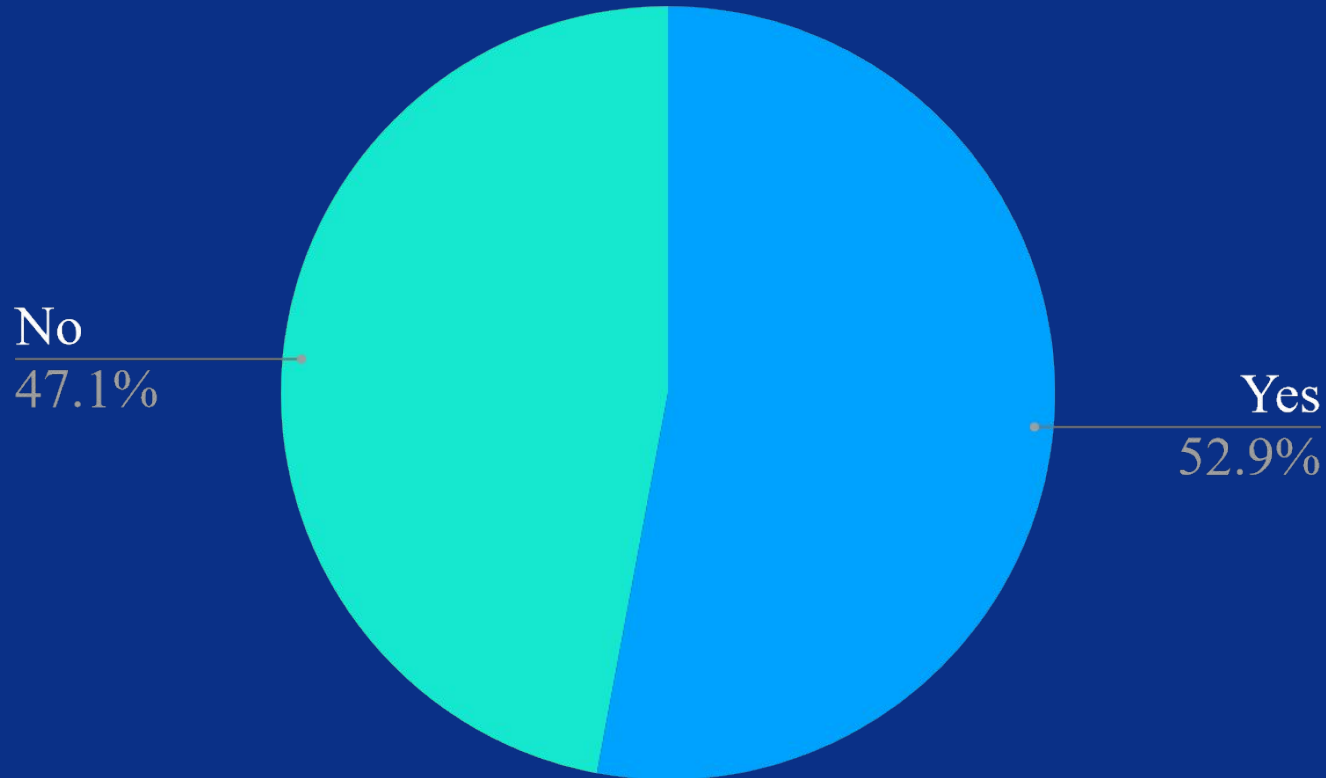

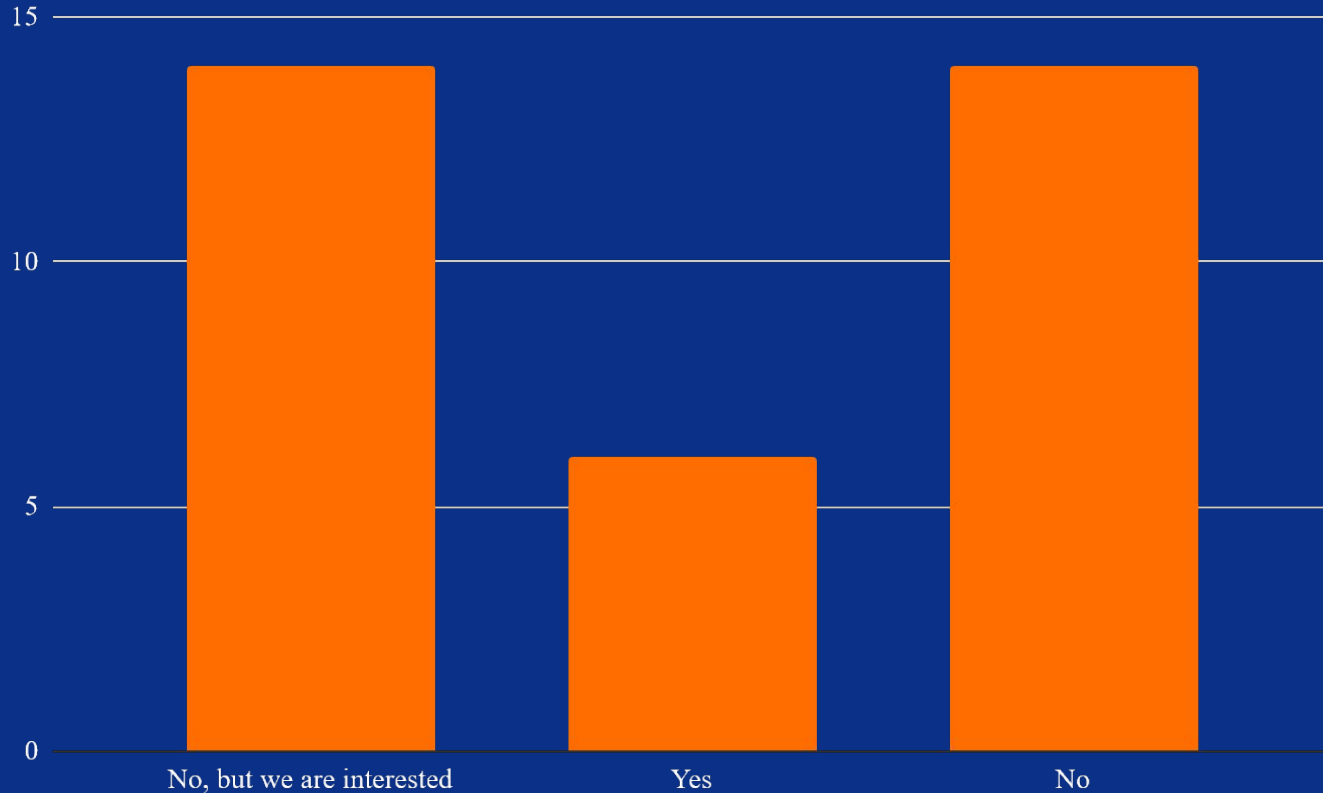

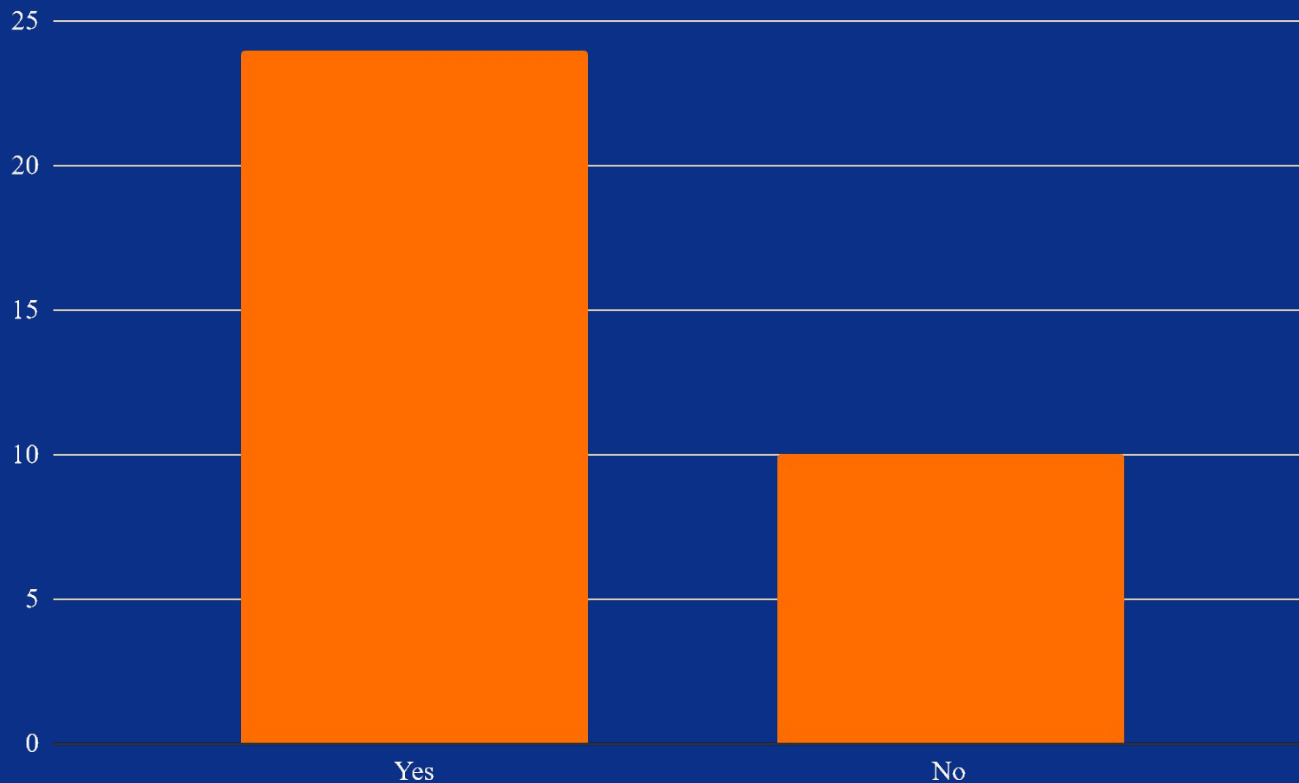
23. Do you plan to use AA to advocate?



