

ICM DB - PART 7. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT- CHAPTER 1. DEFINITIONS - Article 1. General

- 1.1 Professional Development is a Key Area of ELSA that aims to support law students and young lawyers in developing and improving the necessary skills to access the professional world by means of continuous education for individuals <u>in regards to their future career and the skills needed therefore</u>.
- 1.2 A Professional Development project is one where participants acquire skills needed in order to access the professional world through <u>training events</u>, <u>Lawyers at Work events</u>, <u>ELSA Traineeships</u>, <u>Career Launch sessions</u> or <u>any other activity falling under the score of Article 1.1 of this Chapter.</u>



LAWYERS AT WORK

Lawyers at Work Events (L@W Events) are projects which allow law students and young lawyers to experience working in a legal profession first-hand. L@W Events are designed to involve practical insights into the legal profession and as such shall involve interactive learning opportunities.

A career fair (<u>also known as a job fair or career expo</u>) is a recruiting event in which employers and recruiters meet with potential employees and where job seekers find more about job openings at potential employers.

They are most often organised in large halls where potential employers set up booths with HR team members who are there to explain to potential employees all about current job openings, the application process and anything else regarding the organization. But they can also be held online!

LEGAL CLINICS

The Legal Clinic (also known as Law Clinic) is an activity inspired by a learning method adopted in many American Law Schools based on learning programs providing hands-on legal experiences.

Students are asked to offer pro bono legal services to real clients. Their services consist in researching materials, drafting legal arguments and meeting clients. All the activities are carried out, in different fields of law, under the direction of one or more professors. The main goal is to complete the theoretical qualification of students through practical activities.



LEGAL CLINICS IN ELSA

It is very important that the Law Firm is giving pro bono assistance to the clients.

Usually, the case involved disadvantaged categories of people or important human rights.

JOINT PROJECTS WITH OTHER KEY AREAS

- <u>Traineeships as part of other activities</u>: A traineeships can be the prize for the best orator in a moot court or a negotiation competition or for the best essay writer in an essay competition!
- <u>PD Workshop as part of other activities</u>: It can be organized for the participants of an academic competition or S&C Projects!
- <u>Career Fair as part of other activities</u>: A (small) Career Fair can be organized for the participants of an academic competition or S&C Projects with the collaboration of the Partners involved in the projects!
- <u>International Focus Programme (IFP)</u>: Professional Development Events can be organized with a focus in those topics!

- Collaborative project with all the Key Areas (AA, MCC/C, PD and S&C)
 - One subject

 - Active knowledge learning with AA
 - Soft skills learning with PD events
