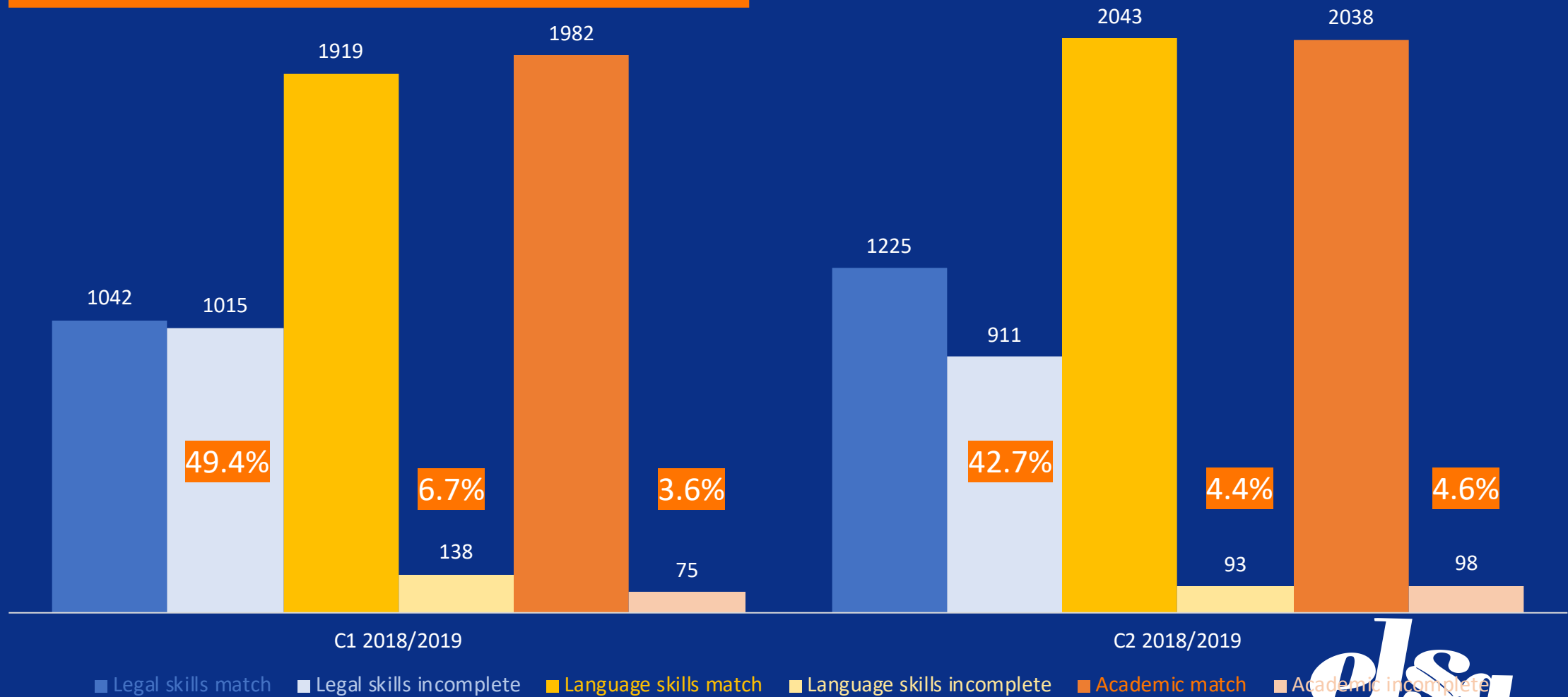

The verification guidelines – food for thought

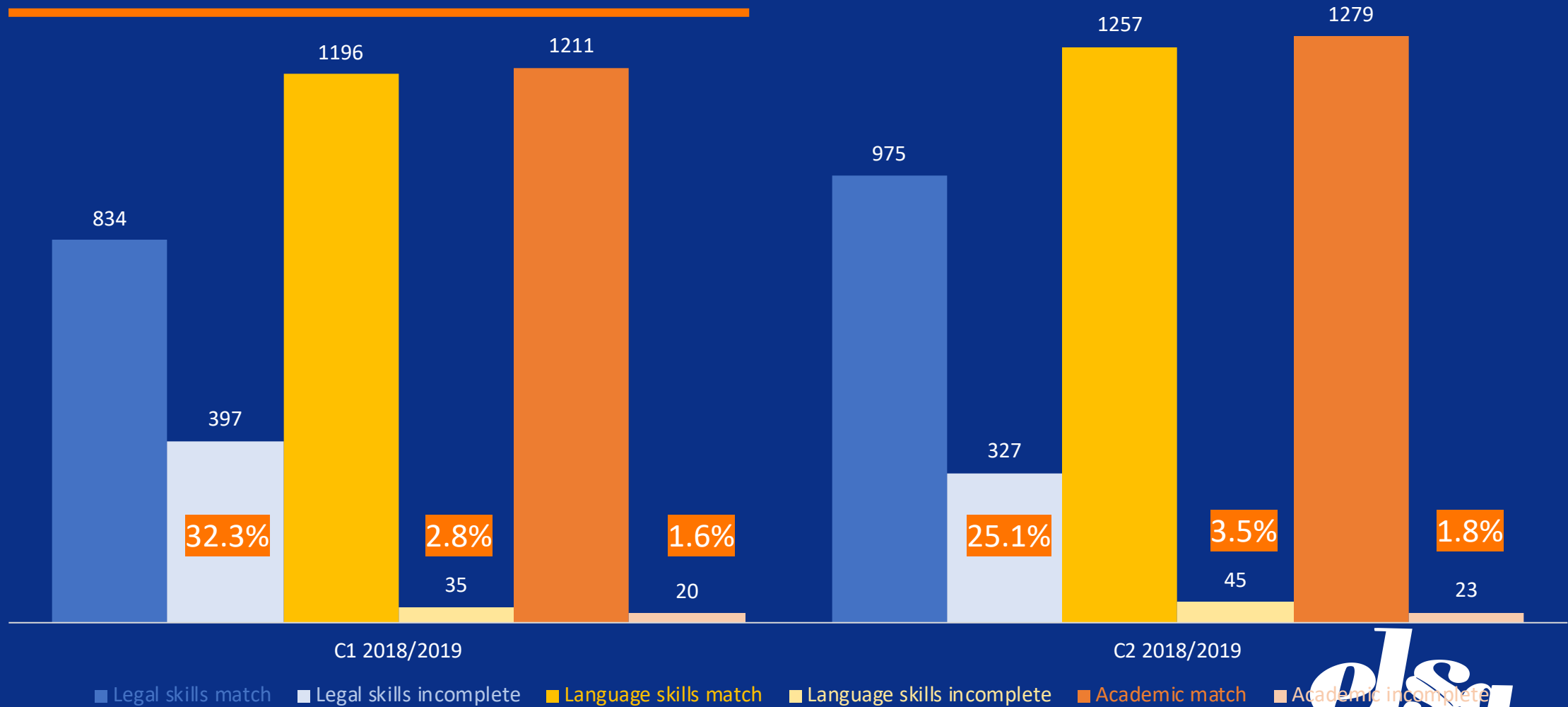
- **What should be the **quality standards**?**
 - **Verification** by the Sending Group(s);
 - **Matching** by ELSA International
- **Should all (verified) SAFs be presented to the TNPs?**
 - **Fair competition** for all motivated and capable applicants
 - **Transparency**
 - **Demand by the TNP**
 - ***What is the point of specifying the skills in the TSF then?***
- **Should only fully matched SAFs be presented to the TNPs?**