25. Do you or Local Groups conduct bilateral or multilateral LRGs?



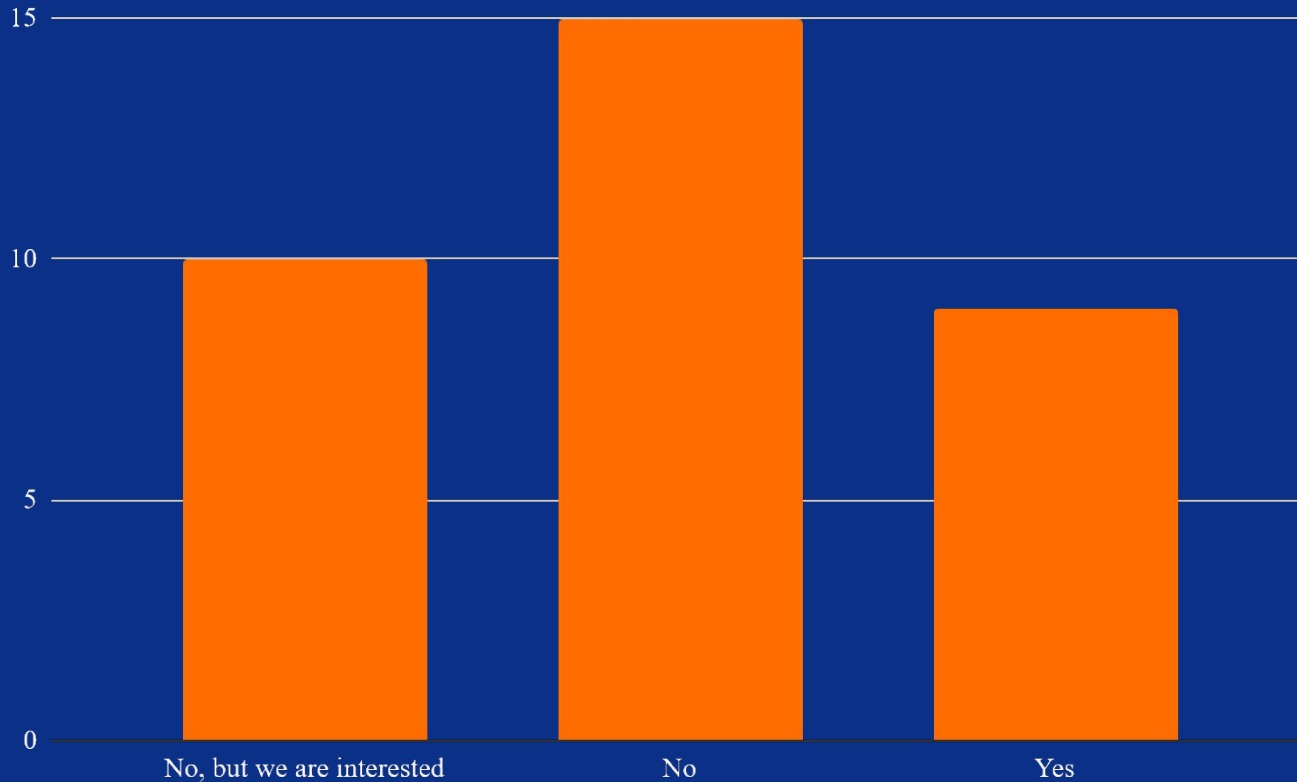

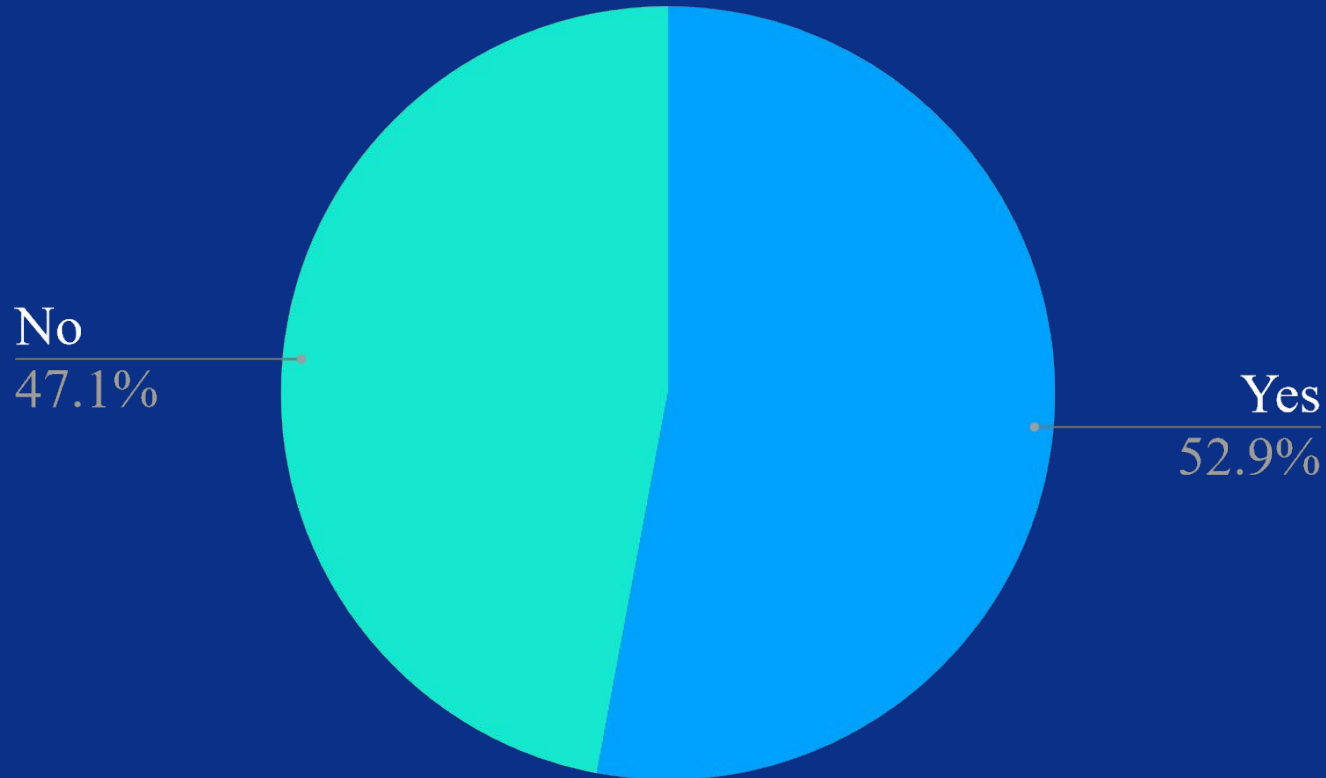

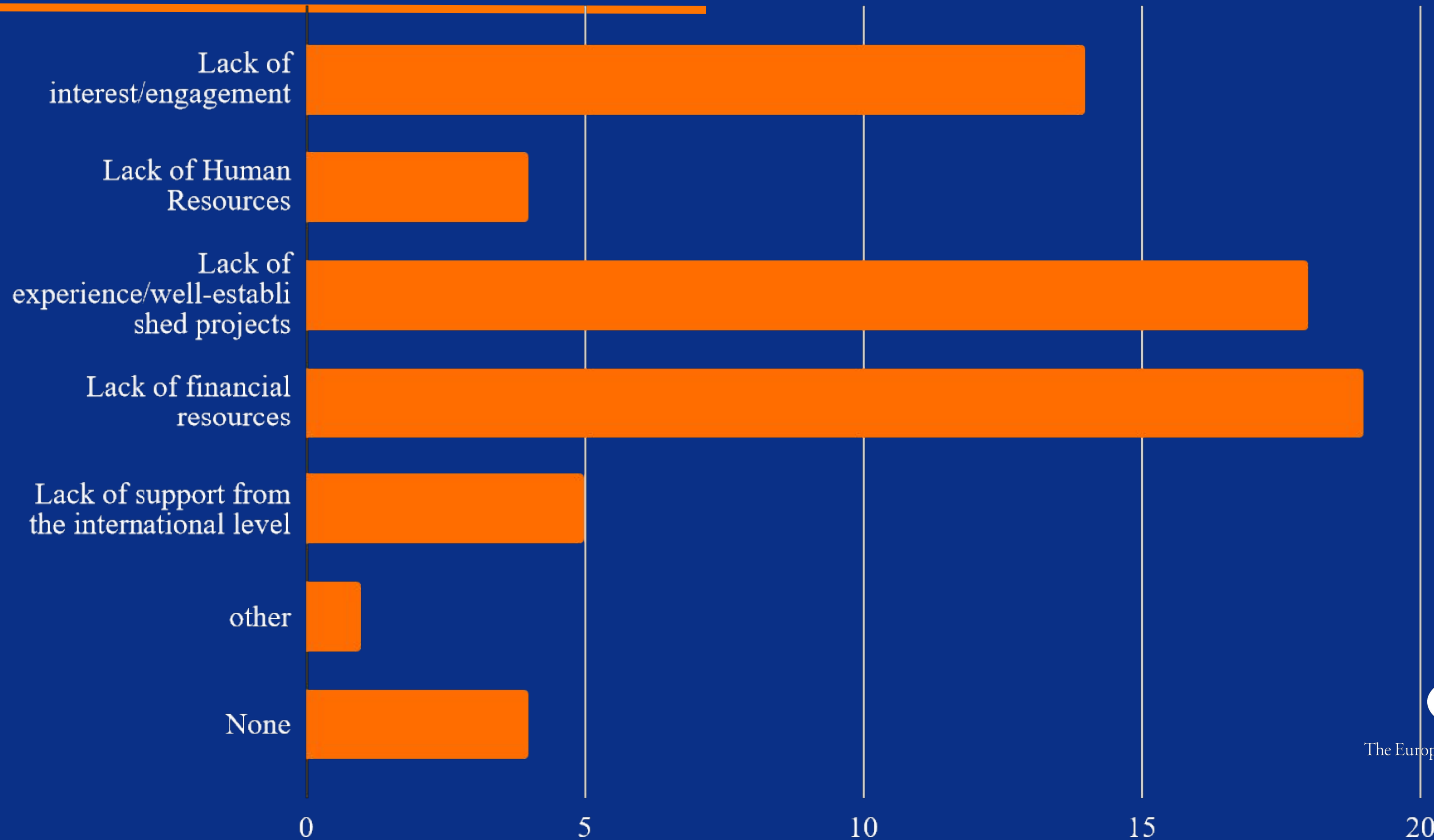
28. Is there enough visibility of the ELSA Law Review for the members of local groups in your country?