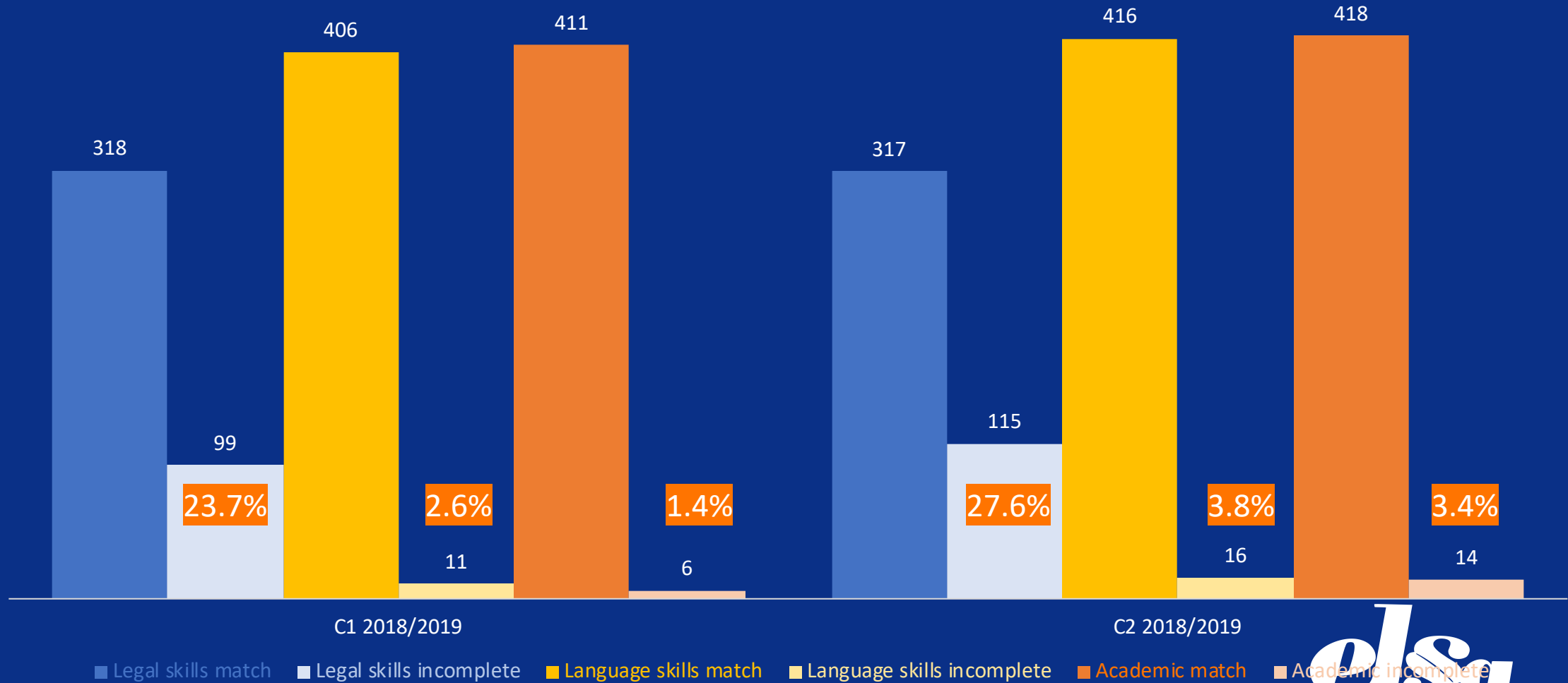
SAF being verified and approved

Solutions?

- Focus on the **verification of the SAFs** (Sending Group)
- **Language skills** = must be matched
- **Academic level** = must be matched
- **Legal skills** = some **discretion** for strong applications?
- **LEAVE A COMMENT in the SOS** where a SAF falls short of the required legal skills → Facilitating the life of the STEP Trainees Team