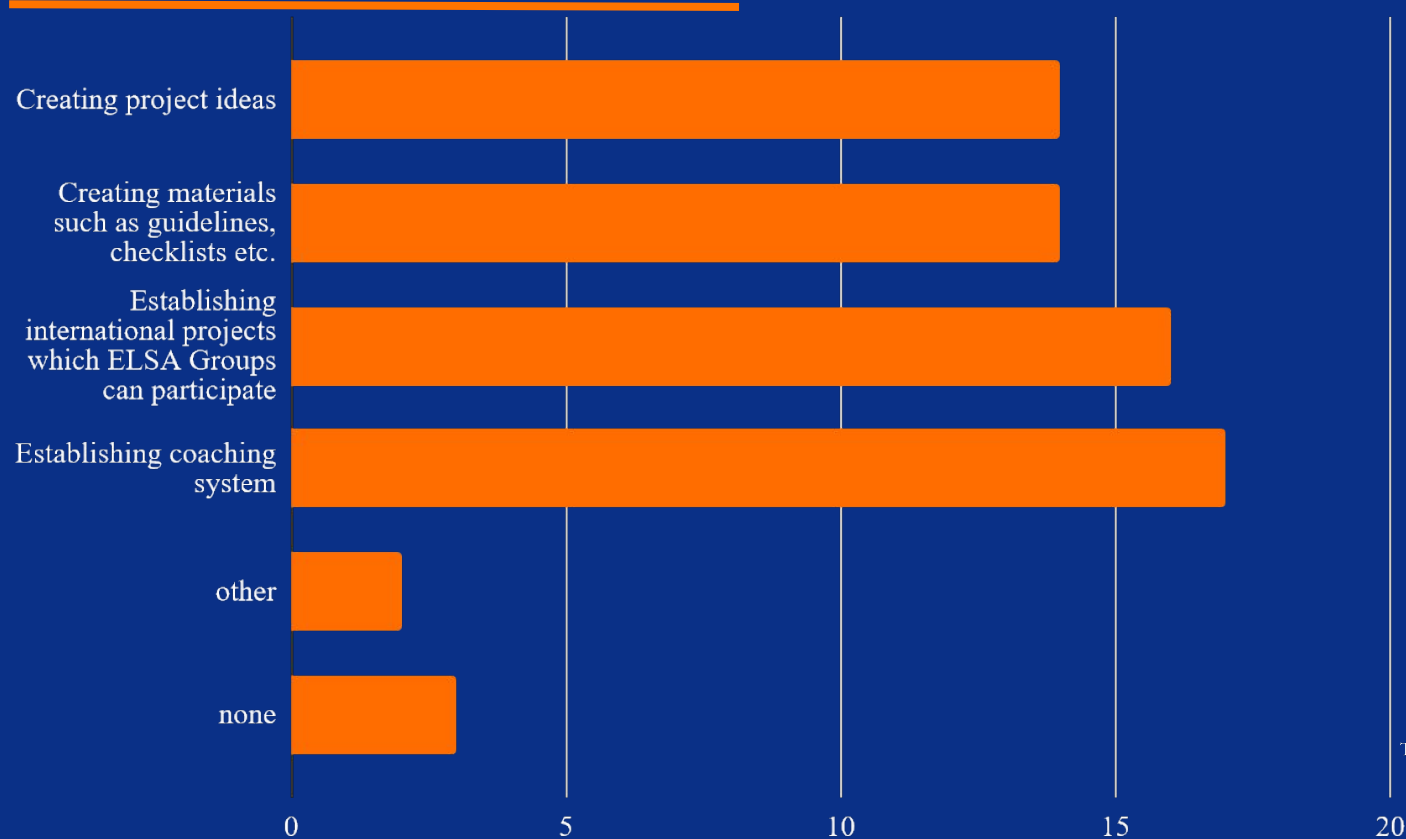

30. What kind of assistance would you need from the ELSA International for your social responsibility initiatives?



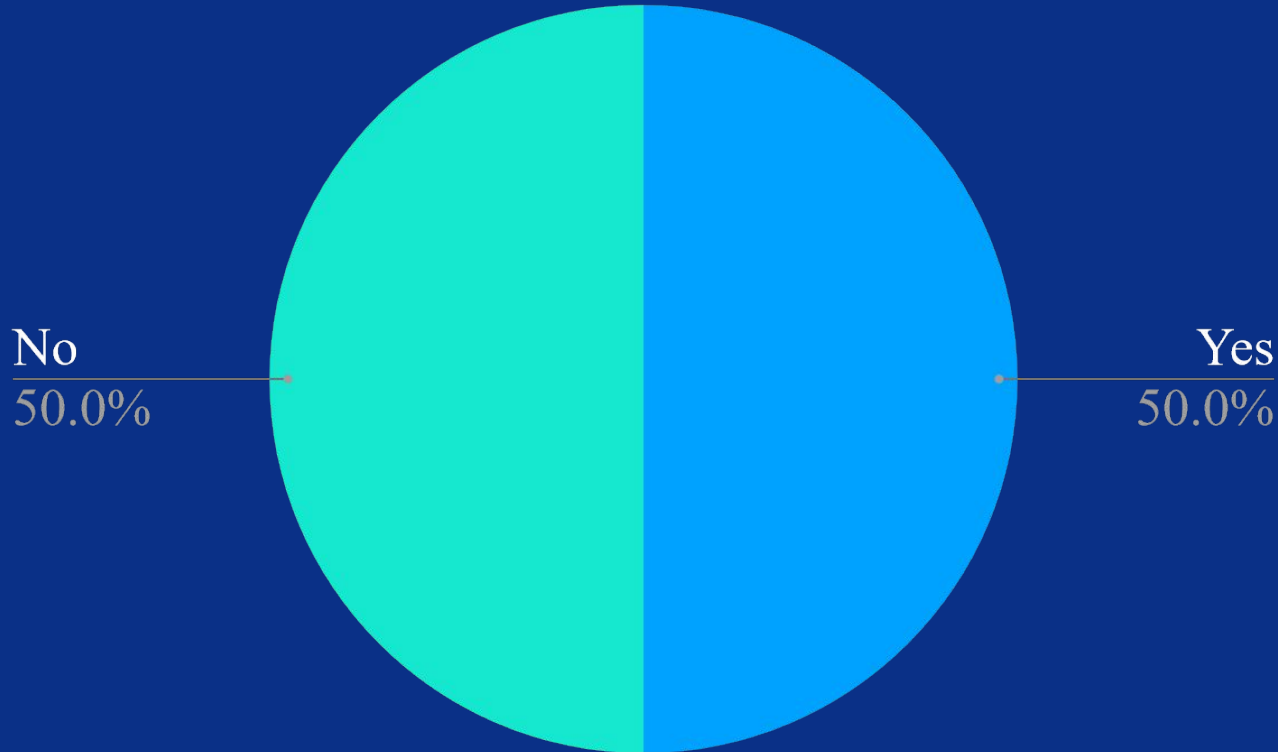

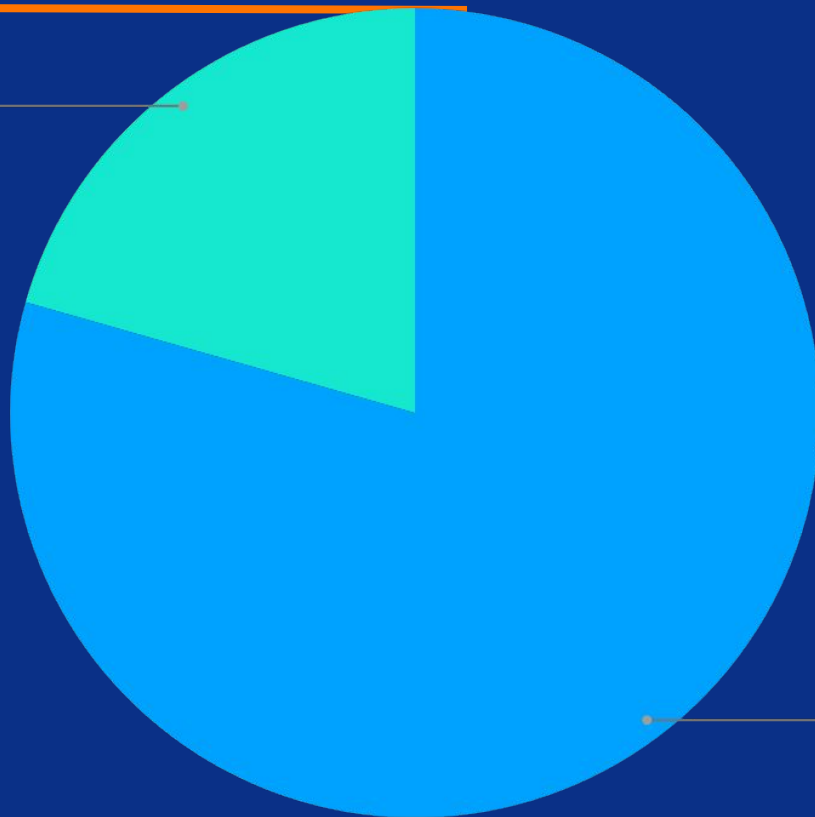

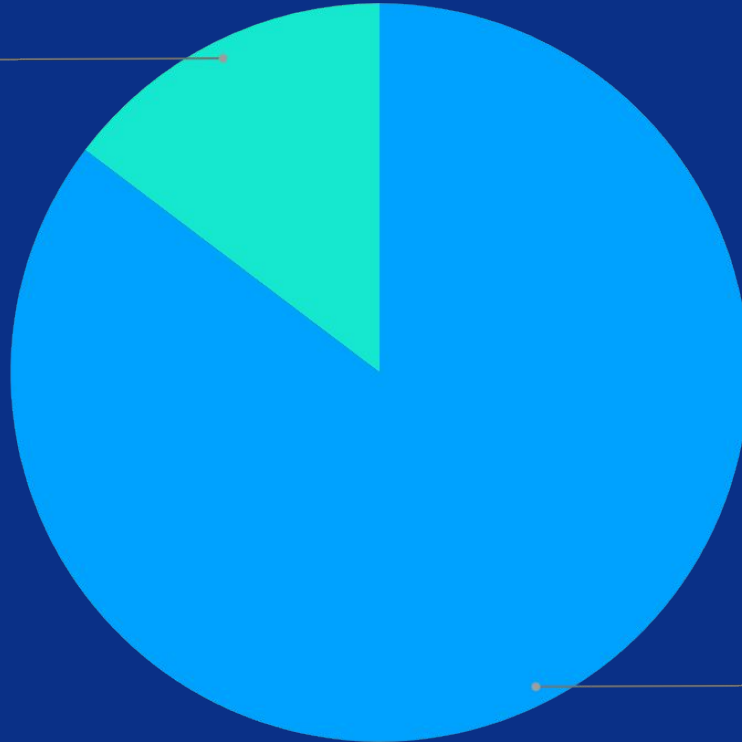

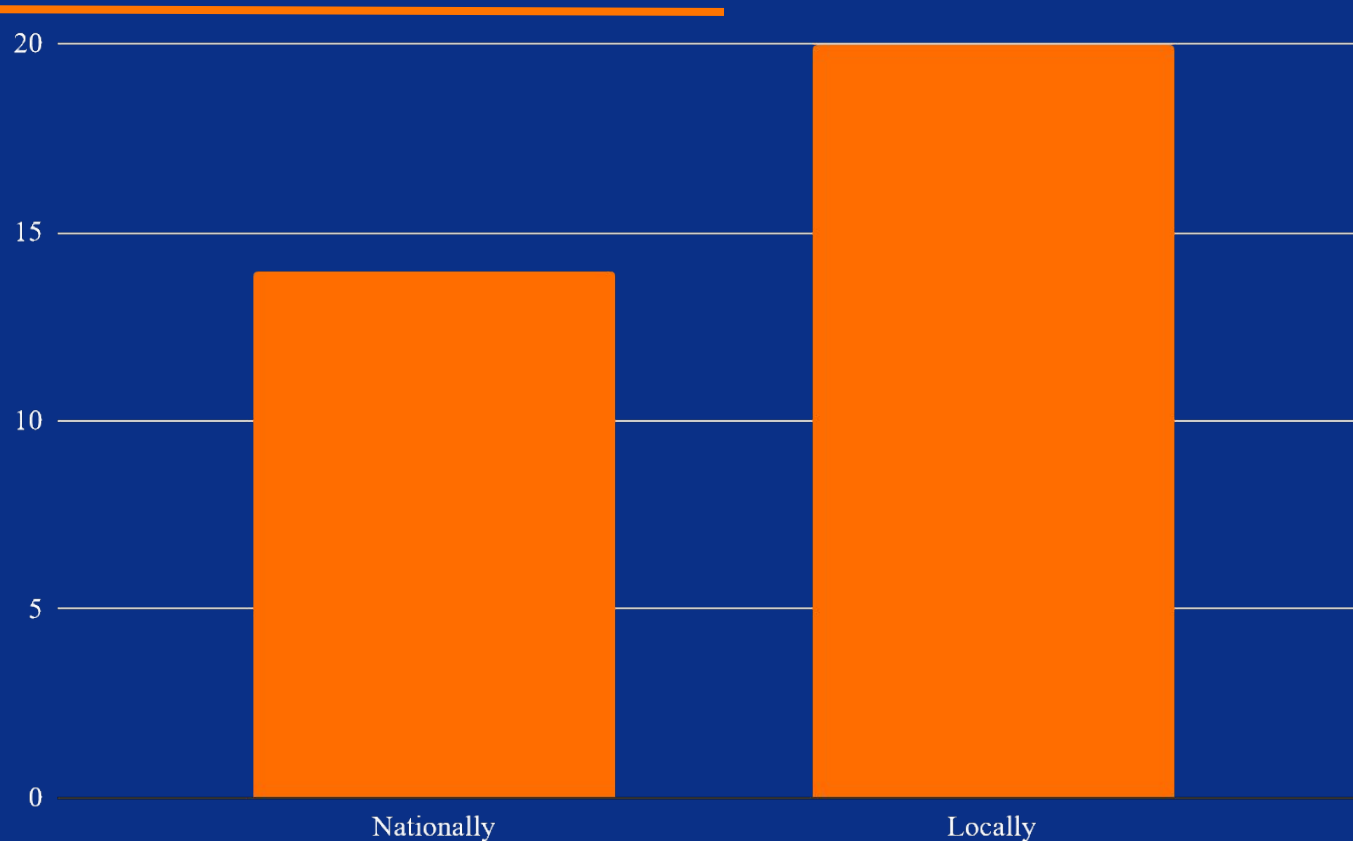

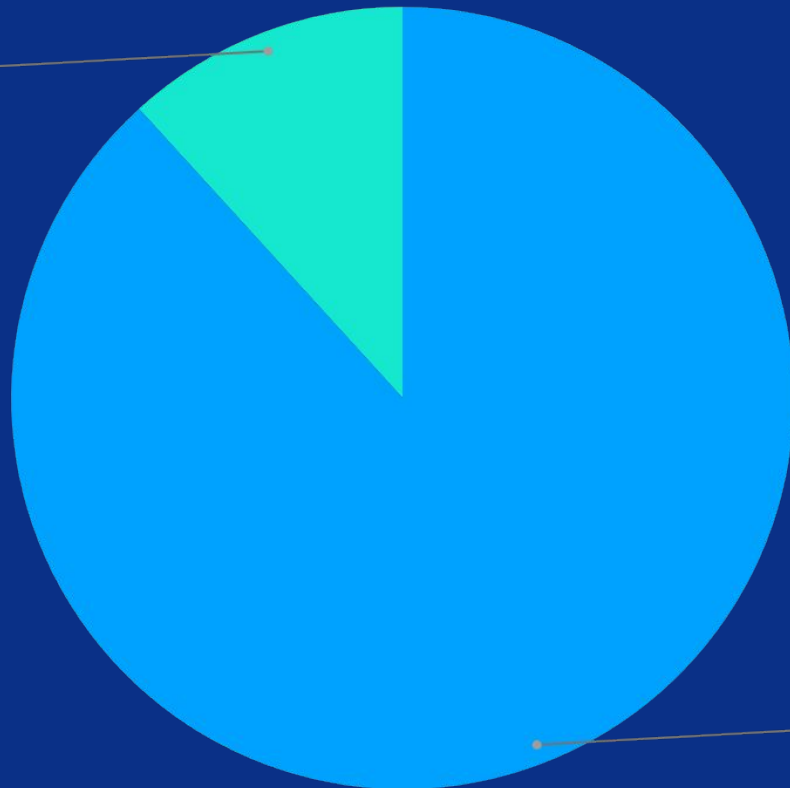
43. How is the Reception organised in your Group?

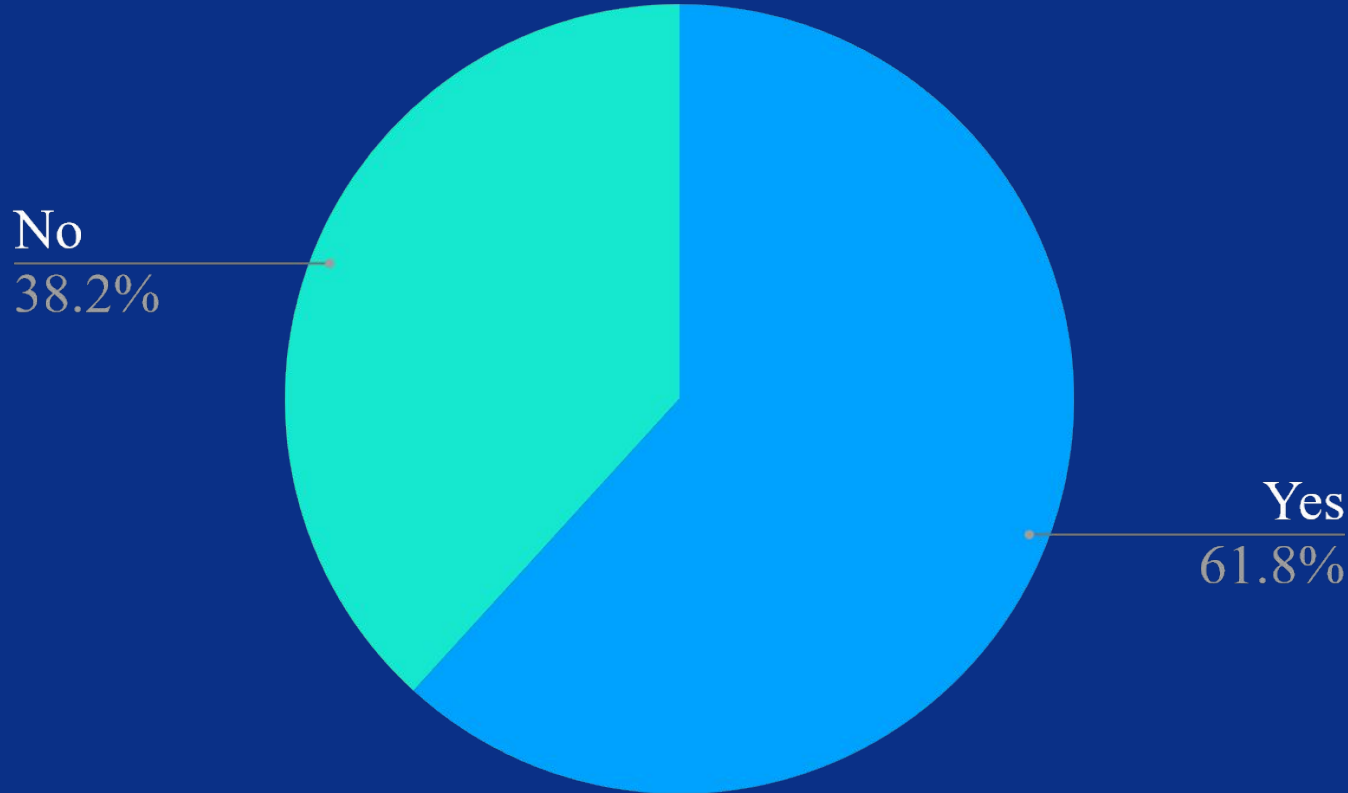

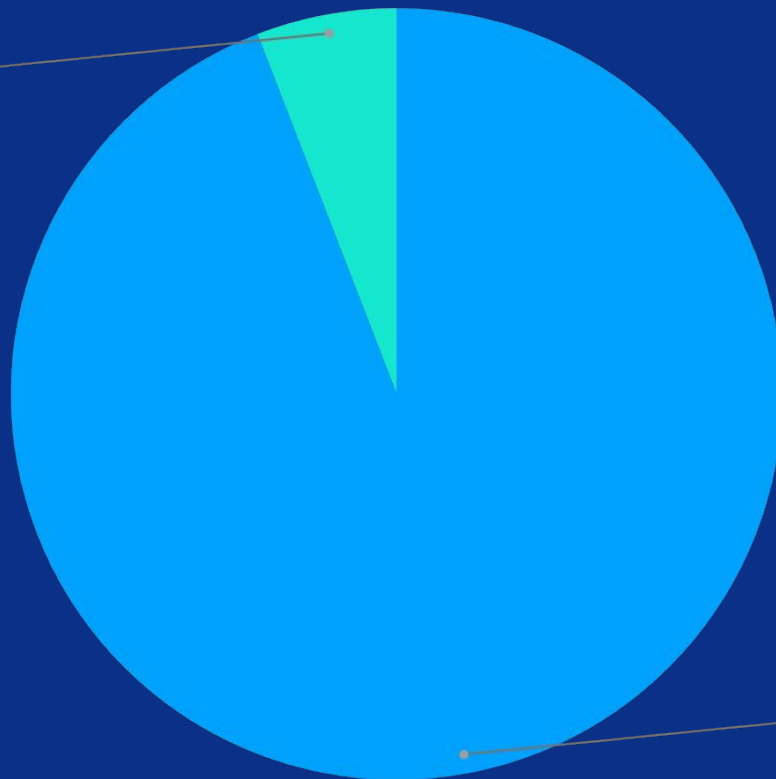
46. Are you interested in organizing a Legal Tandem?

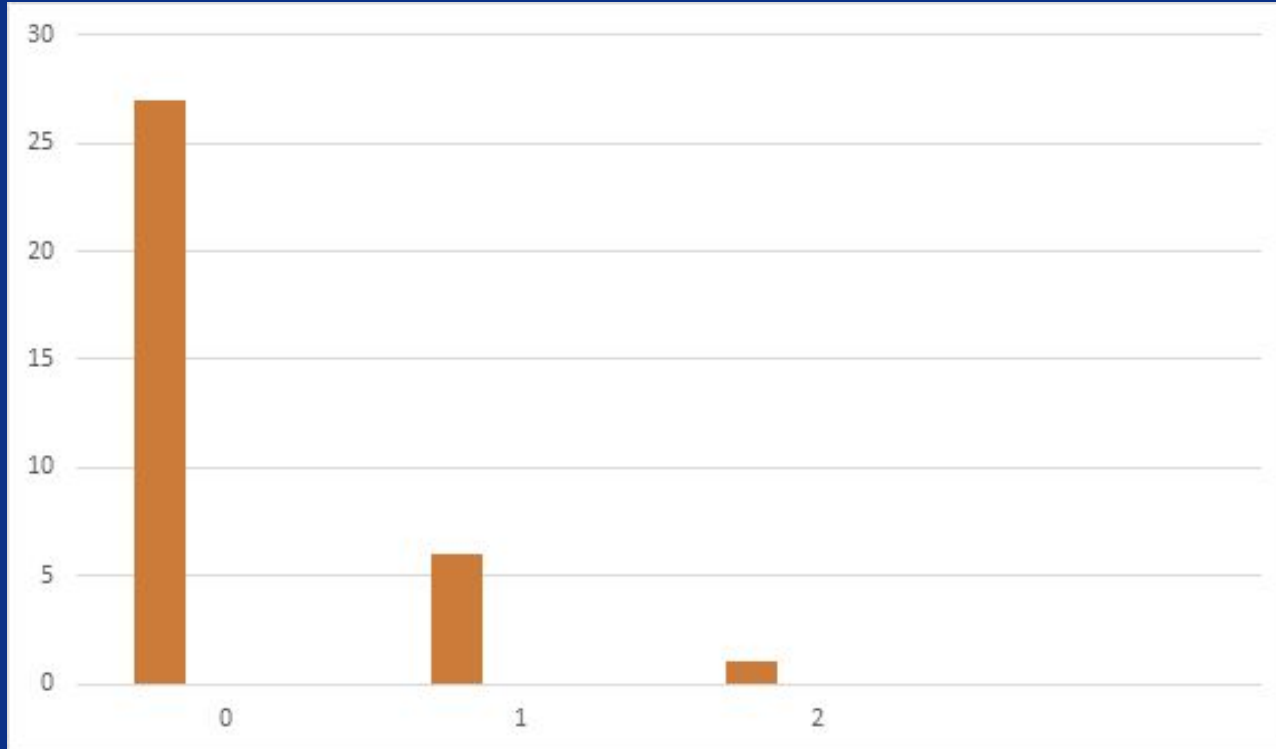
49. How many international S&C projects were organised in your National Group?

52. How many International Conferences of ELSA were organised in your National Group?

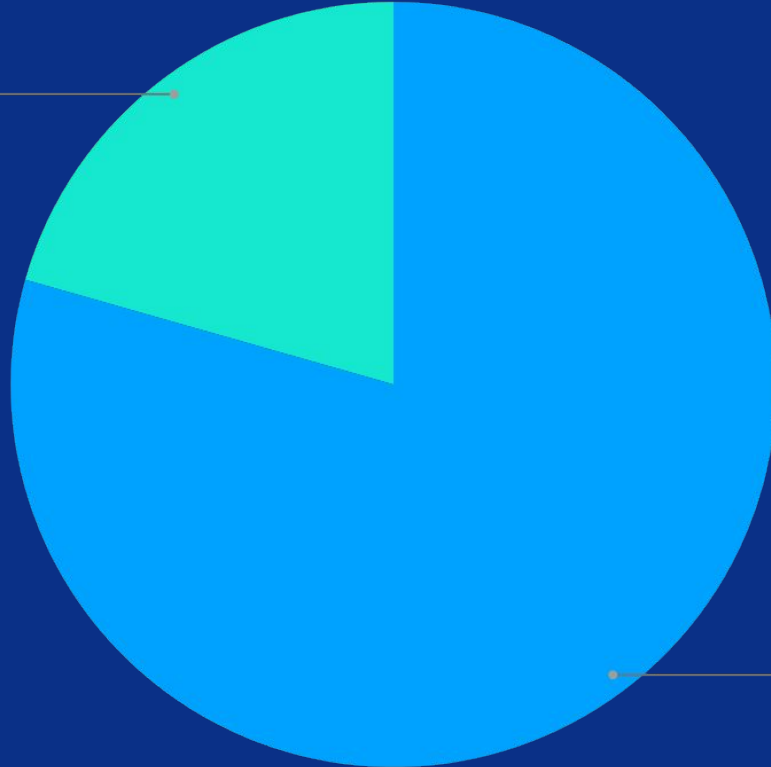
